Race 7 – GARY STEWART @ MITAVITE 1650- The hearing into a charge filed under Rule 636 (1) (b) with respect to Apprentice M Cropp riding of STORMIN NORMAN over the final 300m of the race, has been concluded.

After consideration the Judicial Control Authority has determined that STORMIN NORMAN's chances of finishing in a higher placing were not detrimentally affected and consequently the charge was dismissed.

RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 REMBRANDT MOTEL HURDLE

The race card incorrectly listed the distance of the race at 2,800 metres, the correct distance being approx. 2,980 metres. On and off course patrons were advised accordingly.

GOLD MIST jumped the fence near the winning post on the first round poorly

When questioned into the run of THATZ DAVID rider C Perrett was of the opinion 71.5kgs and the holding nature of the track were factors in the geldings run today.

R Cully had no excuse for the poor run of BALLY HEIGHTS which finished back. Trainer P Nelson agreed to monitor the geldings progress over coming days and report any finding to the stewards.

Race 2 GARDEN EDGE HURDLE

The race card incorrectly listed the distance of the race at 2,800 metres, the correct distance being approx. 2,980 metres.

PENDULUM and SMART MOLLY were retired from the race near the 500 metres when well back and out of contention.

CONQUISTADOR hit the last fence and lost momentum.

KEEP AHEAD broke down in the home straight on the first occasion sustaining an injury to the off hind leg. KEEP AHEAD was subsequently euthanized.

When questioned into the run of HOOVER BOY rider I Lupton advised the gelding over raced early and had little left at the finish.

PENDULUM over raced throughout.

SMART MOLLY underwent a post race veterinary examination which revealed the mare to be lame. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance is required.

Race 3 HYPNOTISE MAIDEN STEEPLECHASE

PASCOE BROWN raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

CHIVAS ROYALE was retired from the event with 400 metres to run when well back and out of contention.

DUMINY lost ground at the fence near the 1200 metres.

BINKLEBONK made a poor jump at the second last fence and lost momentum.

When questioned into the run of VICTORY MORGAN rider C Singer had no excuse.

Race 4 STORAGE & EQUIPMENT HIRE MAIDEN

CISKAY was held up momentarily prior to the home turn.

Race 5 TUDOR LODGE MOTEL/AVON MOTEL 2100 RATING 65

GOLD MESSAGE hung outwards at the start and dictated QUICK MARCH outwards into the line of HIGH COUNTRY which was tightened and lost ground.

SANZ raced keenly in the early stages and had to be steadied for some distance rounding the turn into the back straight.

TWISTED SISTER shifted out under pressure in the home straight.

Race 6 PLATINUM HOMES (NZ) 2000

WAITAHA TOA bucked and dislodged rider R Hannam during its preliminary and galloped some distance prior to jumping a fence in the back straight. WAITAHA TOA was declared a late scratching by the Stewards. As a result the start of this race was delayed five minutes.

BLAKMANDU began awkwardly and was slow away.

WOTABUZZ (A Gillanders) raced keenly. When questioned apprentice jockey Gillanders advised Stewards that her instructions were to trail if possible but she was unable to do so as the gelding over raced in the early and middle stages.

Race 7 MCDONALD REAL ESTATE MAIDEN

WHISPERING WATERS was slow away.

LOOK AGAIN and OUR ENTOURAGE bumped at the start.

TARTLET began awkwardly and when being straightened shifted out abruptly causing tightening to ARILAHA which became unbalanced. Also hampered were GOOD RISK and WHAT NEXT.

TORRICELLA shifted out under pressure near the 200 metres, momentarily hampering TONTORULZ.

When questioned into the run of OUR ENTOURAGE K Myers was of the opinion that her mount may be better suited to a longer distance.
