RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	NEW ZEALAND BLOODSTOCK INSURANCE PREMIER 3YO
<p>LORD KIRKWOOD raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>Near the 300 metres KATE when improving adjacent the rail was inclined to lay out and bumped with TAOIST MASTER on two occasions.</p> <p>TAOIST MASTER had to steady when in restricted room near the 100 metres.</p> <p>KATE shifted out abruptly near the post and momentarily inconvenienced DORIAN GREY.</p> <p>The connections of second placed DORIAN GREY viewed the footage of the final stages but elected not to proceed with an objection against the winner.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the run of PLATINUM LINCOLN rider K Myers stated she could offer no excuse for the disappointing performance.</p>	
Race 2	HB MASTER PLUMBERS PREMIER
<p>Trainer J Bridge admitted a breach of Rule 616 (3) in that he presented OKIE DOKIE at the inspection area with incorrect gear.</p> <p>MAURRAL was tightened at the start when runners either side shifted ground and as a result got back.</p>	

<p>OKIE DOKIE was hampered at the start.</p> <p>Passing the 1100 metres REGALIA was inconvenienced momentarily when inside ‘ER INDOORS which was crowded inwards by OKIE DOKIE (J Riddell). J Riddell was advised to exercise care.</p> <p>OKIE DOKIE was inclined to lay in under pressure throughout the final straight and near the 350 metres shifted in and bumped with ‘ER INDOORS.</p> <p>OUR GREAT EMPIRE was crowded for several strides when tiring passing the 200 metres.</p> <p>EDENSOR had to shift ground outward passing the 200 metres to continue to improve.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the run of INDIANA JONES apprentice A Forbes was of the view that the gelding may be better suited to a longer distance.</p>	
Race 3	STELLA ARTOIS PREMIER
<p>KOKANEE GOLD was slow away.</p> <p>LETMEBY shifted out abruptly at the start tightening GO THUNDER which settled back.</p> <p>TAATS was slow away.</p> <p>THE MAILMAN raced keenly early and made the first corner awkwardly and when being steadied, then shifted out and bumped with MIDNIGHT PADDLE and DANCING EMBERS which was dictated wider on the track</p> <p>SHORT OF CENTS had to be steadied near the 1600 metres when racing keenly.</p> <p>ME AROHA raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>TAATS shifted in abruptly when struck with the whip near the 350 metres and bumped with THE LAST AL</p> <p>L. Allpress the rider of CENTAROSE admitted a breach of Rule 638(1)(d) after she permitted her mount to shift in passing the winning post on the first occasion when not clear of THE PALM KING which was checked. After consideration the Judicial Committee suspended L Allpress’s license to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 8th September up to and including racing on Thursday September 13th (4 days).</p> <p>When questioned into the run of MARVON DOWNS rider J MacDonald advised Stewards the gelding was held up near the 400m when the pace ahead quickened, however only finished on fairly when in clear running.</p>	
Race 4	BAY FORD NZ PUNTER OF THE YEAR PREMIER
<p>COMMETT and TEMPLE VIEW were slow away.</p> <p>M Cameron the rider of THE MINER’S SON defended a charge of careless riding in that he allowed his mount to shift inwards shortly after the start dictating MR MCCLOUD inward into the line of YANGMING which was checked. Also affected was ALFONZE which had to be steadied off heels. After deliberations the Judicial Committee dismissed the charge.</p> <p>YANGMING after being checked commenced to over-race and had to be steadied for some distance in the run through the back straight.</p> <p>Passing the 300 metres ALFONZE ducked in abruptly tightening MUNGO JERRY. Also affected in this incident was YANGMING which became unbalanced for a short distance.</p> <p>MUNGO JERRY then became held up and had to be angled wide passing the 100 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p>ALFONSE was galloped on during the running and lost a right hind plate.</p>	
Race 5	REDWOOD PREMIER
<p>SUPERTURF was slow away.</p> <p>The saddle on FIGURE AGAIN shifted forward entering the back straight placing the rider at a disadvantage for the remainder of the race.</p> <p>Rider B Lammas (BELFAST LAD) was reminded of his obligation in respect of his whip usage on a horse not in connection.</p>	
Race 6	BILLY’S BAR HASTINGS PREMIER
<p>MIKO (M Cropp), SHOWING OFF and JOY’S CHOICE came together and bumped at the start.</p> <p>ANNIE HIGGINS began awkwardly and got back.</p> <p>DELECTA DREIMS raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>ANNIE HIGGINS was held up over the final 200 metres.</p> <p>JOY’S CHOICE raced in restricted room from near the 100 metres.</p> <p>Track was upgraded to a Dead 6 after the running of Race 6.</p>	
Race 7	HASTINGS, HEART OF HAWKE’S BAY PREMIER
<p>BRACKENWOOD was scratched on veterinary advice after being found to be lame in the near fore leg in the tie up stalls.</p> <p>SECOND HOPE and SHEZGORGEIOUS were slow away.</p> <p>GOSSIPING over-raced when making the turn near the 900 metres</p> <p>DREAMCATCHER was obliged to race wide throughout.</p> <p>SHEZGORGEIOUS was held up rounding the final turn until near the 200 metres.</p> <p>SECOND HOPE was held up near the 200 metres before being taken wider to improve.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of BALDOVINO which disappointed, rider J MacDonald could offer no excuses. A subsequent veterinary examination of BALDOVINO revealed no abnormalities.</p>	
Race 8	MAFKI CHALLENGE STAKES
<p>I AM SAM was slow away.</p>	

ART BEAT began awkwardly and bumped with **BABY GUINNESS**.

TIMEKEEPER was obliged to race three wide throughout.

Near the 200 metres **INNOVATION** improved onto the heels of **I AM SAM** and had to be steadied.

THE HOMBRE had difficulty obtaining clear running rounding the final turn until the 200 metres.

OCEAN PARK was held up rounding the home turn until near the 200 metres

FLEUR DE LUN had to steady momentarily near the 150 metres when **MUFHASA** shifted out under hard riding. **FLEUR DE LUNE** then raced in restricted room for the remainder.

S Spratt (**MUFHASA**) lost her whip near the 100 metres.

V Colgan reported that **HE'S REMARKABLE** was not entirely comfortable in the track conditions and would improve with the outing.

Race 9	LET'S GO TO TURKS PREMIER

THUNDERBIRD ONE was a late scratching at 5pm after dislodging the rider J Waddell during the preliminary and galloping freely for an excessive distance.

BOLT ACTION began awkwardly and shortly after clipped a heel and blundered.

Passing the 1250 metres **BOLD ACTION** contacted the heels of **MAKEBA** and blundered. **J Riddell** the rider of **MAKEBA** defended a resultant charge of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d) in that he permitted his mount to shift in when not clear of **BOLD ACTION**, causing that runner to be checked.

After consideration the Judicial Committee found the charge proved and suspended **J Riddell's** licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing today up to and including racing on Monday 10th September. (5 days).

KENNY'S CHANCE was held up rounding the turn and passing the 250 metres, when attempting a narrow run, contacted the hind quarters of **BONDI TRAM** which resulted in both **KENNY'S CHANCE** and **BONDI TRAM** becoming unbalanced. Also affected in this incident was **POLYANTHA** which was hampered.
