Race 1		MORRIS AND BAILEY LIMITED OPEN HURDLES	

O'CONNOR hit the fence near the 1300m.

HONEY went off stride after making contact with the running rail near the 1600m.

When questioned into the disappointing run of CRACKA CROWN which failed to finish, rider M Gillies said that after hitting the fence near the 2000m his mount overextended itself at the next fence and this may have had an effect on its performance. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormality. Connections undertook to monitor the progress of CRACKA CROWN in coming days and report any finding to the stewards.

### Race 2 PGG WRIGHTSON LIMITED MAIDEN HURDLES

ERIC THE VIKING jumped indifferently in the early stages. MISTER DEEJAY and SEA EAGLE both raced keenly in the early and middle stages. MISTER DEEJAY hit the fence near the 1800m. When questioned regarding the run of MISTER DEEJAY, which dropped out over the final stages, rider R Cully said the gelding was not entirely comfortable in the going and had little left at the finish after racing keenly throughout. MR MOR and SEA EAGLE bumped near the 400m. MR MOR blundered after jumping the third-last fence and lost momentum. SEA EAGLE landed awkwardly after jumping the last fence.

Rider J Rathbone reported that SNOWDROPTWINKLETOES jumped its fences slowly throughout but had no tangible excuse. ERIC THE VIKING returned to the enclosure with blood present in the mouth, this being consistent with striking the barrier prior to the start.

Race 3 PROFESSIONALS REAL ESTATE TARARUA DASH

OUR GREAT EMPIRE began awkwardly and shifted out bumping with WEE JEAN, which in turn shifted out making heavy contact with DECADENT, which lost ground.

NICMAJAC shifted out on jumping, hampering VEININSKY which lost ground. Apprentice jockey M Dravitzki (OUR GREAT EMPRIE) admitted a breach of rule 638(1)(d) in that she permitted her mount to shift inwards near the 900m, dictating CRACK A TUI into the line of VEININSKY which was checked. After deliberations apprentice jockey Dravitzki had her licence to ride in races suspended from the close of racing on Saturday, 15 September 2012 until the conclusion of racing on Thursday, 20 September 2012. VEININSKY was inclined to lug inwards in the home straight. **DANNEVIRKE 4 SQUARE 1600** Race 4 THORA BOB was slow to begin. KOBUDO raced keenly rounding the first turn and near the 1400m had to be steadied off heels for some distance. PRINCE FEDERICO and MR ALIBI came together and bumped shortly after entering the home straight. KOBUDO was inclined to lay in throughout the final straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormality. HUAR WEE was held up for a short distance near the 400m. When questioned into the run of LORD KIRKWOOD which failed to finish the race off after leading throughout, rider T Russel said the gelding pulled up in a normal post-race condition and was very disappointing. Connections were advised to monitor the progress of LORD KIRKWOOD over coming days and report any finding to the stewards.
