<b>Race 1</b>	<b>AGRAFORUM MAIDEN 1800</b>
<b>CHANTILLY LACE</b> (S Doyle) began awkwardly.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>MR NANCHO @ LINWOOD PARK 1800</b>
<p><b>POOKA'S SISTER</b> (K Myers) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>OUR ALCHEMIST</b> (D Walker) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>ADALIA</b> (C Lammas) raced keenly rounding the first turn making contact with <b>OUR ALCHEMIST</b> (D Walker) on several occasions, when laying in away from <b>PORSHABEEL</b> (H Tinsley).</p> <p><b>OUR ALCHEMIST</b> was inclined to over race in the middle stages.</p> <p><b>OUR ALCHEMIST</b> was held up behind the weakening <b>PORSHABEEL</b> near the 500 metres.</p> <p><b>POOKA'S SISTER</b> made contact with <b>SEAMS LIKE MAGIC</b> (R Hutchings) when shifting out to obtain clear running near the 300 metres. Also inconvenienced was <b>JENNY'S OKAY</b>. K Myers was advised to exercise care. <b>POOKA'S SISTER</b> was then inclined to lay out.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of <b>OUR ALCHEMIST</b> rider D Walker stated that the mare had not been suited by the slow tempo of the race and would prefer more rain affected conditions. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormalities.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>GRAPHIX EXPLOSION MAIDEN 1200</b>
<p><b>MION JAY</b> (L Whelan) was slow away.</p> <p><b>MISS HOLLY</b> (J Shackleton) began awkwardly and shifted out hampering <b>COAT HANGER</b> (B Lammas) which was forced outwards crowding <b>WHISPERING WATERS</b> (R Hutchings).</p> <p><b>CITIEYETE</b> (D Walsh) jumped outwards at the start making contact with <b>MISS DAISY</b> (H Tinsley).</p> <p><b>CITIEYETE</b> and <b>BILL BREAKER</b> (K Myers) came together on several occasions in the run down the back straight.</p> <p><b>MISS DAISY</b> and <b>KASHMIR KID</b> (M Dravitzki) both raced wide without cover.</p>	

**BILL BREAKER** made contact with **MISS DAISY** near the 150 metres.

**MION JAY** was reluctant to improve into a tight run to the inside of **COAT HANGER** (B Lammas) in the final straight and had to be steadied passing the 100 metres when **COAT HANGER** shifted in slightly under pressure.

**WHISPERING WATERS** was inclined to shift out under pressure over the concluding stages.

**MISS HOLLY** returned to the enclosure with some blood present in the left nostril which after being examined by the Veterinarian was found to be from a minor laceration.

**Race 4**

**STELLA ARTOIS MAIDEN**

**MANGAROA MAIDEN** was a late scratching on veterinary advice at 2.34pm due to a laceration to the off hind coronet.

**DICAPRIO (A Calder)** jumped in the air at the start and was slow away.

**RUSSIAN HAZE** (J Parkes) raced keenly in the early stages and had to be steadied near the 900 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of **TONTORULZ** (M Dravitzki) which shifted in. M Dravitzki was issued with a warning.

**MI COMPANERO** (L Whelan) returned to the enclosure with blood present in the left nostril which after being examined by the Veterinarian, was found to be from a minor laceration.

**Race 5**

**TOP STITCH 1400**

**AUSTIN ROAD** (J Parkes) began awkwardly.

**TORRADO** (R Hannam) was slow away.

**ZABLIME** (M Tanaka) raced three wide without cover throughout.

**Race 6**

**MITAVITE FORMULA 3 1400**

**ZEINA ROYALE** (L Whelan) and **STORM HOME** (D Turner) both began awkwardly and were slow away as a result.

**ISHMA** (A Calder) raced three wide without cover throughout.

When questioned regarding the performance of **HEAPZACASH** rider H Tinsley advised that in his opinion the mare had been feeling the effects of recent racing, with the connections indicating that **HEAPZACASH** was now likely to be spelled.

**JACKSUN** (A Morgan) was briefly held up near the 150 metres and when shifting in to obtain clear running inconvenienced **ZEINA ROYALE** near the 100 metres.

S Doyle the rider of **LEICA DUELL** which raced poorly was unable to offer any excuses but did feel that the mare, which was resuming from a long spell, should improve with the outing.
