RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	STELLAR ARTOIS PREMIER
<p>TAATS (R Hutchings) underwent a veterinary examination at the barrier and was cleared to start after contacting a gate when leaving the enclosure</p> <p>THE MAILMAN (H Tinsley) jumped inwards abruptly at the start hampering SIR AMRON (J Jago) which lost ground.</p> <p>THE MAILMAN raced fiercely in the early stages having to be firmly restrained off heels for some distance.</p> <p>TAATS was obliged to race three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>TAATS was dictated wider near the 1300 metres when I'LL'AVA'ALF (L Innes) shifted out. L Innes was advised to exercise care.</p> <p>TAATS was inclined to lay in throughout and near the 800 metres shifted in crowding HOOVER BOY which had to be eased when becoming awkwardly placed on heels.</p> <p>THE MAILMAN was held up when on the heels of the tiring ORCHIDIUM (J Parkes) passing the 500 metres.</p>	
Race 2	BEDPOST HASTINGS PREMIER
<p>LET'S GO FRATELLI (L Innes) was slow away.</p> <p>MUNGO JERRY (K Myers) was slow away.</p> <p>ENUFFISENUFF (S Spratt) was obliged to race three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>AZINCOURT (L Allpress) raced keenly in the run down the back straight.</p> <p>REBEL'S RANSOM (M Hills) had to be steadied off heels passing the 800 metres when racing keenly.</p>	

<p>SWEET RITA (T Thornton) was denied a narrow run passing the 300 metres when AMITY DANE (C Lammas) lay in and away from CHAPCHICK.</p> <p>CHAPCHICK (R Jones) was held up early in the home straight.</p> <p>REBEL'S RANSOM was held up passing the 250 metres so was angled out to obtain clear running and in doing so inconvenienced JAMOMITI (H Tinsley)</p>	
Race 3	LITTLE AVONDALE PER INCANTO PREMIER 1300
<p>EDENSOR (J Waddell) jumped inwards at the start making contact with WAKE THE GURU (O Bosson)</p> <p>EDENSOR then became badly unbalanced and hung in severely crowding WAKE THE GURU, GRACE O'MALLEY (M Du Plessis), OUR KINGPIN (L Allpress) and CAJUN (T Russell), which was forced onto the hind quarters of WEE JEAN (C Grylls), which also became unbalanced.</p> <p>GRACE O'MALLEY went off stride for a short distance in this incident.</p> <p>EDENSOR then raced ungenerously and had to be restrained off heels throughout the back straight. Trainer D Guy was advised a warning had been placed against EDENSOR with respect to its racing manners.</p> <p>BACH (M Wenn) was inclined to race greenly through the back straight.</p> <p>OUR KINGPIN raced wide throughout.</p> <p>Near the 1000 metres FINN MOSS (K Myers) was buffeted for several strides when racing to the inside of SUMMER BOY (D Walker) which shifted in when being steadied off the heels of WEE JEAN which shifted ground when not fully clear. C Grylls was issued with a warning.</p> <p>TALK THE TORQUE (D Bradley) was held up for a short distance prior to the home turn.</p> <p>FINN MOSS was inclined to lay out in the early part of the home straight.</p>	
Race 4	AON INSURANCE BROKERS PREMIER
<p>ASPINAL (L Innes) got its head up over the side of the gate immediately prior to the jump and as a consequence was slow away.</p> <p>BABY GUINNESS (C Grylls) was obliged to race three wide throughout.</p> <p>ASPINAL was held up rounding the turn and only obtained clear running passing the 100 metres.</p> <p>KEKOVA (L Allpress) was held up for a short distance near the 300 metres.</p> <p>ASPINAL raced in restricted room over the final few strides.</p> <p>THE HOMBRE (J Riddell) underwent a post- race veterinary examination which revealed a poor post-race recovery. Trainer J Bary advised that the Hombre would undergo an endoscopic examination in coming days with the outcome to be reported to the Stewards.</p>	
Race 5	HAWKE'S BAY BREEDERS GOLD TRIAL STAKES
<p>The start was delayed one minute after several runners proved fractious after being loaded.</p> <p>A TOUCH OF RUBY (C Grylls) began awkwardly and was slow away.</p> <p>COASTAL EXPRESS (J Parkes) commenced to over-race shortly after leaving the barriers and at the 1000 metres shifted out bumping with WATERFORD (L Innes).</p> <p>OASIS ROSE (O Bosson) commenced to over-race passing the 1200 metres and near the 1000 metres had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of PURE ELEGANCE (J Waddell). OASIS ROSE then, while continuing to over-race, shifted in crowding DESERT STAR (L Allpress) which was tightened and blundered.</p> <p>WATERFORD raced three wide without cover throughout, and over the final 300 metres was inclined to lay in which resulted in the filly being unable to be ridden to full advantage.</p> <p>SORIANA (R Hutchings) was held up briefly entering the final straight.</p> <p>OASIS ROSE which was inclined to lay in in the final straight, had some difficulty obtaining clear running until the 100 metres.</p>	
Race 6	PGG WRIGHTSON PREMIER
<p>DESPEREAUX (S Spratt) had to be steadied going into the first bend and then raced keenly for some distance.</p> <p>FIGURE AGAIN (M Du Plessis) raced keenly in the early stages and had to be steadied off heels leaving the straight on the first occasion and in doing so went back onto HERMAN MUNSTER (L Allpress).</p> <p>BACK IN BLACK (V Colgan) was held up in the early part of the home straight.</p> <p>BUTCH JAMES (K Myers) was disappointed for a run passing the 100 metres when SEAFLYTE (C Lammas) shifted in and away from FLEMINGTON (M Hills) which was taken in by PERO (J. Riddell) which shifted ground under pressure. PERO shifted in again over the concluding stages crowding FLEMINGTON just short of the finish.</p>	
Race 7	NEW ZEALAND BLOODSTOCK INSURANCE PREMIER
<p>MINNALEO (L Allpress) and TEMPLE VIEW (A Forbes) were slow away.</p> <p>Approaching the 1200 metres WHOOPIE GEE (M Dravitski) was tightened and lost momentum when inside SINS OF THE FATHER (D Walker) which, when racing ungenerously, shifted in and away from VANILLA (T Thornton) which shifted in. Also affected in this incident was TEMPLE VIEW which had to be steadied away from WHOOPIE GEE.</p> <p>T Thornton was issued with a warning.</p>	

GUESS WHAT (N Harris) raced ungenerously when being steadied near the 1000 metres and came back onto **SKAI GLEN (M Wenn)** which had to be steadied for a short distance.

GUESS WHAT made the turn near the 900 metres awkwardly and shifted out bumping with **BRAVE CENTAUR (M Hills)**.

M Du Plessis the rider of **NORTHERN GENERAL** dropped his whip near the 200 metres.

VANILLA was held up rounding the turn and passing the 200 metres, when attempting to obtain clear running ,shifted in and crowded the tiring **SINS OF THE FATHER**. T Thornton was advised to exercise care.

Race 8	WINDSOR PARK PLATE

SPECIAL DAYS (J Waddell) jumped outwards at the start bumping **INNOVATION (L Innes)** resulting in both runners being slow away. **SHEZ SINSATIONAL (O Bosson)** and **GREEN SUPREME (M Du Plessis)** were slow away.

Rounding the turn near the 1400 metres **FLEUR DE LUNE (J Jago)** had to steady momentarily when inside **MUFHASA (S Spratt)** which was improving to the lead. **HE'S REMARKABLE (V Colgan)** which was trailing **FLEUR DE LUNE** had to steady.

S Spratt was reminded of her obligations when shifting ground.

FEARS NOTHING (H Tinsley) raced wide without cover throughout.

FLEUR DE LUNE shifted out under pressure passing the 100 metres momentarily hampering **XANADU (M Coleman)**.

S Spratt admitted a breach of Rule 638 (2) in that she made a celebratory gesture prior to the finish.

After consideration the Judicial Committee imposed a fine of \$300

JOY'S CHOICE (O Bosson) jumped in at the start crowding **BRACKENWOOD (D Bradley)**.

OUTBACK GIRL (R Norvall) was slow away.

GUEVARA (L Allpress) began awkwardly then commenced to over-race badly in the run down the back straight.

GUEVARA was angled out to avoid heels near the 800 metres and in doing so hampered **JACK'S POINT (K Myers)** which went back onto **BRACKENWOOD** which had to be steadied.

JOY'S CHOICE raced three wide without cover throughout.

JACK'S POINT was dictated wider near the 300 metres when **PRECIOUS TIME (C Lammas)** was angled out in search of clear running.
