RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	ROSELAND TAVERN SPRINT
<p>BELLAPIN (R Hutchings) shifted outwards leaving the barriers hampering GIFTED SAND (J Shackleton). BONDI TRAM (T Russell) began a little awkwardly then was further hampered when crowded. HEY BRUCE (C Lammas) had to be steadied off the heels of RED LEADER (A Forbes) which shifted in shortly after the start. A Forbes was advised to exercise care. BONDI TRAM over-raced in the middle stages. BELLAPIN was inclined to lay in under pressure in the final straight. BONDI TRAM shifted out under pressure near the 100 metres with ROYAL SCEPTRE (A Calder) shifting away from that runner.</p>	
Race 2	QUALITY HOTEL EMERALD 1600
<p>MISS EVERGREEN (S Collett) was slow away. SIVOCCI (M Cameron) had to be steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of SIR KEITH (J Riddell) going into the bend near the 1300 metres. LADY LINDAUER was disappointed for a run near the 250 metres. MAURRAL (H Tinsley) lay in when struck with the whip near the 150 metres and had to be straightened.</p>	
Race 3	MARTINS EVENT AND PARTY HIRE 1600
<p>MOLTO GRATO (C Grylls) was buffeted when improving into a tight run between DIAMOND LINDAUER (S Collett) and DRAGON EYE (V Colgan) near the 150 metres when both those runners shifted ground. NOAH JON (C Lammas) had to be steadied just short of the finish when MIDNIGHT PADDLE (A Calder) shifted in under</p>	

pressure.

When questioned regarding the poor performance of **MAKEBA** rider T Russell advised that the mare had been unable to quicken when placed under pressure near the 600 metres and had been disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination of **MAKEBA** did not reveal any abnormalities.

H Tinsley (**ELEGANT MADAM**) advised that the mare had not been suited by the stop start tempo of the race.

R Norvall (**ANYTHING GOES**) advised that his mount had not been suited by the firm nature of the footing.

Race 4 | **CORSON GRAIN 1350**

CORSICANA (M Cameron) shifted inwards abruptly when jumping away badly hampering **LADY SAYYIDA** (A Calder). **DA BEAST** (T Russell) began awkwardly making contact with the hindquarters of **TORRICELLA** (R Hutchings) with both runners becoming unbalanced.

NO ESCAPE (S Collett) was slow away.

CORSICANA got its head up when being steadied away from the heels of **TORRICELLA** near the 1100 metres.

MAHORA GOLD (A Forbes) raced three wide without cover throughout.

LADY SAYYIDA was held up rounding the final turn and had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.

GALAXY ROAD was held up until near the 200 metres.

Race 5 | **FARMERS AIR METRIC MILE**

THE TERMINATOR (A Calder) and **VOLKSWOOD** (H Tinsley) were slow away.

CONTEST (M Cameron) was inclined to get its head up when being restrained off heels going into the first turn.

BALDOVINO (R Hutchings) raced three wide without cover throughout.

BLACK ATTACK (C Grylls) was held up becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of the weakening **SAN PEDRO** (S Collett) rounding the final turn and early in the straight.

Race 6 | **CRAIG'S INVESTMENTS 1200**

PARVATI (R Hutchings) began awkwardly and when recovering came together and bumped with **KOOL GAL** (M Cameron). **SUNSEKA** (J Riddell) began awkwardly and shifted outwards with **PERFECTION** (A Calder) jumping inwards resulting in crowding to **MARLANDA MISS** (S Shirahama) which lost ground.

PARVATI hung outwards throughout making the final turn awkwardly.

Approaching the 300 metres **KILMORACK** (C Lammas) lay out crowding **PARVATI** onto the hindquarters of **EKRAAR**

SUPERIOR with both those runners becoming unbalanced and continuing to make contact for a distance. Near the 150 metres, when continuing to lay out away from **KILMORACK**, **PARVATI** struck a heel of **EKRAAR SUPERIOR** and blundered badly.

PEIT ROX (R Norvall) was held up passing the 300 metres.

Race 7 | **UNIVERSAL ENGINEERING/CLASSIC HITS 1200**

HAVATASTE (T Russell) was a late scratching at 4.12pm after refusing to go to the start. Trainer J Bary was advised that **HAVATASTE** is required to trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing next.

TWILIGHT DRAGON (V Colgan) was a late scratching at 4.15pm on veterinary advice at the start as it was lame in the off front leg.

BEN TENNYSON (C Lammas) was slow away.

NO CHANGE (S Collett) and **MISS SENNA** (S Shirahama) both began awkwardly and came together.

LUCKY SPIRIT (H Tinsley) raced three wide without cover throughout.

ALPHABET STREET (A Forbes) had to be steadied off heels near the 500 metres and shifted out. As a result **BEN TENNYSON** then had to shift out off the heels of **ALPHABET STREET** taking **NO CHANGE** wider on the track.

LUCKY SPIRIT made the final turn awkwardly shifting out and hampering **ALPHABET STREET, COMMAND** (R Hutchings) and **NO CHANGE**.

SAINT KITT (R Norvall) was held up near the 250 metres when well back.
