RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	TUMU ITM PREMIER
<p>REBEL'S RANSOM (M Hills) was slow to begin.</p> <p>STORMIN NORMAN (M Du Plessis) shifted out shortly after the start inconveniencing MUNGO JERRY (K Myers) who had to steady.</p> <p>AUSSIEAUSSIEAUSSIE (R Hannam) raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>HERMAN MUNSTER (L Allpress) was obliged to race three wide without cover in the early stages.</p> <p>SEAFLYTE (C Lammas) lay out under pressure passing the 300 metres resulting in MUNGO JERRY shifting out and away from that runner brushing with REBEL'S RANSOM.</p> <p>A short distance further on MUNGO JERRY lay out and brushed with REBEL'S RANSOM.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of HERMAN MUNSTER rider L Allpress stated that the gelding had been forced to work hard early when trapped wide but could otherwise offer no excuses. L Allpress further advised that the gelding would be better suited by some easing of the ground.</p>	
Race 2	TRUTEST PREMIER
<p>SUPERVISOR (J Riddell) was slow away.</p> <p>I'LL'AVA'ALF (L Innes) raced wide without cover through the early stages.</p>	

CENTAROSE (R Norvall) over-raced in the early stages.
ENUFFISENUFF (S Spratt) had to be steadied off heels near the 1000 metres when over-racing.
DANCING CHIEF (V Colgan) raced keenly throughout.
OFF THE TOP (M Dravitzki) had to be steadied near the post when in restricted room.
Connections of third placed **ENUFFISENUFF** viewed video footage with a view to a protest against the winner **HIDDEN ASSET** (O Bosson) however elected not to proceed.
S Spratt rider of **ENUFFISENUFF** was reminded of her obligation with respect to the use of the whip prior to the 200 metres.

Race 3 | **STELLA ARTOIS PREMIER**

DANCING DEE (L Allpress) and **LOOSE CHANGE** (B Grylls) were slow away.
CLASSY MATTER (R Hannam) raced wide in the early stages.
LIV'N PARADISE (J Riddell) raced wide without cover throughout.
LOOSE CHANGE (B Grylls) had to be steadied near the 900 metres when inside **RANSOMED** (L Innes) which lay in when making the turn.
IN TO WIN (J Shackleton) and **INANOFF** (M Wenn) were both held up throughout the home straight going to the line untested.
DOUBLE O SEVEN (J Waddell) was held up rounding the turn and near the 200 metres had to be steadied when attempting a marginal run between **ESTRATO** (M Coleman) which shifted in slightly and **LIV'N PARADISE** which lay out under hard riding. **DOUBLE O SEVEN** then had to be angled wider to improve.
The connections of third placed horse **DOUBLE O SEVEN** protested against second placed horse **ESTRATO** alleging interference in the final straight. After consideration the Judicial Committee dismissed the protest.

Race 4 | **WAIKATO STUD PREMIER**

JUST ISHI (D Bradley) was slow to begin.
BIG ROCKET (H Tinsley) shifted out at the start hampering **EASYSTREET** (C Lammas) which lost ground.
HUARWEE (L Allpress) raced wide throughout.
Passing the 1200 metres **SUNSEKA** (M Du Plessis) had to be steadied when racing keenly.
Near the 900 metres **WALKINGONSHINE** (J Waddell) had to be steadied when inside **BEGUILE** (M Wenn) which shifted in. M Wenn was issued with a warning.
QUINTERO (O Bosson) made the turn near the 600 metres awkwardly and ran out hampering **BEGUILE (M Wenn)** which lost momentum. When being corrected **BEGUILE** shifted in crowding **WALKINGONSHINE** for a short distance.
CALL ME MAYBE (B Lammas) hung in throughout the final straight and passing the 200 metres shifted in crowding the tiring **HUARWEE**. Also affected in this incident was **SUNSEKA** which was hampered for several strides. **B Lammas** was issued with a warning.
JUST ISHI was held up throughout for the majority of the final straight and only obtained clear running passing the 100 metres.

Race 5 | **DHL GLOBAL HAWKE'S BAY GUINEAS**

SACRED FALLS (L Innes) slipped behind then knuckled badly at the start losing considerable ground.(6L)
SILVERDALE (C Grylls) raced keenly in the early and middle stages and made the first turn awkwardly.
TRAVINO (J Waddell) raced greenly for a short distance after the start.
ADDICTIVE HABIT (H Tinsley) raced wide throughout.
TOUCH WIN (V Colgan) improved onto the heels of **SACRED FALLS** passing the 500 metres and when being steadied shifted out dictating **SWIPER THE FOX** wider.
TOUCH WIN lay in throughout the final straight and near the 200 meters shifted in making heavy contact with **SILVERDALE**.
JULINSKY PRINCE (J Riddell) raced in restricted room over the final 200 meters.
Approaching the 200 metres **TAOIST MASTER** (D Browne) lay out resulting in crowding to **ADDICTIVE HABIT** and **MOVE FASTER** (D Walker), which had to steady. A short distance further on **ADDICTIVE HABIT** and **MOVE FASTER** were again crowded when between **TRAVINO** which shifted in and away from **SACRED FALLS** and **TAOIST MASTER** which continued to lay out.
SOUTHERN LORD (O Bosson) was held up rounding the final turn until the 100 metres.

Race 6 | **BAY FORD PREMIER**

TAURUS (J Parkes) was slow away.
GOSSIPING (A Calder) shifted out at the start hampering **VINCENT MANGANO** (M Coleman) which lost ground.
RAMPANT (K Myers) was slow to begin and then raced fiercely in the run through the back straight.
CASTING STONES (V Colgan) got its head up when being steadied making the turn near the 900 metres.
GOSSIPING was held up in the early part of the home straight.
TRAPICHE (O Bosson) was held up for the majority of the home straight and went to the line without being fully tested.

Race 7	TRADERACKS STAKES
<p>ROYAL QUEEN (A Calder) began awkwardly losing ground. Near the 1300 metres BABY GUINNESS was tightened and became unbalanced when inside SHOWING OFF (A Forbes) which was taken in by FRITZY BOY (H Tinsley) which shifted in when not clear. BABY GUINNESS then shifted in making heavy contact with MIKO (R Hannam) which also became unbalanced. H Tinsley admitted resultant charge of careless riding and after consideration the Judicial Committee suspended H Tinsley's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 13th October up to and including racing on Monday 22nd October. (4 days) BABY GUINNESS then raced ungenerously throughout the back straight. PAPILIO (D Bradley) raced wide throughout.</p>	
Race 8	HASTINGS, HEART OF HAWKE'S BAY PREMIER
<p>O'STELLAR late scratched on veterinary advice at 3.45pm when found to be lame in right hind leg. BONDI TRAM (M Du Plessis) and BOLT ACTION (L Innes) were slow to begin. ST ANDREWS (O Bosson) which was obliged to race wide throughout, raced keenly when being restrained passing the 900 metres. HACKENSACK (E Lloyd) raced fiercely into the first bend proving difficult to control and near the 600 metres when being heavily restrained off heels shifted in checking SHARE THE BLAME (H Tinsley) which lost ground. Trainer W Davies was advised that a warning had been placed against the racing manners of HACKENSACK. AMERICANIDOL (M Hills) was held up rounding the turn and near the 250 metres had to be directed across the heels of DENLEE (D Bradley) to improve. When questioned regarding the performance of SAND'IOR rider J Waddell could offer no excuses. A post-race veterinary inspection of SAND'IOR revealed no abnormalities.</p>	
Race 9	NEW ZEALAND BLOODSTOCK INSURANCE SPRING CLASSIC
<p>POSTMANS DAUGHTER (D Johnson) which was fractious in its barrier prior to the start was slow away and then further hampered when GREEN SUPREME (M Du Plessis) shifted out on jumping. ZENNISTA (D Bradley) began awkwardly losing ground. ARTBEAT (N Harris) was slow away. FEARS NOTHING (H Tinsley) was tightened and lost its position approaching the winning post on the first occasion. After questioning riders it was established that POSTMANS DAUGHTER, which had commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied, shifted out abruptly simultaneously as GUISEPPINA (J Riddell) was attempting to obtain a position more adjacent to the rail. Stewards determined that the incident was beyond the control of any rider and no further action was deemed necessary. DOLEMACHE (J Waddell) was crowded and raced in restricted room over the final 100 metres when between GUISEPPINA (J Riddell), and SHEZ SINSATIONAL (O Bosson), which lay in. XANADU (M Coleman) was held up for a short distance rounding the final turn before being taken inward to improve. Stewards ordered a veterinary examination of CARRICK (L Innes) which finished in last placing. The examination revealed no abnormalities.</p>	
Race 10	2012 RUSH MUNRO SPRING CARNIVAL FINALE
<p>MUSUKO KING (H Tinsley) shifted out on jumping making heavy contact with TRADTRI (R Norvall) resulting in both runners losing ground. KAPSBOY (J JAGO) raced wide throughout. SANRIBA (L Rose) had to be steadied off heels for some distance passing the 800 metres. MUSUKO KING failed to make the final turn correctly when in restricted room and shifted out on to the heels of THE MINER'S SON (M Du Plessis) having to be checked. URUNGA (K Myers) was held up passing the 500 metres until near the 200 metres, and when taken wider to improve shifted out making contact with MUSUKO KING which was shifting ground under pressure in the final straight. SANRIBA had to be steadied when awkwardly on heels when passing the 200 metres.</p>
