RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	WAIARUHE STATION DASH
<p>MAJOR LINCOLN began awkwardly and lost ground. NICMAJAC was slow to begin. KAYZED commenced to over race when in restricted room shortly after leaving the barrier and had to be steadied for some distance. PROHIBITION raced greenly in the early stages. SPECIAL EDITION hung in rounding the final turn. When questioned into the run of ZEDEEDUDADEEKO, rider J Riddell said the gelding was awkward in its action shortly after start, raced greenly throughout but would improve with experience.</p>	
Race 2	R&D WANSBOROUGH THREE YEAR OLD
<p>ACUTELY GOLD and HIGH FASHION came together and bumped at the start. MISS PROFESSIONAL was slow to begin. I'M PERFECT raced wide throughout. I'M PERFECT, ON YER FEET and ACUTELY GOLD all raced keenly in the early stages due to the lack of pace. MISS PROFESSIONAL lay in passing the 600m and had to be steadied off the heels of GRACE WITH POWER. ACUTELY GOLD lay in over the concluding stages and had to be straightened.</p>	
Race 3	DAVID AND ELLEN OLIVER AT KONINI SPRINT

ELUSIVE ONE raced wide without cover throughout.

THE GREAT WHITE failed to run on in the straight after racing in a forward position. When questioned, rider M Hills was of the opinion the gelding was unsuited to the holding track.

M Cameron the rider of **SILVER VEIL** reported his mount was unsuited to the holding track.

HERMOSA NOVIA had to steady off the heels of the tiring **THE GREAT WHITE** near the 350m.

DAUFINO shifted out over the final 200m.

Race 4 | **RJ&C MCRAE METRIC MILE**

A veterinary clearance was received for **KINDACOO**.

ANNHEE SAPLAYA was slow away.

At the start **NGAWAKA** and **COLBY** were tightened and lost ground when runners either side shifted ground. **COLBY** then commenced to over race, had to be steadied going into the first turn then raced wide throughout.

KINDACOO raced wide without cover throughout.

When questioned into the run of **JOE COOL**, rider L Allpress could offer no excuse.

Race 5 | **PADDY & NIKKI KAURI FILLIES & MARES**

SAVAROSE, which was fractious and kicking the back gate of the barrier, underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was cleared to start.

PEIT ROX was slow to begin.

FLOSS THE BOSS and **LADY LINCOLN** were tightened shortly after the start when **DRESS TO EMPRESSNOW** lay in and away from **CORSICANA**, which was racing to its outside. A short distance further **GRACEFUL JOY** (E Lloyd) shifted in and further tightened **CORSICANA**, **DRESS TO EMPRESSNOW**, **FLOSS THE BOSS** and **LADY LINCOLN**, which lost ground. E Lloyd was advised to exercise care.

VICKI ANNE made the first corner awkwardly and when being steadied went back on to **PAIGE ME**, which had to steady off that runner's heels.

NGAWHINI was held up for some distance in the home straight prior to being angled outwards to improve near the 250m.

When questioned into the run of **CORSICANA**, which finished last, rider M Cameron was of the opinion that the filly may be feeling the effects of recent racing.

Race 6 | **JAMESON MOTOR TRIMMERS & UPHOLSTERS DISTANCE**

KOKANEE GOLD hung outwards shortly after the start causing tightening to **STUERTZER**, **POST ONLINE** and **CITADELLE**, resulting in **STUERTZER** settling back.

SAFE BREAKER was caught wide early so was taken forward to sit outside the leader going into the back straight.

KOKANEE GOLD gave ground quickly near the 400m, simultaneously as **THE LAST AL** improved on to its heels, and when being steadied **THE LAST AL** went back on to **STUERTZER**, which also had to steady and lost ground. **THE LAST AL** continued to be held up for some distance rounding the turn, prior to gaining a clear run in the home straight.

Over the final stages **RIPDIDDLER** shifted out under pressure making contact with **CITADELLE**.

Race 7 | **WATSON'S CONTINUOUS SPOUTING SPRINT**

POWERADE (C Johnson) began awkwardly and then a short distance further was tightened between **SAINT KITT**, which shifted out and **BARMASAI**, which shifted in. **POWERADE** then commenced to over race in the run along the back straight. When questioned into his lack of vigour in the home straight, C Johnson advised stewards that **POWERADE** had been agitated in the gates prior to the start and after being tightened commenced to over-race for some distance. C Johnson added that the gelding raced greenly throughout and when asked to improve near the 400 metres failed to respond to any extent after over racing in the early stages. C Johnson's explanation was noted.
