RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	C&F INDUSTRIES MAIDEN
<p>LOVETOKEEP'ER was a late scratching 10.30am after sustaining a minor laceration en route to the course. CORSICANA began awkwardly and got back. HOW TRUE and VAL VAMOOSE both shifted out near the winning post on the first occasion.</p>	
Race 2	JAMES TRUCKS AND MACHINERY 2200
<p>DESTINY COVE began awkwardly. PALM ISLAND raced keenly in the early and middle stages. ALIGNADREAMS hung out throughout and was not persevered with in the final straight. When questioned, rider K Smith advised that the mare's hanging tendency had been detrimental to its performance and added that ALIGNADREAMS may be feeling the effects of recent racing. Trainer H Bishop advised that ALIGNADREAMS would now be spelled. Following this event the track was upgraded to Good 3.</p>	
Race 3	SOUTH WAIRARAPA VET SERVICES 3YO
<p>TAIPA TIGER was a late scratching at 12.35pm after sustaining an injury in the tie-up stalls. Trainer L Latta was advised that a veterinary clearance is required prior to TAIPA TIGER next starting. MWAADAN was slow away. Shortly after leaving the barriers, LOVETESSA was crowded and steadied when outside KING KAMADA, which when racing greenly shifted out and away from ROHAISE. Also inconvenienced in this incident was WERRIBEE. STREETS AHEAD (A Forbes) shifted inwards under pressure near the 100m, into the line of SUPER SONIC, which had to</p>	

steady for a short distance. A protest was lodged by the connections of the fifth placed **SUPER SONIC** against the fourth placed **STREETS AHEAD**. After deliberations the protest was dismissed. Apprentice jockey A Forbes was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

Following the race Trainer T Riddell reported that **TALK THE TORQUE** had gone down on its heels during the running and advised stewards that the gelding would be spelled.

Race 4 THE PROFESSIONALS PATRICK & SCOTT FILLIES & MARES

HAZEL, CRISPNCOOL and **ANNIESSTAR** were slow away.

EDENSONG was held up for a short distance near the 200m.

FLAT WHITE raced greenly throughout and was not persevered with in the home straight. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed no abnormalities.

Race 5 THE ROYAL HOTEL FEATHERSTON SPRINT

REILLY O' was slow away from its wide draw then raced wide throughout and finished well back. Rider H Tinsley said the filly had been disadvantaged by its wide draw over the 1000m. A post-race veterinary inspection of **REILLY O'** failed to reveal any abnormality.

Race 6 CarFinance.co.nz LTD 1600

READY EDDIE was slow away.

SINGSTAR raced wide without cover throughout.

PEIT ROX was forced wide near the 800m. **PIET ROX** was then obliged to make its finishing run wide from the 600m.

AMBITIONS BEAUTY failed to run on to any extent over the final stages. Trainer G Lowry reported that the mare is retired. When questioned regarding the improved performance of **CAJUN**, trainer J Bary stated that at its previous start on 22 September the mare had lost ground over the early stages, however today was assisted by a better beginning. Trainer Bary further advised that **CAJUN** had been suited by the drop in class.

Race 7 BATHROOMS BY DESIGN METRIC MILE

MINNALEO had to steady off the heels of **CANSO** passing the 1400m.

MINT raced three wide throughout.

OUR CENTREFOLD was short in its action on pulling up. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed **OUR CENTREFOLD** was sore in the off fore fetlock. Connections advised the mare has been retired.

When questioned into the disappointing performance of **O'CEIRINS MAGIC**, rider J Parkes had no excuse. Connections advised the mare is retired.

Race 8 MASSONS IMPLEMENT CO LTD 1400

SUITS YOU SIR began awkwardly and was slow away.

ISEEAREDDOOR was tightened at the start and got back.

BRIMEX lay in and bumped with **POMPEI CAT** near the 300m.

When questioned into the disappointing run of **SUITS YOU SIR**, rider H Tinsley advised the gelding hung badly throughout and is retired.

When questioned into the improved performance of **BASILDON BOND**, Trainer J Bary advised stewards that the gelding was better suited to the Good3 track conditions of today.
