#### **RACE COMMENTS:**

## Race 1 TE AROHA VETERINARY SERVICES 2200

MOUNTAIN BATTLES (T Thornton) and KENS LEGACY (D Hain) were both slow to begin.

BACK BURNER (D Nolan) began awkwardly.

ROSEVALE (A Collett) and KENS LEGACY both over-raced in the early stages.

ISTIMAGIC (S Spratt) raced three wide without cover from the 1400 metres.

**MOUNTAIN BATTLES** had to be steadied passing the 800 metres when crowded for room by **GET ON IT** (O Bosson) which shifted in and away from **ISTIMAGIC**. **MOUNTAIN BATTLES** again had to be steadied off the heels of **GET ON IT** near the 600 metres and was then held up rounding the final turn.

**ROSEVALE** lay out under pressure over the final 200 metres.

VIKING CHIEF (M Du Plessis) lay in across the heels of LOGAN near the 200 metres having to be corrected by its rider.

B R Jones (LABOUR ONLY) advised that the gelding had hung and raced greenly throughout.

## Race 2 SHACKELL ELECTRICAL LTD 1200

D Walsh who was still feeling the effects of an injury suffered at Waverley the previous day was replaced on **TORETTO** by O Bosson.

**BRAESKI** (C Grylls) jumped away awkwardly and was further hampered by **SULTRY ASSASSIN** (A Calder) which shifted outwards abruptly with **BRAESKI** losing several lengths.

PROPITIOUS (R Hutchings) was slow to begin.

**TORETTO** (O Bosson) knuckled when jumping away.

**ARCHIE** (A Forbes) began awkwardly hampering **RED STORM** (L Robertson) which was crowded on to the hind quarters of **CELTIC STAR** (L Satherley).

**CLAREVILLE FLIGHT** (C Lammas) had to be steadied off the heels near the 800 metres when racing keenly.

**TORETTO** raced three wide without cover throughout.

**CELTIC STAR** was held up rounding the final turn.

CELTIC STAR shifted out when racing greenly under pressure near the 100 metres and had to be straightened.

M Cameron (**TO BE SURE**) advised that the gelding had raced greenly in its raceday debut and would benefit from the experience, further adding that **TO BE SURE** had not been assisted by its wide barrier draw and had been trapped wide throughout. M Cameron was also of the opinion that **TO BE SURE** would now be better suited over more ground.

**ARMY GIRL** (M Coleman) lost the left hind plate during the running.

#### Race 3 BIG MICKS UNDERGROUND TAKEAWAYS 1200

I'M A TAART (A Collett) was slow to begin.

**ALIGN OF FLUTES** (K Leung) jumped away awkwardly and then was further hampered when **BIG BANG BABY** (N Collett) shifted out forcing **DOLORES O'RIORDAN** (D Johnson) into that runner's line.

**SAYYAL** (L Innes) was slow to begin.

**LIGHT THE WAY** (T Thornton) and **MUMZAGRADUATE** (M Coleman) came together when both runners shifted ground at the start.

**GIRLS DON'T CRY** (S Collett) raced wide without cover throughout.

**I'M A TAART** was held up rounding the final turn before being disappointed for a run near the 350 metres and shifted outwards across heels to obtain clear running near the 150 metres.

When questioned regarding the disappointing performance of **SAYYAL** rider L Innes was unable to offer any tangible excuse. A post-race veterinary examination of **SAYYAL** did not reveal any abnormalities.

### Race 4 BARKERS FUNCTION CENTRE 1200

**SCHRODINGERS CAT** (C Grylls) which was slow to begin was then further hampered by **DONK** (A Forbes) which began awkwardly after having to force its way out of its barrier stall which front gate had not opened correctly. The Stewards filed a request for a ruling with the Judicial Committee which after viewing video footage and hearing all relevant submissions declared **DONK** to be a non-starter with all bets on that runner to be refunded.

**STRICTLY TIME** (J Waddell) was buffeted at the start between **MR KNOWITALL** (L Satherley) and **SKYDIVER** (T Thornton) which both shifted ground when jumping away.

**PRINCE OF THRACE** (M Du Plessis) began awkwardly.

**CHEQUE MATE** (S Collett) and **SCHRODINGERS CAT** came together and bumped when joining the course proper near the 800 metres. **KARAKA JACK** (V Colgan) which was following had to be firmly restrained off the heels of **CHEQUE MATE** for some distance with the saddle on **KARAKA JACK** shifting sideways badly hampering its rider for the remainder of the race with **KARAKA JACK** unable to be ridden competitively.

**SKYDIVER** lost the right front plate during the running.

#### Race 5 STANISH SIGNS 1400

SILVER MINX (A Collett) was slow to begin.

**WOWOWOW** (J Waddell) began awkwardly.

**HAPPYABOUTTHAT** (B R Jones) shifted outwards when jumping away forcing **ITSA FLUKE** (L Satherley) on to **ZAM'S DESTINY** (R Norvall) further hampering **WOWOWOW** which was crowded on to **KOZACHAK** (M Tanaka).

**UNSTOPPABLE** (T Thornton) had to be steadied and shifted out when over-racing near the 1200 metres.

**ZAM'S DESTINY** raced wide without cover and hung outwards around the bend.

SHE'S INSATIABLE (C Dell) shifted out near the 150 metres inconveniencing BELLA LADY (M Wenn).

J Waddell admitted a charge in that he had used the whip excessively on his mount **WOWOWOW** with the Judicial Committee imposing a fine of \$175.

## Race 6 STALLION PLACEMENT SCHEME 1400

HEZ COOL (C Grylls) began very awkwardly making contact with the side of its barrier stall which was forced inwards striking GRONYX (V Colgan) in the head region. As a result GRONYX became unbalanced and made contact with CALLMELOU (T Thornton) which had jumped outwards from the barriers. GRONYX then blundered when being buffeted between CALLMELOU and HEZ COOL losing several lengths. The connections of GRONYX filed an information with the Judicial Committee requesting a ruling as to whether GRONYX had been denied a fair start. After viewing video footage at length and considering submissions the Judicial Committee determined that GRONYX be declared a non-runner with all bets to be refunded.

**CHEVREMONT** (S Collett) was unable to obtain clear running for the length of the final straight.

**DUNTOILIN** (L Satherley) was held up until near the 250 metres.

**OLD GOLD** (V Gatu) was held up until near the 150 metres.

## Race 7 BAYLEYS REAL ESTATE 1400

The majority of runners were loaded for race seven when it came to the Stipendiary Stewards attention that pay-out on the previous race had not been cleared due to issues involving Australian co-mingling. All runners were removed from the barriers until payment of dividends was eventually cleared with the race then starting 10 minutes late as a result.

THE ARROW KEEPER (M Du Plessis) and NAVY BEACH (L Innes) both began awkwardly.

**ROCKFIELD BELLE** (M Coleman) and **TAAXMAN** (R Hutchings) came together at the start and continued to do so for a short distance.

BEGUILE (M Wenn) and SCOTTISH MIST (L Satherley) both raced wide without cover.

GIMME A FLYER (S Shirahama) was briefly held up near the 300 metres.

**NAVY BEACH** was held up near the 250 metres and was unable to obtain clear running for the remainder of the race.

**ROCKFIELD BELLE** and **TAAXMAN** came together near the 100 metres when both horses were attempting to obtain clear running with **ROCKFIELD BELLE** then having to be steadied.

## Race 8 MIKE FRASER-JONES 1600

This race started approximately 4 minutes late due to the delayed previous race.

**RAINMAKER** (V Colgan) jumped inwards when leaving the barriers making contact with **THE CHIFNEY RUSH** (M Du Plessis) which then crowded **SNAVE** (O Bosson) on to **ASWORTHY** (A Taylor).

TART 'N' TARTAN (T Thornton) began awkwardly crowding ROAMIN (A Calder).

Approaching the 1400 metres **THE CHIFNEY RUSH** had to be steadied to avoid the heels of **RAINMAKER** which was taken in by **PURE PLATINUM** (M Cameron). **PURE PLATINUM** then again shifted in crossing the junction on to the course proper with **RAINMAKER** having to be steadied. M Cameron was issued with a warning.

**THE CHIFNEY RUSH** shifted in and away from **ROAMIN** (A Calder) passing the 300 metres hampering **RAINMAKER**. M Du Plessis was advised to exercise more care.

L Innes (SHANSPUR) was spoken to regarding the use of his whip.

Mr S Ramsay the co-trainer of **BARBADINE** (S Shirahama) which raced poorly advised that he would be having the mare fully vetted on return to its stable and would advise any findings.

Following this race the track was down-graded to a Slow 7.

## Race 9 DIPROSE MILLER LTD 1600

**POSTAGE** (M Cameron) jumped away awkwardly and shifted out making contact with **SNEAKY SHAN** (C Parish) which in turn crowded **REGALO REAAL** (J Waddell).

**YANGMING** (A Forbes) over-raced in the early stages having to be steadled off heels and shifted out racing three wide without cover from the 1000 metres.

**YANGMING** shifted out under pressure in the straight hampering **HEAD HONCHO** (C Grylls) and **MR CHEZ** (R Hutchings) near the 250 metres.

**REGALO REAAL** lost the left hind plate during the running.

## Race 10 SUPER LIQUOR TE AROHA 1600

Mr T Wenn who was in charge of **SECRET DESIRE** (S Collett) was fined \$50 after presenting the mare to race without notified gear, namely blinkers.

ROSE L'AMOUR (M Du Plessis) and BUSTED LOVE (C Lammas) were slow away.

TINKER ROSE (T Thornton) over-raced in the early and middle stages.

LADY MARILYN (A Forbes) was inclined to shift ground under pressure in the final straight.

**MATIDA** (M Sweeney) was not persevered with in the final straight finishing a distant last. **MATIDA** was found to have pulled up sore in the right foreleg with a suspected tendon injury. Trainer Mr B Wells was advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required prior to **MATIDA** racing next.
