RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	PORRITT SAND HURDLE
	<p>CURRENCY SPIKE (M Mitchell) was slow to begin.</p> <p>CASH KINGDOM (A Ihaka) lay out approaching the first hurdle crowding HOOVER BOY (C Studd).</p> <p>CURRENCY SPIKE jumped outwards at the first fence.</p> <p>CURRENCY SPIKE put in a poor jump at the third fence.</p> <p>CURRENCY SPIKE and HOOVER BOY both hit the fence near the 900 metres.</p> <p>DERBY DAN (R Doherty) misjudged the fence near the 900 and fell hampering LIPPY (S Houston). R Doherty was uninjured.</p> <p>HOOVER BOY put in a poor jump at the third last fence and blundered badly on landing dislodging rider C Studd who was uninjured.</p> <p>THE NEMESIS (A Kuru) put in a poor jump at the second last fence.</p> <p>CURRENCY SPIKE ran down the second last fence hampering MISTER DEEJAY (J Rathbone).</p>

Post-race veterinary examinations of DERBY DAN and HOOVER BOY did not reveal any abnormalities.	
Race 2	JOEROK HURDLE
<p>SEA EAGLE (C Studd) was slow away.</p> <p>AIR CADET (E Stack) badly misjudged the second fence and fell heavily dislodging a portion of the running rail which was repaired prior to the second circuit. Rider E Stack was uninjured.</p> <p>WEST END (C Singer) jumped indifferently at the rear throughout.</p> <p>STEEL (M Mitchell) hesitated going into the fence near the 1300 metres losing ground. STEEL then jumped the next two fences in the back straight indifferently.</p> <p>SEA EAGLE hung out around the final turn with COMTE DE JEU (A Kuru) shifting out away from that runner hampering WEST END.</p> <p>THE POOKA (R Cully) jumped the last two fences poorly.</p> <p>A post-race veterinary examination of AIR CADET did not reveal any abnormalities.</p>	
Race 3	GARRARDS HORSE & HOUND HURDLE
<p>RADINKA (M Mitchell) put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1200 metres and landed awkwardly. O'CONNOR (J Rathbone) also put in a poor jump at that fence.</p> <p>RADINKA and BIG BROWNIE (A Ihaka) both put in poor jumps at the fence near the 1100 metres.</p> <p>ARURITESON (C Studd) hit the fence near the 900 metres.</p> <p>ARURITESON hit the third last fence.</p> <p>When weighing in following the race J Forbes the rider of the horse placed third by the Judge, JOEROK, weighed in under her weigh-out weight by more than the 0.5 kg allowance provided by Rule 648(3). A request for a ruling was filed with the Judicial Committee who determined that JOEROK be disqualified as per Rule 648(3). The final placings were amended accordingly with 8 FLAVOUR FLAV first, 6 ARURITESON second, 11 SILK 'N' SATIN third, 3 BIG BROWNIE fourth and 12 RADINKA fifth.</p> <p>J Forbes (JOEROK) admitted a charged under Rule 649(3) in that she had weighed in at less than her weigh-out weight by greater than the 0.5 kg allowance permitted by Rule 648(3). After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee reserved their decision on penalty.</p> <p>Following the race R Cully advised that he was feeling unwell and after being examined by the Course Doctor was stood down from him remaining engagements.</p>	
Race 4	LAMMERMOOR FARM DUKE OF GLOUCESTER CUP
<p>Amateur rider K Hillis was permitted to ride GREVE 0.75 kg over-weight.</p> <p>HE KIN TALK (A Kuru) raced wide without cover until near the 1200 metres.</p> <p>HE KIN TALK shifted in under pressure inconveniencing BELINUS (S MacNab) near the 150 metres. A Kuru was advised to exercise care.</p> <p>A Kuru (HE KIN TALK) was reminded of his obligation to ride his mounts out fully to the finish whenever circumstances permit.</p> <p>Amateur rider H Bull (BUTCH JAMES) was spoken to regarding the manner in which he used his whip in the final straight.</p>	
Race 5	MYTHS AND LEGENDS STEEPLECHASE
<p>LONG TALL TEXAN (P Ormsby) was crowded leaving the barriers clipping a heel and blundering badly. Rider P Ormsby then retired the horse from the race prior to the first fence. When questioned P Ormsby advised that after striking a heel he had had concerns with the gelding's action. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormality.</p> <p>HONEY (J Rathbone) hesitated at the first fence and jumped high losing ground.</p> <p>VICTOR LUDORUM (A Ihaka) put in a poor jump at the fence passing the 1200 metres.</p> <p>ONEKAYKARAKA (E Stack) jumped inwards at the fence near the 800 metres crowding MORPHEUS (I Lupton).</p> <p>VICTOR LUDORUM put in a poor jump at the second last fence.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of HONEY rider J Rathbone stated that the mare is inexperienced over steeplechase fences and this was the first occasion on which it had competed in a race with live fences and should benefit from the experience.</p> <p>GO JIMMY GO (C Leveque) lost both front plates during the running.</p>	
Race 6	TOM'S MYTH STEEPLECHASE
<p>NO QUOTA (C Studd) began awkwardly.</p> <p>BATATIUS (I Lupton) put in a poor jump at the fence near the 600 metres and knuckled badly on landing.</p> <p>SMOKE (S Houston) was retired from the race prior to jumping the final two fences. Rider S Houston advised that the gelding had been unsuited by today's firm track conditions.</p> <p>THOMOND PARK (J Rathbone) made contact with the inside wing when jumping the final fence.</p> <p>THOMOND PARK pulled up lame following the race. A veterinary examination found the gelding to have ruptured a suspensory in the left foreleg with trainer J Wheeler advising that THOMOND PARK was now likely to be retired.</p>	
Race 7	BAYLEYS WAIKATO HUNT GOLD CUP
<p>CAPE KINAVERAL (C Singer) misjudged the fence passing the 1200 metres and fell heavily hampering ZAGATA (M Mitchell).</p>	

C Singer was uninjured.

ZAGATA went off stride when almost coming into contact with the outside fence near the 100 metres.

A post-race veterinary examination of **CAPE KINAVERAL** found the gelding to have bled from both nostrils. As such **CAPE KINAVERAL** is to be classified as a bleeder unless clear results of an endoscopic examination carried out within six hours subsequent to the race are provided to the Stipendiary Stewards.

S Houston (**THE FOX**) was fined \$150 for making a celebratory gesture prior to the winning post.

Race 8

WAIKATO FARRIERS HIGHWEIGHT

HEZ COOL (J Forbes) began awkwardly losing ground.

MONTOPOLI (A Taylor) over-raced in the early and middle stages.

IZNOGOUD (C Leveque) and **PAPARIMU** (A Ihaka) both raced wide throughout.

HEADSHOLDTHEMONEY (S Houston) was disappointed for a run when attempting a marginal gap to the inside of **RUSSIAN HAZE** (C Dell) which shifted in slightly. **HEADSHOLDTHEMONEY** had to be steadied off the heels of **RUSSIAN HAZE** for a short distance before obtaining clear running to the inside of that runner.
