| Race 1 | Recreational Services 800 |
| FRANCES (M McNab) was slow to begin and then was inclined to lay out around the bend. DESERT VIEW (R Hutchings) had to be steadied off the heels of CROOKED STILL (O Bosson) near the 500 metres. | |
| Race 2 | Avondale Sunday Markets 1200 |
| CINZANO ROSE was a late scratching at 12.08pm after sustaining an injury prior to being transported to the racemeeting. Trainer B Foote was advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to CINZANO ROSE next racing. HOLLY ROSE (T Thornton) jumped away awkwardly. HIGH SOCIETY which proved fractious when loaded into the barriers subsequently began awkwardly and lost ground. Rider O Bosson reported that the saddle had shifted back in the early stages. CATALMA (A Calder) shifted in abruptly on jumping. HIGH SOCIETY raced greenly throughout. PACIFIC CHOICE (V Colgan) raced keenly in the early and middle stages and approaching the 800 metres had to be restrained off the heels of SPINNING DANCER (M Du Plessis) and in doing so lost ground. SPINNING DANCER was obliged to race three wide without cover throughout. AURORA LIGHTS (J Waddell) was held up rounding the final turn and had to be taken wider near the 400 metres to improve. LUCKY ORPHAN (C Grylls) hung out under pressure in the final straight and near the 150 metres shifted out hampering | |

| BASSALEG (L Innes) which had to steady and shortly after again shifted out further hampering BASSALEG momentarily. C Grylls, the rider of LUCKY OPHAN was issued with a warning and advised that he is expected to straighten his mounts when they commence to shift ground sooner than he did on this occasion. | |
| Race 3 | The Original Aussie Butcher Kumeu 1200 |
| FENDER (M Cameron) jumped away awkwardly. ALL OF THE LIGHTS (C Grylls) shifted in abruptly on jumping hampering BEL AMI (P Turner) and GRANADA (S Spratt). MRS BROWNS BOY (D Nolan) hung out making the turn. Rounding the final turn THE LIONS RULE (J Waddell) when laying out, shifted out making contact with LORD PETRUS (A Collett) which became unbalanced and lost momentum. | |
| Race 4 | Bruce Amies Pharmacy Ltd 1400 |
| GET THE MESSAGE (M Tanaka) jumped away awkwardly. SKYSOBLUE (T Thornton) was held up for clear running until the 250 metres. | |
| Race 5 | Byerley Park 1600 |
| ANDROID (M Tanaka) jumped in at the start making contact with SOLDAAD (M Sweeney) and as a result lost ground. SOLDAAD had to be restrained off heels for some distance passing the 1000 metres. SUMMERTIME LASS (K Kalychurun) shied away from the rail near the 800 metres hampering MASTER IP (V Colgan) and PEREGRINE (C Grylls). ANDROID was held up for a short distance near the 300 metres. KHALEESI (M Du Plessis) went off stride passing the 70 metres when a plastic bag blew into its path. | |
| Race 6 | Crombie Lockwood 2200 |
| VARNISH (J Whiteside) jumped away awkwardly and then was further hampered when LUCKY TONIGHT (M Cameron) shifted in. SEAMS LIKE MAGIC (R Hutchings) was held up rounding the turn and passing the 400 metres was denied a marginal run between GAYBRIANNE (A Calder) and LUCKY TONIGHT which both shifted ground. SEAMS LIKE MAGIC was further held up for a short distance approaching the 200 metres. CAPISTRANO ANGEL (N Collett) was inclined to lay out under pressure over the final stages. | |
| Race 7 | Avondale Dental 1200 |
| BLUE STREAK was a late scratching at 2.55pm on veterinary advice. THE PROPHECY (T Thornton) shifted in on jumping making contact with DIAMONDS IN TIME (A Collett). COURIER (L Robertson) raced wide throughout. | |
| Race 8 | Auckland Co-op Taxis 1400 |
| DON GALLARDO (M Du Plessis) jumped awkwardly and then blundered losing ground. Shortly after leaving the barriers the saddle on GOLDEN CUP WINNER shifted forward placing Apprentice Rider K Kalychurun in a significant disadvantage, with the gelding being retired from the event passing the 600 metres. EDDIE THE EAGLE (V Colgan) hung out under pressure in the final straight and approaching the 100 metres made contact with DEANE MARTIN (S Spratt) losing momentum. | |
