RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	FORTUNA LTD 1400
STREETS AHEAD (C Lammas) was a late scratching behind the barriers at 12.43 pm on veterinary advice as it had blood present in one nostril. MISTAAR (A Calder) and SHE'LBELITZEM (L Satherley) were both slow to begin. UNICORN EXPRESS (M Cameron) jumped away awkwardly shifting in and crowding BEAUTY GLOW (M Hills). FOOTPRINT (V Colgan) over-raced in the early and middle stages. RACQUETOR (L Innes) lay out away from UNICORN EXPRESS (M Cameron) rounding the final turn. ANGEL'S SHARE (C Grylls) was disappointed for a run between THE LAST SHOWER (N Harris) and RACQUETOR when both those runners shifted ground near the 300 metres. When questioned regarding the performance of FOOTPRINT V Colgan stated that other than racing keenly in the early and	

middle stages he was unable to offer any tangible excuse, adding that the gelding had been under pressure prior to entering the final straight being unable to quicken when asked to do so and had been disappointing. The track was upgraded to Dead 4 at 12.50 pm following race one.	
Race 2	TOPSOIL AND SAND SUPPLIES 2100
RAFA (A Calder) was slow to begin. WHISTLING STRAITS (V Colgan) jumped away awkwardly. OBERON (M Du Plessis) over-raced in the early stages. WHISTLING STRAITS over-raced in the early and middle stages. JUNGLE KNIGHT (C Grylls) was inclined to lay out throughout. PUMP UP THE VOLUME (L Innes) lay inwards under pressure over the final 200 metres.	
Race 3	CAMBRIDGE JOCKEY CLUB 1600
HAPPYABOUTTHAT was declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 12.35 pm after requiring veterinary treatment on course for a bout of colic. The gelding was then transferred to the nearby Hamilton Veterinary Clinic for further treatment. DIAMOND PETE (L Satherley) began awkwardly losing ground. ARMADIO ESTRADA (S Shirahama) which was slow to begin was further hampered when FAME MOUSE (L Robertson) shifted out when jumping away. L Robertson admitted a charge of careless riding in that shortly after the start she permitted her mount FAME MOUSE to shift inwards when insufficiently clear of FORBIDDEN (M Cameron) which was forced into the line of THENAMESBOND (J Whiteside) which clipped a heel and fell. After hearing submissions L Robertson's licence to ride in races was suspended from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 6 October until the conclusion of racing on Wednesday 31 October, 12 riding days. J Whiteside was cleared by the course doctor to fulfill her remaining engagements. When regaining its feet THENAMESBOND dislodged a portion of the running rail and suffered lacerations to the right shoulder. Trainer Mr S Ralph was advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness is required prior to THENAMESBOND racing next. CARBIDE (J Waddell), FAME MOUSE and DIAMOND PETE all over-raced badly rejoining the course proper near the 1200 metres when the pace steadied. A Forbes (THE PAPERBOY) and L Woods (SOPHIE CLAIRE) were both issued with warnings and advised that they must not ease the pace to a degree that puts other riders in difficulty. SINISTA (T Thornton) had to be steadied off the heels of POCKET OF ACES (S Spratt) near the 900 metres. CARBIDE dislodged rider J Waddell when pulling up. J Waddell was treated by the course doctor for abrasions to the right leg and passed fit to fulfill his remaining engagements.	
Race 4	EBONY GROSVÉ 1600
MISS BIENNALE (R Hutchings) jumped away awkwardly losing its footing behind and losing considerable ground becoming tailed off in the early stages. Although regaining contact with the body of the field rounding the bend MISS BIENNALE failed to quicken in the final straight and was not persevered with over the final 250 metres. When questioned R Hutchings advised that after spreading itself at the start the mare had felt a little indifferent in its action throughout. A post-race veterinary examination found the mare to be mildly lame in the right foreleg. TILDA (M Du Plessis) over-raced in the early and middle stages. TILDA and RANSOMS GOLD (C Grylls) were both unable to obtain clear running in the final straight. VANILLA (M McNab) shifted out near the 300 metres crowding SEAGOLD (S Shirahama) on to POLYANTHA (O Bosson). SENNA (J Waddell) had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight. VANILLA which was eased down over the final 150 metres was found to have bled from both nostrils and is stood down from racing for the mandatory three month period.	
Race 5	GREENE RACING @ TE RAPA 1600
MALBEC (A Collett) shifted in on jumping away crowding EL SOLDADO (A Forbes). SAVANAH RUSH (J Waddell) shifted out on jumping away making firm contact with THE TERMINATOR (A Calder) which was forced on to MEDICI (M Coleman) with both those runners losing ground. KASHIN GIRL (S Shirahama) got its head up when being restrained near the 1200 metres and dropped back on to EL SOLDADO which was hampered. MALBEC raced three wide without cover throughout. STORMING THE TOWER (J Jago) shifted out to obtain clear running near the 450 metres with OLD DRUMBLE (R Hutchings) then laying out away from that runner taking MALBEC and BRUNO (L Innes) over extra ground. KASHIN GIRL lay in making contact with KEENLY (M Cameron) near the 350 metres. KEENLY then had some difficulty obtaining clear running until near the 250 metres. STORMING THE TOWER lay inwards in the final straight and was unable to be fully ridden out.	
Race 6	HAMILTON BUILDING SUPPLIES 1200
Mr D Olson, the co-trainer of STREET PARTY (V Colgan) reported that due to a minor foot problem a pad had been applied to the off front foot. A pre-race veterinary examination passed the mare as fit to run. STREET PARTY and VINCENT STREET (S Shirahama) were both slow to begin.	

STREET LAW (K Leung) jumped away awkwardly.
QUEEN OF ROCK (R Norvall) over-raced in the middle stages making the first bend awkwardly.
STREET LAW raced three wide around the first bend until being allowed to improve forward to sit outside the leader near the 600 metres.
CAPTAIN BRO (K Kalychurun) raced wide without cover throughout.
QUEEN OF ROCK was held up rounding the final turn.
VINCENT STREET was held up near the 250 metres.
GOLD HUNTER (P Turner) shifted in under pressure in the straight hampering **ALLENDE** (J Whiteside) near the 150 metres. P Turner was advised to exercise more care.
STREET PARTY was disappointed for a run between **VINCENT STREET** and **SHE'S PRESTIGIOUS** (A Forbes) near the 150 metres when both those runners shifted ground.
CAPTAIN BRO shied passing the 150 metres when well back.

Race 7	SURETRADE BUILDING SERVICES 1200

ALL ABOUT FUN (P Turner) was slow to begin.
CONFEDERATE (O Bosson) and **OUI** (M Wenn) came together at the start with **CONFEDERATE** becoming unbalanced forcing **OUI** inwards crowding **GO JOELI** (M Cameron) on to **ROLL WITH PULSE** (J Oliver) with both **GO JOELI** and **ROLL WITH PULSE** losing ground.
AUSPICIOUS (N Harris) began awkwardly.
APACHE SKY (M Du Plessis) raced three wide without cover.
FUTURE KING (V Colgan) lay in under pressure in the straight making contact with **APACHE SKY** passing the 100 metres.
ROLL WITH PULSE was briefly held up behind the weakening **COOL GENIE** (R Hutchings) passing the 250 metres.

Race 8	CARDINAL LOGISTICS 1400

TIME LEGEND (S Shirahama) was slow to begin.
NICOLE AMY (M Tanaka) knuckled at the start and was then crowded by **HAPPYTO KEEPA** (S Spratt) which jumped outwards. **HAPPYTO KEEPA** continued to lay out in the early strides taking **NICOLE AMY** out on to **FASTNFREE** (A Collett) which was forced outwards crowding **WISECRACK** (C Lammas) and **HIGH KIN** (M Coleman) which both lost ground.
SUM UP (R Norvall) raced three wide without cover throughout.
TIME LEGEND commenced to over-race badly passing the 1000 metres and continued to do so through the middle stages.
ZARA DANCER (M Hills) also over-raced in the middle stages.
SUM UP was inclined to shift ground under pressure in the final straight.

Race 9	SVS VETERINARY SUPPLIES 1400

DE'COLLETAGE (J Jago) and **HAPPY MAN** (P Turner) lost ground when crowded at the start between **BOY STAR** which began awkwardly and shifted inwards abruptly and **XALTED** (N Harris) which also began awkwardly and shifted out.
BRAVE CENTAUR (M Hills) over-raced in the early and middle stages.
MISS PELEAR (V Colgan) had to be checked when crowded for room going into the bend near the 850 metres due to **NEARLY STOLEN** (S Spratt) laying in despite its rider's efforts to allow sufficient room. **XALTED** which was following **MISS PELEAR** was hampered as a result having to shift out abruptly off that runner's heels crowding **TORINO** (M Du Plessis) on to **BRAVE CENTAUR**.
BRAVE CENTAUR raced wide without cover throughout.
XALTED had to be steadied near the 450 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of **MISS PELEAR**.
HAPPY MAN (P Turner) was held up near the 200 metres.
MISS PELEAR had difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.
STINGRAY (M Cameron) shifted out to obtain clear running inside the final 100 metres hampering **DE'COLLETAGE**.
