## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>BROKERWEB INSURANCE BROKING 1600</b>
<p><b>ARMADIO ESTRADA</b> (S Shirahama) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>GET ON IT</b> (J Jago) shifted out abruptly leaving the barriers, hampering <b>DIDGERIDOO</b> (D Johnson), which made contact with the hind quarters of <b>REMINISCING</b> (M Coleman), which became briefly unbalanced.</p> <p><b>REMINISCING</b> attempted to buck shortly after the start, briefly going off stride. <b>REMINISCING</b> then lost its position when being steadied.</p> <p><b>SURPASS</b> (L Allpress) raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>HEADSHOLDTHEMONEY</b> (R Stam) raced wide throughout.</p> <p><b>THE HOTZ</b> (V Colgan) shifted out passing the 400 metres, inconveniencing <b>DIADEME</b> (O Bosson).</p> <p><b>ARMADIO ESTRADA</b> was held up early in the final straight.</p> <p><b>MISTER SOX</b> (C Dell) which was under pressure prior to entering the final straight went off stride passing the 350 metres, and dropped out to finish a distant last. <b>MISTER SOX</b> underwent a post-race veterinary examination, including an endoscopic examination, which found the gelding to have bled and is now subject to the mandatory three month stand down from racing.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>SEAFOOD BAZAAR 1600</b>

<p><b>THE JUNGLE BOY</b> (J Whiteside) jumped away awkwardly, losing ground.</p> <p><b>OPTIONS</b> (D Johnson) was held up early in the final straight obtaining clear running passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>Following this race the track was upgraded to a Dead (6).</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>THE LAWRENSON GROUP 2100</b>
<p><b>GLEESON</b> (A Calder) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>GLEESON</b> was held up rounding the final turn and early in the straight.</p> <p><b>POLARITY</b> (M Cameron) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the final straight, having to be straightened by its rider near the 50 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>VISION FOREST LAKE 2100</b>
<p><b>WHISTLING STRAITS</b> (V Colgan), <b>SHE'S A TOMBOY</b> (J Whiteside) and <b>OUR STAR PUPIL</b> (B Grylls) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>EL SOLDADO</b> (S Spratt) began awkwardly, with jockey S Spratt losing the use of her off-side stirrup iron, before regaining it near the 2000 metres.</p> <p><b>JUNGLE KNIGHT</b> (C Grylls) got its head up when being steadied passing the winning post on the first occasion, and continued to over race through the middle stages.</p> <p>Going into the first turn near the 1800 metres, <b>LITTLE ALFIE BROWN</b> (L Satherly) had to be steadied to avoid the heels of <b>SEAFLYTE</b> (C Lammas) which shifted in when not fully clear. C Lammas was issued with a warning. <b>EL SOLDADO</b>, which was racing tight to the inside of <b>SEAFLYTE</b>, then commenced to over-race, having to be firmly restrained for a distance. Also inconvenienced was <b>ANNIE HIGGINS</b> (L Innes).</p> <p><b>THE TERMINATOR</b> (A Calder) raced three wide without cover until passing the 700 metres.</p> <p><b>MISS ISLE</b> (J Waddell) lay in under pressure early in the straight, crowding <b>LITTLE ALFIE BROWN</b>, which was then inclined to shift away from that runner, making contact with <b>ANNIE HIGGINS</b>, which had shifted out slightly. <b>ANNIE HIGGINS</b> then became unbalanced and lay out, forcing <b>LITTLE ALFIE BROWN</b> onto the hind quarters of <b>MISS ISLE</b>, striking a heel and blundering badly near the 250 metres.</p> <p>V Colgan (<b>WHISTLING STRAITS</b>) was unable to offer any excuses for the geldings performance, other than after getting back it appeared to be difficult today to make up ground.</p> <p><b>SEAFLYTE</b> required veterinary attention for superficial injuries to the left-hind fetlock after being galloped on during the running.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>JAMES &amp; ANNIE SARTEN MEMORIAL STAKES (GROUP 3)</b>
<p><b>WARHORSE</b> (M Cameron) began awkwardly and was inclined to over-race in the early stages.</p> <p><b>SACRED FALLS</b> (L Innes) was inclined to lay in up the final straight, with <b>PURE ELEGANCE</b> (J Waddell) laying in away from that runner near the 150 metres. <b>SACRED FALLS</b> continued to lay in, making contact with <b>ROLLOUT THE CARPET</b> (M Du Plessis) passing the 100 metres.</p> <p><b>MAGIC SHAFT</b> (L Allpress) shifted out passing the 200 metres, hampering <b>WARHORSE</b>.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>NEW ZEALAND BLOODSTOCK INSURANCE 1400</b>
<p>O Bosson was unable to make the weight for <b>OUR KINGPIN</b>, being replaced by J Waddell. O Bosson was fined \$200.</p> <p><b>FAIR FLEET</b> (J Jago) and <b>CELTIC STAR</b> (L Satherly) were both slow to begin.</p> <p>Passing the 1300 metres, <b>FENDER</b> (L Allpress) became awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>KAAP'S PRINCESS</b> (C Lammas) which steadied, with <b>FENDER</b> then commencing to over-race through the middle stages.</p> <p><b>FAIR FLEET</b> raced wide throughout.</p> <p><b>OUR KINGPIN</b> (J Waddell) over-raced in the middle stages and was inclined to hang outwards, becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>KARAKA JACK</b> (V Colgan) going into the bend near the 800 metres.</p> <p><b>MARMI</b> (M Cameron) made the 800 metre turn awkwardly when racing keenly.</p> <p><b>OUR KINGPIN</b> continued to hang out badly around the bend, running wide.</p> <p><b>DELTA ROSE</b> (L Innes) had to be steadied when crowded for room near the 500 metres when <b>RUREADY</b> (C Grylls) raced greenly when shifting out. Taking into account the racing manners of <b>RUREADY</b>, C Grylls was on this occasion issued with a warning. Also hampered as a result was <b>GARDEZ LA FOI</b> (M Wenn).</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>MCCARROLLRACING.CO.NZ 1400</b>
<p><b>APACHE SKY</b> (M Du Plessis) shifted out leaving the barriers, inconveniencing <b>SECRET WHISPER</b> (M Cameron) which shifted out and crowded <b>GOLD HUNTER</b> (P Turner) which lost ground.</p> <p><b>TRENDY</b> (S Collett) knuckled shortly after leaving the barriers.</p> <p><b>HANDSOME MATES</b> (V Gatu), which was racing keenly, was crowded for room passing the 1100 metres when <b>SECRET WHISPER</b> shifted in whilst being steadied.</p> <p><b>THE MENACE</b> (C Dell) had to be steadied when racing keenly going into the 800 metre turn dropping back on to <b>HANDSOME MATES</b>, which was continuing to over-race. <b>CAIPIRINHA</b> (D Johnson) which was also over-racing when in restricted room to the inside of <b>HANDSOME MATES</b> made contact with that runner, with <b>HANDSOME MATES</b> then shifting out and making contact with the hind quarters of <b>SECRET WHISPER</b> which was badly unbalanced.</p> <p><b>APACHE SKY</b> raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>THUNDERBIRD ONE</b> (J Waddell) raced greenly in the final straight.</p>	

<b>GALSHAAN</b> (S Shirahama) was held up behind the weakening <b>PRINCE OF WALES</b> (M Coleman) passing the 200 metres and was unable to obtain clear running for the remainder of the race.	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>UNSWORTH EQUESTRIAN 1200</b>
<p><b>RED DAKOTA</b> (L Innes) and <b>VERONICA</b> (P Turner) were both slow away.</p> <p><b>OHOPE PRINCE</b> (M Sweeney) and <b>ALL ABOUT FUN</b> (A Forbes) were crowded between <b>CASSIE MAY</b> (M Coleman) and <b>BARBARIC</b> (J Waddell) near the 1100 metres.</p> <p><b>SPRINGLOADED</b> (A Calder) was inclined to get its head up when being steadied in the early stages.</p> <p><b>OHOPE PRINCE</b>, which was over-racing, did not make the bend near the 800 metres, hampering <b>ALL ABOUT FUN</b> and taking <b>AMERICANIDOL</b> (M Du Plessis) over extra ground. Also inconvenienced was <b>VERONICA</b>.</p> <p><b>ALL ABOUT FUN</b> made contact with <b>VERONICA</b> when being steadied off heels passing the 600 metres.</p> <p>M Sweeney reported that his mount <b>OHOPE PRINCE</b> had raced greenly in its first run left handed.</p>	
<b>Race 9</b>	<b>NEW ZEALAND BLOODSTOCK INSURANCE 1600</b>
<p><b>SPEEDY ROCKET</b> (R Norvall) was slow to begin and then was further hampered when <b>ROAMIN</b> (A Calder) shifted in.</p> <p><b>VALLEY DIAMOND</b> (C Grylls) was slow away.</p> <p>V Colgan was unable to offer any excuses for the disappointing performance of <b>RASTEAU</b>.</p> <p><b>PARNELL PRINCE</b> (N Harris) raced three wide without cover throughout.</p>	
<b>Race 10</b>	<b>THE READY TO RUN SALE 1600</b>
<p><b>NORTHERN GENERAL</b> (A Forbes) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>CARBIDE</b> (O Bosson) jumped away awkwardly.</p> <p><b>TRAVELLER</b> (V Colgan) over-raced when being restrained in the early and middle stages, hampering <b>BOUVIER</b> (M Sweeney) near the 1300 metres.</p> <p><b>BARNEY</b> (C Grylls) raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>TRAVELLER</b> lay in behind <b>CARBIDE</b> passing the 350 metres, and had to be corrected by its rider.</p> <p>When questioned regarding his ride on <b>TRAVELLER</b>, rider V Colgan advised that the gelding is best ridden with cover, and after electing to attempt to settle his mount early with cover behind <b>HARLEQUIN</b>, the pace had gone out of the race, and the gelding had commenced to over-race when awkwardly placed towards the rear. V Colgan further added that <b>TRAVELLER</b> had then not been suited by the slow tempo of the race under its top weight.</p> <p>M Cameron reported that his mount <b>KING ZEUS</b> appeared to have held its breath and he had recommended to the connections that consideration be given to applying a tongue tie for its next start.</p>	
<b>Race 11</b>	<b>BNZ PARTNERS 1600</b>
<p>Trainer N Robinson was fined \$50 after presenting <b>MAGIC POWER</b> without notified gear.</p> <p><b>MAGIC POWER</b> (B Grylls) and <b>YANGMING</b> (R Hutchings) were both slow to begin.</p> <p><b>HAWICK PARK</b> (M Cheung) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>C'EST MAGNIFIQUE</b> (A Calder) over-raced in the middle stages.</p>
