RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	MATAMATA HIRE CENTRE 2000
<p>SON OF CIVICS (J Jago) raced ungenerously when being restrained approaching the winning post on the first occasion.</p> <p>HEADSHOLDTHEMONEY (C Grylls) was obliged to race three wide without cover in the early stages.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of ROSEVALE (M Coleman) advised that the mare had hung inwards throughout the race and may prefer some easing of the ground.</p>	
Race 2	SPOT ON VITAL FIRE PROTECTION 1600
<p>THE DARLING ONE (L Innes) and CALL THE SHOTS (M Sweeney) both knuckled jumping away.</p> <p>ST PICASSO (P Turner) was slow to begin and was hampered by CALL THE SHOTS which shifted out.</p> <p>ENFORZA (S Shirahama) was slow away.</p> <p>BELLA LADY (D Johnson) began awkwardly.</p> <p>Passing the 1200 metres RECKON I'M READY (M Du Plessis) became awkwardly placed on the heels of JUSTACRUSIN (C Lammas) which shifted in when linking on to the course proper. I'VE GOT FAITH (C Grylls) which was following then had to steady off that runner's heels shifting back on to BELLA LADY which was hampered.</p> <p>CALL THE SHOTS commenced to over-race near the 1000 metres when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of WALSBURGS KEEPER (B Lammas).</p> <p>SILENT VICTOREE (R Hutchings) raced ungenerously when being steadied in the middle stages, and made the bend awkwardly passing the 800 metres running wide. SILENT VICTOREE then became tailed off in the final straight. Trainer C Phelan was advised that a warning would be placed against the racing manners of SILENT VICTOREE.</p>	

Race 3	MITAVITE 1200
<p>DUKE ELLINGTON (C Dell) and KALYANPUR (V Colgan) came together on jumping away when both horses shifted ground. SEE THRU (A Calder) raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>DUKE ELLINGTON made the first bend awkwardly shifting out forcing SEE THRU over extra ground. Entering the final straight KALYANPUR went briefly off stride becoming unbalanced.</p> <p>DUKE ELLINGTON was held up early in the final straight.</p> <p>DUKE ELLINGTON raced in restricted room to the inside of GIRLS ON FILM (J Waddell) inside the final 100 metres. THEBESTOFYOU (M Du Plessis) lost its near fore plate during the running.</p>	
Race 4	KILGRAVIN LODGE 1200
<p>IDAHO'S CHOICE (L Isherwood), ZABERTO (L Innes) and SALTATIO (M Cameron) were all slow to begin. HERMIONE (V Colgan) began awkwardly and shifted out making contact with AXL ROSE (M Du Plessis). HERMIONE got its head up when racing fiercely in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>IDAHO'S CHOICE made the first bend awkwardly shifting wider on the track.</p> <p>PIPEDREAMS (C Grylls) raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>HERMIONE was held up when awkwardly placed on heels entering the final straight.</p>	
Race 5	BROKERNET CENTRAL REGION 1200
<p>TANAYA (E Stack) jumped away awkwardly.</p> <p>DEECRUZ (J Waddell) was slow to begin.</p> <p>KOOL GAL (M Cameron) was slow to begin and then was hampered when GOING PLACES (M Du Plessis) shifted out. ELYSIUM (M Coleman) raced three wide without cover throughout and was inclined to lay out. Passing the 300 metres VALENCIA'S IMAGE (D Johnson) shifted out making contact with ELYSIUM when looking to obtain clear running.</p> <p>ELYSIUM was inconvenienced having to briefly steady near the 50 metres when VALENCIA'S IMAGE shifted out under pressure. D Johnson was advised she must make a greater attempt to straighten her mounts when shifting ground.</p>	
Race 6	SUPER LIQUOR 1400
<p>GOYESCAS (S Dye) and SPADES (S Shirahama) were both slow to begin.</p> <p>REVOLUTIONARY (V Colgan) shifted out leaving the barrier crowding LUCKY RUBY (M Du Plessis) on to ANGEL'S SHARE (C Grylls).</p> <p>DUE NORTH (J Waddell) shifted inwards leaving the barriers crowding VENUS RISING (D Johnson) and FADE TO BLACK (L Innes).</p> <p>JIMATO (C Dell) began awkwardly making contact with BEAUTY HARMONY (M Coleman).</p> <p>MOSQUITO (M Cameron) raced ungenerously when being steadied in the early stages.</p> <p>STIRLING BRIDGE (M Sweeney) which was over-racing became awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 900 metres and was hampered as a result.</p> <p>GOYESCAS raced keenly when being restrained off heels approaching the 800 metres shifting back on to REVOLUTIONARY which steadied and then made the bend awkwardly. KEEP ROCKING (A Forbes), MOSQUITO, LUCKY RUBY, STIRLING BRIDGE and BEAUTY PERCEPTION (A Calder) were all hampered to varying degrees as a result.</p> <p>BEAUTY HARMONY raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>STIRLING BRIDGE raced ungenerously in the middle stages.</p> <p>ANGEL'S SHARE was held up early in the final straight.</p> <p>MOSQUITO lay in under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
Race 7	A P GOLLAN REGISTERED VALUERS
<p>DARK BISHOP (A Calder) and CAP FERRAT (M Cameron) were both slow to begin.</p> <p>WOWOWOW (J Waddell) jumped away awkwardly, shifting in.</p> <p>CRISTAL HEIGHTS (C Lammas) and PERFECT START (S Shirahama) came together on jumping away.</p> <p>WOWOWOW raced keenly in the middle stages.</p> <p>HEY BRUCE (R Norvall) raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>LIFE'S IN A SPIN (B R Jones) raced greenly when placed under pressure early in the final straight.</p> <p>PERFECT START was briefly held up passing the 250 metres.</p> <p>DARK BISHOP was held up for a distance approaching the 200 metres and when shifting out to obtain clear running inconvenienced PERFECT START.</p>	

When questioned regarding the performance of **PERFECT START** apprentice jockey S Shirahama explained that the filly had travelled well in the early and middle stages, but was under pressure passing the 600 metres and had not responded in the final straight as anticipated, further adding that in his opinion **PERFECT START** may be feeling the effects of the firm nature of today's track.

Race 8

STIRLING SPORTS 2000

SEAGOLD (M Du Plessis) jumped away awkwardly.

TRUE LIGHT (S Doyle) was slow to begin.

SAVARHYS (J Waddell) jumped away awkwardly and then was hampered when runners to its inside shifted out.

YANGMING (R Hutchings) was inclined to over-race in the early and middle stages.

OLIVIA ANN (S Collett) raced three wide without cover in the early and middle stages.

Near the 500 metres **TRUE LIGHT** was inconvenienced by **DELICIANO** (L Innes) which shifted out. L Innes was advised to exercise care.

YANGMING lay out under pressure in the final stages.

L Innes (**DELICIANO**) was reminded of his obligations when riding to the finish of the race if circumstances permit him to do so.

LETMEBY (C Grylls) received veterinary attention following the race after being galloped on.

When questioned regarding the performance of **DELICIANO** rider L Innes stated that the mare had not been suited by the slow tempo of the race, but could otherwise offer no excuses. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any abnormalities.
