RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	SUPERLOO SERVING WELLINGTON & THE WAIRARAPA 2200 MAIDEN SW (2200m)
<p>On jumping RECHERCHE was crowded between ILLUMINATING and INREMISSION both of which shifted ground. BARMASAI jumped awkwardly. INREMISSION hung outwards rounding the first turn. In the early stages, PARTY ROCK and LADY LINCOLN raced keenly. READY EDDIE raced wide from the 1000 metres. Rounding the home turn BARMASAI was held up for a clear run. Near the 400 metres, PARTY ROCK (E Lloyd) became unbalanced when attempting to improve into a narrow run between INREMISSION and BARMASAI and as a result, bumped BARMASAI, became unbalanced and lost ground. PARTY ROCK was then obliged to shift inwards to obtain clear running.</p>	
Race 2	TUMU ITM BUILDING CENTRE MASTERTON 2200 BENCHMARK RATING 75 HANDICAP (2200m)
<p>BELINUS raced wide in the early stages. CANSO raced wide from the 600 metres. J Parkes reported that his mount CANSO jarred up on the firmer surface. L Allpress the rider of ANGEL MINE reported that her mount hung out from the 1000 metres and in her opinion may not have appreciated today's firmer surface.</p>	

Race 3	PETE'S JOINERY SPRINT BENCHMARK RATING 65 HANDICAP (1000m)
<p>SITA was slow to begin Passing the 900 metres LA VIE ONZE raced in restricted room to the inside of YOUTOOFAST which shifted in slightly. ELUSIVE RED raced wide rounding the home turn. In the straight LA VIE ONZE hung outwards. Near the 100 metres SHARMACK lay inwards.</p>	
Race 4	TRUST HOUSE SPRINT BENCHMARK RATING 85 HANDICAP (1000m)
<p>Shortly after the start SCARLET O'HARA was crowded between GOSSIPING and LIV'N PARADISE which shifted in slightly. Approaching the 700 metres GOSSIPING was steadied when tightened for room to the inside of THE FILLY (app J Shackleton) which shifted inwards. J Shackleton was issued with a warning and was advised that a repetition may lead to more direct action being taken. J Parkes the rider of SCARLET O'HARA reported that the mare was having its first start since May and was under pressure for the majority of the race and in his opinion SCARLET O'HARA should benefit from today's run.</p>	
Race 5	PER INCANTO @ LA STUD 3YO BENCHMARK RATING 65 HANDICAP (1300m)
<p>MIGHTY MATT jumped awkwardly, blundered and then threw its head up. Shortly after the start ROHAISE shifted out and bumped MADONNA MIA. MANU hung out round the home turn. IAMISHWARA raced wide rounding the home turn.</p>	
Race 6	TUI BREWERY, LEADING ALL THE WAY SINCE 1889 MAIDEN SW (1300m)
<p>HIGGS BOSON was declared a late scratching at 7.50am acting on a veterinary report. Trainer G Searle was advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to the mare racing again. The start was delayed when GOLDEN JUBILEE proved difficult to load. A warning was placed against the mare. Passing the 1100 metres DEL POTRO raced in restricted room to the inside of LIKE JAGGER which was taken in slightly by JACKSON STREET. JACKSON STREET raced keenly in the middle stages. COLOURFUL LADY and IRISH BEAUTY raced wide for the majority of the race. Rounding the home turn and in the early part of the straight LIKE JAGGER had difficulty obtaining a completely clear run. In the early part of the home straight GOLDEN JUBILEE was obliged to shift outward to obtain a clear run. When questioned in regards to the performance of MULAN QUEEN, rider L Allpress explained that her mount worked hard when being challenged for the lead in the middle stages and when placed under pressure in the straight, failed to respond. A post-race veterinary examination of the mare revealed no abnormalities.</p>	
Race 7	BRENDAN MEO MEMORIAL SPRINT MAIDEN SW (1000m)
<p>PIT A PAT proved difficult to load. A warning was placed against the filly. BABY GEE blundered at the start and was further hampered shortly after when KALAMANJAR shifted inwards away from the heels of MY CASTLE which shifted in slightly. READY TO RUN jumped awkwardly, shifted out and shortly after had to be steadied away from the heels of 'ER INDOORS. Passing the 900 metres, CLAN O'CEIRIN shifted outwards abruptly and bumped SHINING PEARL out across the heels of MY CASTLE. Rounding the home turn and in the straight, 'ER INDOORS hung out when placed under pressure.</p>	
Race 8	BALLANCE AGRI-NUTRIENTS 1400
<p>H Tinsley was fined \$100 under Rule 330 (3) (c) when he was found to be unable to make the weight on PIMMS TIME. B Lammas was the substitute rider of PIMMS TIME. PLATINUM DANCER jumped awkwardly with its head up and lost ground. OUR MOON SHADOW jumped inwards at the start and bumped PIMMS TIME. PLATINUM DANCER raced keenly in the early and middle stages, got its head up on several occasions and then approaching the 900 metres, shifted outwards carrying OUR MOON SHADOW further out on the track. DON'T DILLY DALLY raced wide rounding the home turn. Approaching the 150 metres, PIMMS TIME shifted outwards abruptly and bumped ANAGRAM. When questioned in regards to his ride on BELLEEK D Walsh stated that he was instructed to ride the horse in a midfield position and after beginning well, he travelled nicely but then as the pace slowed in the middle stages he found himself further back than he intended. He added that in the early part of the straight BELLEEK was momentarily placed in restricted room and after obtaining clear running passing the 200 metres, he felt the gelding ran home nicely under his urgings. D Walsh further added that it was the gelding's first run in three months and in his opinion, BELLEEK will benefit</p>	

from today's run and would be better suited on a softer track over more ground.

Jockey D Walker, the rider of **LUCKY SPUR** said that he intended to ride the gelding in a more forward position, however, when the pace steadied in the middle stages, he found himself further back than expected.

Race 9	NEW ZEALAND BLOODSTOCK INSURANCE 1400 (1400)

FAIRWAY WISH and **FRTZY BOY** raced keenly in the early stages.

ELUSIVE TRACY raced wide throughout.

BRACKENWOOD race wide rounding the home turn.

FAIRWAY WISH was held up and disappointed for a run from the 500 metres until passing the 200 metres.

Approaching the 100 metres, **GOLDEN MISS** raced in restricted room.

Race 10	FAGAN FORD METRIC MILE (1600)

BIRCHINO, LADY PLATINUM, KAPE TOWN and **SEDUCER** were all severely crowded on jumping between **PHEASANT** which jumped awkwardly and shifted out and **MINNALEO** which jumped awkwardly and shifted in.

MINNALEO raced keenly in the early stages and got its head in the air on several occasions.

Passing the 1200 **BIRCHINO** steadied to avoid the heels of **KAPE TOWN** which shifted outwards.

Near the 1000 metres when the pace steadied, **KAPE TOWN (D Walsh)** improved quickly and in doing so crowded

PHEASANT, MINNALEO and **SEDUCER**. Jockey Walsh was issued with a warning and was advised that a repetition may lead to more direct action being taken.

SEDUCER raced wide from the 1000 metres.

In the early part of the straight, **DRIFT** was held up when unable to obtain a clear run and near the 200 metres, became unbalanced after coming together with **KAPE TOWN**. As a result, **DRIFT** became unbalanced, shifted in and hampered

PHEASANT which was losing ground.

Post-race veterinary examinations of **PHEASANT** and **CHAIR UP** revealed no abnormalities.
