MY SENTIMENTS (T Thornton) refused to enter its barrier stall and was late scratched at 12.22 pm. Trainer D Flavell was					
advised that <b>MY SENTIMENTS</b> will need to barrier trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing next.					
SUAREZ (M Coleman) jumped away awkwardly and then knuckled losing ground.					
When questioned regarding the performance of <b>DAN THE MAN</b> M Cameron advised that he had been instructed by the					
connections to ride the colt off the pace and in doing so it had been reluctant to gallop amongst other runners.					
Race 2	MONOVALE SAND 1400				
LUV TO SEA (B Hutton) was slow to begin.					
TE ATATU PRINCESS (K Chiong) and SMART ODDS (K Leung) came together on jumping away.					
STRIKEONCE (J Whiteside) shifted in leaving the barrier inconveniencing LASTING TOUCH (A Morgan).					
CASTLZEBERG (A Forbes) raced ungenerously in the early stages.					
ZABERTO (S Shirahama) over-raced in the early and middle stages.					
Approaching the 900 metres JIMATO (C Dell) raced in restricted room between MAGIC EPIC (T Barnabas) which was laying					
in and STRIKEON	<b>CE</b> which was laying out with <b>STRIKEONCE</b> then making the bend awkwardly shifting out abruptly further				
hampering <b>JIMATO</b> which lost ground with <b>MAGIC EPIC</b> and <b>JIMATO</b> then racing wide for the remainder of the race.					

Approaching the 700 metres **CASTLZEBERG** had to steady when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **STRIKEONCE**. **ZABERTO** was held up making the final turn when awkwardly placed on the heels of **RESUME** (B Grylls). Passing the 400 metres **STRIKEONCE** shifted out inconveniencing **TE ATATU PRINCESS**.

Race 3 BEVERLEY PRICE MEMORIAL 1200

SHEEZ ALL HEART (T Thornton) and PLAY THE ACE (A Calder) both jumped away awkwardly.

VALOREPHIN (S Spratt), WONDERLAND (M Du Plessis), LITTLE ROCKET (J Waddell) and STICKY DATE (S Collett) all lost their footing when leaving the barrier.

Shortly after the start SECRET'S ONLY (D Johnson) shifted out crowding WONDERLAND, VALOREPHIN and SHEEZ ALL HEART.

Shortly after the start **DANZA LASS** (C Dell) commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied and then shifted away from **SECRET'S ONLY** which was steadying off the heels of **BIDDABLE** (O Bosson) which shifted in. **DANZA LASS** lost ground as a result. O Bosson was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

JERSEY GIRL (C Grylls), RIO ROSE (M Coleman), SECRET'S ONLY and PLAY THE ACE (A Calder) all made the bend awkwardly near the 900 metres.

Approaching the 800 metres **DANZA LASS** and **SHEEZ ALL HEART** became awkwardly placed inside the heels of **SECRET'S ONLY** having to be steadied.

JERSEY GIRL lay out under pressure in the final straight.

Race 4 WENTWOOD GRANGE 1200

LILLY BELLE was declared a late scratching at 11.05am on veterinary advice after injuring itself in transit.

SIGARSA (O Bosson) lost its footing when leaving the barrier and made contact with BETWEEN DREAMS (R Hutchings).

**SONATA** (J Waddell) lay in after leaving the barriers crowding **THEBESTOFYOU** (M Du Plessis) which steadied.

**SOPHIE'S GEM** (M Cameron) jumped away awkwardly and then was further hampered when **SERENANOVA** (A Calder) shifted out.

**RIVER MOY** (A Forbes) raced wide throughout and made the final bend awkwardly running wider.

**ERIS** (S Spratt) shifted in under pressure from near the 200 metres crowding **SIGARSA** which became briefly unbalanced near the 100 metres. S Spratt was issued with a warning and advised she must make a greater attempt to straighten her mounts when they are shifting ground.

**SIGARSA** and **ERIS** raced in restricted room over the concluding stages between **SONATA** and **THEBESTOFYOU** which shifted away from **SOPHIE'S GEM**.

Following the race the connections of the fifth placed horse **SIGARSA** lodged an objection against the fourth placed horse **ERIS** alleging interference in the final straight. After submissions by all parties the JCA upheld the protest with placings now reading 6 and 8 dead-heat, 18, 4, 10.

**SIGARSA** lost its off front plate during the running.

## Race 5 WILLIAM INGLIS & SON 1200

AIMEES GOLD (T Thornton) lost its footing leaving the barriers.

TREPIDATION (O Bosson) was slow to begin.

**ONE ABOVE** (J Waddell) raced wide without cover throughout.

**VUELA** (M Wenn) made the bend awkwardly passing the 900 metres.

M Du Plessis the rider of **MY BLOSSOM LADY** advised that the mare had felt short in its action. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

## Race 6 COOLMORE AUSTRALIA 1600

**GILMOUR'S GIRL** was a late scratching at 2.56 pm as it refused to go to the start. Trainer W Phillips was advised that **GILMOUR'S GIRL** must barrier trial to the satisfaction of a Stipendiary Steward prior to racing next.

OUR KINGPIN (O Bosson) shifted out on jumping away and inconvenienced VIVA LA VIDA (C Dell).

IRA BEAN (M Tanaka) was slow to begin.

VIVA LA VIDA raced fiercely in the early and middle stages.

**OUR KINGPIN** was inclined to hang out throughout the race and shifted out making the final bend placing rider O Bosson at a disadvantage. When questioned O Bosson advised that the gelding had been inclined to hang previously on left-handed tracks and in his opinion is better suited to racing right handed. A post-race veterinary examination of **OUR KINGPIN** revealed a slower than normal recovery rate, and the gelding is to undergo a further veterinary examination in days subsequent.

**SULTRY ASSASSIN** (A Calder) lost its footing near the 450 metres. **SULTRY ASSASSIN** was then held up near the 250 metres and shifted in to obtain clear running.

ZARAZEN (M Wenn) was briefly held up passing the 100 metres.

**CROMBIE LOCKWOOD BLOODSTOCK 1600** 

MRS NEAT (M Coleman) became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 100 metres having to be steadied by its rider.

Race 7

MUTT WILLIAMS (R Hutchings) and GENUS (O Bosson) came together on jumping away.

**QUEEN OF CLUBS** (T Thornton) knuckled when leaving the barrier.

**PICTURE PERFECT** (R Norvall) and **DUBLEEAGO** (M Du Plessis) came together on jumping away.

SUNOFAGUN (J Waddell) over-raced when being restrained passing the 1200 metres.

**DUCHESSOFCAMBRIDGE** (A Calder) raced ungenerously in the middle stages.

FIFTYSHADESOFGREY (P Turner) changed ground passing the 300 metres to obtain clear running.

Near the 200 metres **SQUARE CIRCLES** (V Colgan) had to be steadied when laying in across the heels of **MUTT WILLIAMS** which shifted out slightly.

When questioned regarding the performance of **HER TO ETERNITY** M Cameron explained that in his opinion the stop start tempo of the race had not suited the filly.

**HER TO ETERNITY** lost its off front plate during the running.

Race 8 LANGSFORD CONTRACTING 1600

COOGEE FLYER (J Waddell) began awkwardly hampering ASTANA (M Tanaka).

BAZA (D Hain) and BOSPHORUS (M Cameron) began awkwardly.

**BOSPHORUS** raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages making the turn passing the 900 metres awkwardly. **BOSPHORUS** was then eased down in the final straight when tailed off. When questioned M Cameron reported that the mare had failed to hit out at any stage. A post-race veterinary examination of **BOSPHORUS** revealed a slower than normal recovery rate, with the mare showing signs of having choked down.

Passing the 400 metres **MOSQUITO** (V Colgan) lay in when making the final bend making contact with **MEMORY** (L Innes). **MEMORY** then lay out when placed under pressure.

KOZACHAK (M Du Plessis) raced wide throughout.
