RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	EAGLE CLOUD SERVICES 1400
<p>LITTLE JACK (L Innes) was slow to begin. HARDTALUVA (M Du Plessis) shifted in leaving the barriers, crowding MAGIC EPIC (M Coleman) which was steadied. IMPEL (J Waddell) knuckled when leaving the barriers. JACK'S RUN (V Colgan), LITTLE JACK, ISDABICKY (T Thornton) and MAGIC EPIC all over raced approaching the 1200 metres when the pace steadied with ISDABICKY and MAGIC EPIC both having to be steadied near the 1100 metres. LITTLE ROCKET (J Whiteside) raced three wide without cover throughout. IMPEL was inclined to lay out in the final straight. When questioned regarding the performance of HARDTALUVA which was eased down in the final straight, rider M Du Plessis stated that the mare had travelled comfortably enough until placed under pressure passing the 600 metres from where it had been quickly beaten and felt indifferent in its action. A post-race veterinary examination found the mare to have suffered from Cardiac Arrhythmia. Trainer S Wenn was advised that HARDTALUVA must trial with a veterinary certificate of fitness including ECG required prior to racing again.</p>	
Race 2	DUNSTAN FEEDS CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER
<p>RANSOMS GOLD (M Du Plessis), DIVINE SPACE (J Waddell) and MISS JAYDEEJAY (O Bosson) began awkwardly. Near the 1800 metres VIKING CHIEF (L Innes) got its head up when being steadied and dropped back onto MAKERS MARK (S Spratt) which was hampered. MAKERS MARK then continued to race ungenerously when being restrained and when negotiating the crossing near the 1600 metres shifted in taking THE NAMESBOND (A Calder) inwards crowding DIVINE SPACE (J Waddell). S Spratt was issued with a warning and advised that she must make a greater effort to relieve pressure.</p>	

KING ZEUS (V Colgan) raced three wide without cover.
DIVINE SPICE and **PENUMBRA** (C Dell) came together near the 1500 metres. **PENUMBRA** then shifted in crowding **DIVINE SPICE**. C Dell was advised to exercise care.
IDALMAR (M Sweeney) over-raced in the middle stages.
ARMADIO ESTRADA (S Shirahama) was held up rounding the final turn and early in the straight until obtaining clear running passing the 300 metres.
BOUVIER (M Wenn) was held up until passing the 300 metres.
RANSOMS GOLD was held up near the 300 metres.
When questioned regarding the performance of **MISS JAYDEEJAY**, O Bosson stated that the mare got further back than intended and had failed to recover. A post-race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.
When questioned the performance of **HE KIN TALK**, M Cameron stated that the gelding had switched off early in the race.
ARMADIO ESTRADA (S Shirahama) lost the near front plate during the running.

Race 3 | **HYLAND RACE COLOURS 1100**

FUTURE KING (V Colgan) was crowded shortly after leaving the barrier when **MUMS APPARITION** (L Satherley) shifted out slightly.
SEA MAJOR (M Du Plessis) began awkwardly.
SPIRIT OF WYUNA (M Wenn) raced three wide without cover.
PINZARRA (S Spratt) hung outwards throughout.
SPIRIT OF WYUNA hung outwards rounding the final turn with **SCHOONER BAY** (O Bosson) laying out away from that runner forcing **BILLY BINGO** (M Cameron) over extra ground. **SCHOONER BAY** continued to lay out in the final straight.

Race 4 | **LINDAUER 1100**

SPIN DOCTOR (S Spratt) was removed from the barriers after being fractious and passed fit to run following a veterinary examination.
PRESTIGIOUS MISS (V Colgan) was slow to begin.
FARAWAY EYES (L Innes) was inconvenienced shortly after jumping when **GOLDMINER** shifted out.
Approaching the 800 metres, **GOLDMINER** (K Leung) had to be steadied when becoming awkwardly placed.
SANDBLASTER (C Dell) raced three wide without cover.
FARAWAY EYES was held up for a short distance passing the 200 metres.
SANDBLASTER lost the off hind plate and **THE MINER** (A Calder) the near hind plate during the running.

Race 5 | **EAGLE MAGIC FISHING CHARTERS 1400**

DIAMONDS IN TIME (C Grylls) knuckled leaving the barriers.
RUREADY (O Bosson) shifted out leaving the barriers crowding **KILLARNEY KID** (A Calder) and **VALBUENA** (J Waddell).
THE TIDY EXPRESS (V Colgan) which began awkwardly was crowded shortly after losing ground.
OHOPE PRINCE (M Sweeney) began awkwardly
DUNTOILIN (L Satherley) was slow to begin.
Approaching the 1200 metres **ELUDE** (D Johnson) was steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of **RUREADY** (O Bosson).
OHOPE PRINCE over-raced near the 1200 metres becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of **RIOT ACT** (S Spratt).
VALBUENA which had commenced to over-race got its head up when being restrained and shifted out across heels striking a heel and blundering passing the 1100 metres. Badly hampered as a result were **THE TIDY EXPRESS** (V Colgan) and **OHOPE PRINCE**. **VALBUENA**, which continued to race ungenerously then shifted back in crowding **DUNTOILIN**.
MYTSHARP (M Coleman), **CHARLI JAY** (M Wenn) and **RIOT ACT** (S Spratt) all raced wide.
SNIPPECHEE (T Thornton) lay in rounding the final turn placing **RUREADY** in restricted room passing the 600 metres.
Entering the final straight passing the 400 metres, **DIAMONDS IN TIME** shifted out from behind the weakening **RUREADY** dictating **KILLARNEY KID** outwards. **PEARLE LUSTRE** (S Shirahama) which was laying inwards then shifted in hampering **KILLARNEY KID** near the 200 metres. S Shirahama was advised to exercise more care.
ELUDE and **DUNTOILIN** were held up over the final 150 metres.
THE TIDY EXPRESS lost the off hind plate during the running. **VALBUENA** lost the near front plate and was reported to have been galloped on.
RUREADY, which was eased down in the final straight, underwent a post-race veterinary examination revealing the gelding to be suffering from Cardiac Arrhythmia. Trainer C Wood was advised that **RUREADY** must trial with a veterinary certificate of fitness including ECG required prior to racing again.

Race 6 | **TREVOR EAGLE MEMORIAL 3YO**

DORIAN GREY (R Hutchings) and **MATO GROSSO** (A Calder) both began awkwardly and came together.
HABIBI (M Cameron) knuckled leaving the barriers becoming unbalanced and was inclined to lay out throughout the race.

Race 7 | **STAPLES RODWAY 1400**

CAPTORG (A Calder) began awkwardly losing ground then raced ungenerously in the early stages.
MOSH PIT (C Grylls) lost its footing jumping away and knuckled.
CAPTORG got its head up when being steadied when racing in restricted room going into the bend near the 1000 metres.
CAPTORG continued to race ungenerously for some distance.
BILLIE JEAN KING (T Thornton) raced three wide without cover.

DARCI'S GOLD (M Cameron) shifted out to obtain clear running near the 350 metres hampering **MA BELLE AMI** (R Hutchings), which crowded **BILLIE JEAN KING** onto **MOSH PIT**. M Cameron was issued with a warning. **MA BELLE AMI** was then inclined to lay out away from **DARCI'S GOLD** when racing in restricted room.
MOSH PIT lay in under pressure inconveniencing **BILLIE JEAN KING** near the 150 metres.

Race 8 | **EAGLE TECHNOLOGY STAKES**

ROCHALLEN (M Sweeney) shifted in leaving the barriers making heavy contact with **ALEGRIO** (A Calder) which became unbalanced.

MY SCOTSGREY (J Jago) which was slow to begin was lost for speed in the early stages. J Jago advised that the gelding had felt sluggish and been outpaced throughout.

SADIST (V Colgan) and **CAT WOMAN** (R Hutchings) were slow to begin

SADIST over raced in the early stages when being restrained.

SHUKA (L Innes) was briefly held up near the 300 metres shifting in across the heels of **FLASH HAPI** (S Spratt) to obtain clear running. **SHUKA** was then inclined to lay in when shifting out across the heels of **VIADANA** (M Du Plessis) near the 50 metres.

SPECIAL DAYS (R Jones) shifted out under pressure hampering **SADIST** near the 100 metres.

Race 9 | **DUNSTAN FEEDS CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER**

QUICKASUCAN (D Johnson) and **HAERE MAI** (S Collett) were both slow to begin.

Shortly after the start **TAAXMAN** (J Whiteside) lay out placing **ALFONZE** (S Shirahama) in restricted room. **ALFONZE** was steadied as a result.

BRAVE CENTAUR (O Bosson) raced wide in the early stages.

RUBY LIPS (V Colgan) over raced in the middle stages and when being steadied near the 900 metres shifted out inconveniencing **ALFONZE**. **RUBY LIPS** then continued to over race when three wide without cover around the bend.

ALFONZE was crowded for room passing the 600 metres between **HAERE MAI** (S Collett) which shifted out slightly and **THE MENACE** (C Dell) which lay in resulting in **ALFONZE** being steadied near the 500 metres when **HAERE MAI** was taken out further by **SHAN'S JOY** (R Hutchings) which shifted out off the heels of **TAAXMAN**.

TAAXMAN was steadied when held up near the 500 metres and was unable to obtain clear running for the length of the final straight.

SHAN'S JOY was held up briefly early in the final straight.

THE MENACE shifted out under pressure over the final stages.

Race 10 | **AUCKLAND CO-OP TAXIS 2100**

XALTED (J Waddell) **EVEREADY TO DANCE** (D Johnson) and **HARLEQUIN** (V Colgan) were all crowded between **OBERON** (M Du Plessis) and **HIACE** (S Shirahama) which both shifted ground leaving the barriers.

LE MOUSSIER (M Cameron) began awkwardly and shifted out hampering **JED** (C Grylls) which clipped a heel losing ground.

POLYANTHA (O Bosson) began awkwardly.

SAVED BY THE BELL (M Sweeney) commenced to hang out leaving the straight on the first occasion when being steadied near the 1700 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **LE MOUSSIER**. **SAVED BY THE BELL** continued to hang out for the remainder of the race.

HIACE over raced in the early and middle stages.

RHYTHM DIVINE (C Dell) raced wide without cover.

J Waddell admitted a charge of careless riding in that he permitted his mount **XALTED** to shift outwards when not sufficiently clear of **SAVED BY THE BELL** which was checked near the 500 metres. After hearing submissions, the Judicial Committee suspended J Waddell's licence to ride in races from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 8th December until the conclusion of racing on Friday 14th December, 4 riding days. Also hampered in this incident was **MISS HERB** (J Whiteside).

JED was held up behind the weakening **OBERON** near the 300 metres.

POLYANTHA lay in under pressure in the final straight.
