<p>LIFE'S IN A SPIN (B R Jones) was slow to begin.</p> <p>THE DARLING ONE (L Innes) was crowded shortly after jumping away losing ground due to inward movement from GUESS WHAT (N Harris). Also contributing was outward movement from ISTILANE (M Du Plessis).</p> <p>SOCIETY RULER (K Joyce) lost its footing rounding the bend near the 1400 metres.</p> <p>SKAI GLEN (T Thornton) over-raced through the middle stages.</p> <p>GUESS WHAT lost its footing behind passing the 800 metres.</p> <p>SOCIETY RULER lost its footing approaching the 400 metres and then shortly after became unbalanced losing its footing on a second occasion when bumped by THE DARLING ONE which had lost its footing badly when receiving slight contract from ISTILANE. Hampered as a result was TRALEE (J Waddell).</p> <p>TRALEE raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>Following this race where several runners had encountered difficulties with their footing a track inspection was undertaken involving Stipendiary Stewards, Club Officials and senior riders. During this inspection numerous slip marks were apparent in the area between the 600 metres and the 400 metres with it being the unanimous view of the Inspection Committee that the track was unsafe for further racing. Accordingly the remainder of the meeting was abandoned.</p>
