<b>Race 1</b>	<b>NRM 2YO 800</b>
<b>DUBLIN</b> (M Tanaka) was slow away.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>PACIFIC SPHERE 1200</b>
<b>VIBRANT</b> (L Innes), <b>JAGERSFONTEIN</b> (T Thornton) and <b>JACKIE DANIELS</b> (S Shirahama) were all slow away. <b>STATHAM</b> (N Harris) and <b>HOLLY DEE</b> (J Waddell) came together approaching the 900 metres when <b>STATHAM</b> raced ungenerously. <b>VIBRANT</b> lost its footing passing the 900 metres when making the bend. <b>STATHAM</b> continued to race ungenerously and lost its footing passing the 800 metres. <b>EWENIGHT</b> (M Sweeney), <b>VIBRANT</b> and <b>FLYING TREASURE</b> (O Bosson) all lost their footing approaching the 600 metres. <b>FLYING TREASURE</b> again lost its footing near the 500 metres. Immediately after this race a number of riders expressed concerns with the footing during the race with several riders advising that their mounts had slipped at various points rounding the bend. An Inspection Committee comprising of	

Stipendiary Stewards, Club Officials, senior riders and trainers inspected the area following which it was the unanimous decision that the track was unsafe for further racing today. Accordingly the remainder of the meeting was abandoned.
