RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	BEDPOST HASTINGS 2000
<p>D Walsh replaced T Harris on KUWAIT. T Harris was fined \$200 under Rule 605 (1) for failing to present himself in the jockey's room by the required time.</p> <p>BOSPHORUS (C Lammas) began awkwardly and was slow away. BOSPHORUS over-raced in the early stages and got its head up rounding the first turn.</p> <p>NO ESCAPE (B Lammas) hung outward for a distance rounding the first bend and lost ground.</p> <p>TRAPTHEBOYZ (M Tanaka) was bumped near the 250 metres when KUWAIT was angled out for a clear run.</p> <p>Stable representative T Hazlett reported that BOSPHORUS required post-race veterinary attention after making respiratory noises in the tie up stalls. The veterinary examination, which included an endoscopic examination revealed the mare had swallowed a clod of earth.</p>	
Race 2	RED BADGE SECURITY 1400
<p>CHAPEL JAZZ (D Bradley) began awkwardly and was further hampered when GOLDEN JUBILEE (L Satherley) shifted out. A short distance further GOLDEN JUBILEE, CINNA MISS (B Hutton), LUCY LINCOLN (B Grylls) and COLOURFUL LADY (J Parkes) were all tightened when ROSEHIP (M McNab) shifted outwards abruptly.</p> <p>ROSEHIP raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>LITTLE DRAGON GIRL (B Lammas) raced greenly in the home straight and shifted in passing the 100 metres momentarily hampering LUCY LINCOLN and ROSEHIP.</p> <p>L Satherley the rider of GOLDEN JUBILEE was reminded of her obligations regarding the use of her whip prior to the 200 metres.</p> <p>SECRET LOVE (M Tanaka) was held up early in the home straight.</p> <p>Track conditions were upgraded to Good 3 following this event.</p>	
Race 3	NEW ZEALAND BLOODSTOCK INSURANCE 3YO
<p>KEEN TEMPO (D Bradley) shifted out when leaving the barriers dictating ADIOS (R Jones) outwards.</p> <p>ZULU BOY (B Lammas) was tightened when leaving the barriers and lost ground.</p> <p>HAVATASTE (M McNab) raced greenly in the early and middle stages when wide.</p>	

When questioned into the improved performance of LITTLE ROCKET (B Grylls), trainer R Manning attributed the improvement to the Good 3 track and the addition of blinkers. ZULU BOY was held up early in the home straight.	
Race 4	BEST TRAVEL 2100
LIV'N PARADISE (B Lammas) became fractious in its gate and after undergoing a veterinary check, was cleared to race. When questioned into the performance of LIV'N PARADISE which finished well back jockey B Lammas was of the opinion that the mare was better suited to any easing of the ground. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any significant abnormality.	
Race 5	WINDSOR PARK KARAKA YEARLINGS 2013
THE BEAUT (A Morgan) began awkwardly and made contact with COUNT DE LOREE (K Smith). PHEASANT (J Parkes) was slow way. COUNT DE LOREE had to be restrained off heels when racing keenly near the winning post on the first occasion. JUST AS WELL (M Dee) raced wide rounding the first turn before improving to the lead passing the 1200 metres. When questioned into the performance of MONEYFOR JAM which finished well back jockey B Lammas was of the opinion that the mare was better suited to any easing of the ground.	
Race 6	RUSSELL ROADS CITY OF HASTINGS CUP
HAVE NO MERCY (B Grylls) began awkwardly. OUTBACK GIRL (R Hannam) raced keenly in the early and middle stages. MI PAYDAY (L Satherley) which ran last returned to the enclosure noticeably sore. A post-race inspection revealed the mare to be lame in the right fore. Connections were advised the mare would need a clearance.	
Race 7	RUSSELL LIVESTOCK 1400
OUTSHINE (D Walsh) was hampered on jumping when WORKINGCLASS (J Parkes) jumped inwards and lost ground. BRAGGING RIGHTS (L Satherley) was held up rounding the final turn. OUTSHINE was held up and unable to improve throughout the final straight. When questioned into the run of NOTHING TRIVIAL which got well back in the early stages rider B Lammas said the gelding was lost for early speed despite his attempts to keep pace with the field. B Lammas was of the opinion the gelding raced greenly and would improve with experience.
