<b>Race 1</b>	<b>MCKENZIES'S ELECTRICAL/R E SOLUTIONS 2200</b>
KINDACOO over raced throughout.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>B&amp;B CONTRACTING MAIDEN 3YO</b>
ST'RUTH lay on the side of its gate and was slow away. APLOMB was inclined to lay in down the home straight.	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>carfinance.co.nz 1300</b>
SUNSEKA blundered at the start but recovered quickly. EXCEEDING A DREAM was held up for a short distance prior to entering the home straight. MR WOOHOO was trapped wide throughout. Rider K Smith considered this to be a factor in the gelding's failure to run on over the concluding stages.	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>MARQUIS HOTEL CARTERTON 1250</b>
The start of this race was delayed by 2 minutes at the request of the TAB. LIGHTNING LUCY blundered badly at the start and dislodged rider L Allpress who was stood down for one race. LIGHTNING LUCY suffered superficial abrasions to the mouth and nose area as well as the hind legs. FLORAL SCENT was shifted wide on the turn and had its chance affected by the riderless LIGHTNING LUCY.	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>THE WAIRARAPA TIMES AGE DASH</b>
K Myers replaced L Allpress on MELS EVIE I'M SAM was tightened at the start and settled back. Shortly after the start, WEE JEAN was tightened after MISS SING shifted in and away from REBOUND when racing greenly. H Tinsley (REBOUND) was advised to exercise care when in similar circumstances. R Hannam (WOLVERHAMPTON) was reminded of his whip use prior to the 200 metres.	

<b>Race 6</b>	<b>RAT TAT 1400</b>
<b>JERRICO</b> was slow away. <b>JACK'S BOY</b> lost its footing at the start.	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>POPE &amp; GRAY CONTRCTORS LTD 1600</b>
<b>MAJOR LINCOLN</b> lost ground on jumping away when runners either side shifted ground. <b>C Dell (MISS SERENA)</b> dropped his whip near the 200 metres. When questioned on the performance of <b>KEVILDO, B Lammas</b> said the gelding may prefer the cut out of the ground.	
<b>Race 8</b>	<b>QULITY DEMOLITION &amp; CONTRACTING (2011) LTD MAIDEN</b>
<b>LAJUCCA</b> began awkwardly and lost ground. <b>RUGER</b> raced keenly in the early and middle stages. <b>C Dell</b> reported that <b>RUGER</b> may have held its breath. <b>LAJUCCA</b> and <b>SANIANI</b> bumped when both runners were under hard riding near the 250 metres. <b>MADAM ZENNO</b> dropped out to finish a long last after racing wide without cover throughout. Rider <b>D Walsh</b> said he felt something was amiss with the mare. A post-race veterinary examination of the mare failed to reveal any abnormality.
