RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	MCI AND ASSOCIATES / MORRIS AND BAILEY SPRINT
<p>TARTAN RED AND FOREVER DREAMING both began awkwardly and settled back.</p> <p>GWYNETHANNE was slow to begin and was observed to be making up ground at the finish. Rider R Myers was of the opinion that filly may be better suited to a longer distance.</p> <p>PROHIBITION was observed to be under pressure with 800 metres to run and continued to drift finishing several lengths last. When questioned, L Allpress could offer no explanation for the poor performance. A veterinary inspection failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.</p>	
Race 2	CROWLEY FORGE MASTER FARRIERS LIMITED JUVENILE
<p>IRISH STRINGS began awkwardly, lost ground and was then slow into stride.</p> <p>CELTIC WOMAN was slow away.</p> <p>PASS IT ON hung outwards badly from the 800 metres and despite the rider's efforts, extinguished its chances by running very wide on the corner. Rider H Tinsley considered the gelding to be shin sore. Connections were advised that the gelding must trial to the satisfaction of the Stewards prior to its next start.</p> <p>SERENE STAR hung outwards in the home straight and had to be continuously straightened.</p> <p>CHARLESTOWN lost a front plate during the running.</p> <p>CELTIC WOMAN lost the near side front plate during the running.</p>	

Race 3	PRENTERS READY MIX CONCRETE OPEN
<p>T Harris informed the Stewards at 8.00am that he was unable to make the weight for ISLINGTON BAY and was replaced by J Parkes. T Harris admitted a breach of Rule 330 3 (c) and was fined the sum of \$200.</p> <p>JAGGARD jumped outwards abruptly at the start hampering ISLINGTON BAY which got back.</p> <p>SHESALLJAZZ hung inwards at the start into the line of PRINCESS KATIE which settled back. Also hampered was QUEEN OF THE CASTLE.</p> <p>JAGGARD was held up behind the weakening SHESALLJAZZ for some distance early in the final straight</p> <p>PRINCESS KATIE was also held up early in the home straight before being angled wider to obtain clear running.</p>	
Race 4	TUI BREWERY THE BEER AROUND HERE STAYERS
<p>ILLUMINATING lost ground at the start.</p> <p>ALL IN CLOVER lugged in down the home straight and had to be straightened.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of ILLUMINATING, K Myers could offer no excuses. A post-race veterinary examination of the mare failed to reveal any significant abnormalities other than having lost the near side hind plate. Co-trainer P Shailer advised that the mare may back-up next week.</p> <p>When questioned on the performance of CITY CHIC, R Myers was of the opinion the mare would appreciate an easing in the track.</p>	
Race 5	LINCOLN LODGE METRIC MILE
<p>SARTOBY stood flat-footed when the gates opened and was very slow away. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed against SARTOBY with regards to its barrier manners.</p> <p>MY MAGICIAN and THORA BOB bumped going into the first bend resulting in both runners losing ground.</p> <p>NOVA SCOTIA raced three-wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>Over the final stages when being angled out, OMANA, over-reacted and shifted out further than intended and hampered TAIPA TIGER.</p>	
Race 6	BAMBRY'S WATER TREADMILL WOODVILLE-PAHIATUA CUP
<p>SEDUCER was slow away.</p> <p>FAIRWAY WISH raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>ENUFFISENUFF (R Myers) raced in restricted room for most of the home straight and when pulling up accidentally clipped the heels of CLASSCOROC and fell. R Myers was attended to by medical staff and cleared. Trainer J Bary advised he would monitor ENUFFISENUFF over coming days and report any finding to the Stewards. R Myers was given an exemption not to weigh-in.</p>	
Race 7	GOLDEN BAY CEMENT SPRINT
<p>TYNE COT, STOPOVER and JOE COOL were slow to begin.</p> <p>FALZANO shifted out on the home bend and forced BRADPIT and ANTOWNOV wider on the track.</p> <p>FOOTLOOSE was inclined to shift in over the final stages having to be straightened.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of STOPOVER which finished last, R Hannam said the gelding after being agitated in the barrier, raced below par and was disappointing.</p>
