Race 1	HB RACEHORSE OWNERS ASS. 2100
<p>KIA KAHA (L Allpress) was slow away.</p> <p>TINNAKOTU (J Parkes) over-raced in the lead throughout.</p> <p>When questioned into the poor performance of TINNAKOTU rider J Parkes said the gelding had little left at the finish after over-racing throughout. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormality.</p> <p>Track upgraded to Good 3 after the running of the first race.</p>	
Race 2	WAIKATO STUD 3YO
<p>PLATINUM MARSEILLE (K Myers) got its head up in the early stages when being restrained.</p> <p>DRAGON BEAUTY (L Allpress) lay inwards near the 350 metres making contact with VICEROY (J Parkes) which was held up. A short distance further both runners came together again and bumped.</p> <p>SOUND (R Myers) was inclined to shift inwards over the final stages placing VICEROY in restricted room.</p> <p>J Parkes was reminded of his obligation when shifting ground, after angling his mount inwards near the 150 metres hampering KEEP A FORTUNE (M Wenn).</p>	
Race 3	STELLA ARTOIS SPRINT
<p>GOLD MOET underwent and passed a veterinary examination prior to this race after slipping over in the parade ring.</p> <p>TANSAVA (H Tinsley) was tightened on jumping away when runners either side shifted ground.</p> <p>V Johnston the rider of PIT A PAT was issued with a warning after she allowed her mount to shift in shortly after the start hampering DISCO INFERNO(R Myers) and STYLEE (C Lammas).</p> <p>GOLD MOET (B Lammas) and KARMAZYN (J Riddell) over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>GOLDEN BAY (J Parkes) was obliged to race three wide throughout.</p> <p>STYLEE lost the near hind plate during the running.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of KARMAZYN rider J Riddell could offer no excuse for the gelding's performance. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormality. Trainer J Bary advised that he would remove the nose band and may apply a tongue tie prior to it's next start.</p>

<p>PHEASANT (J Parkes) was slow away.</p>	

<p>KING LEONIDAS (C Dell) had to be steadied off the heels of COUNT DE LOREE (K Smith) when the pace eased near the 400 metres on the first round.</p> <p>Near the 800 metres HILTON JAMES (J Riddell) was checked when racing to the inside of HE KIN TALK (D Walker) which when being taken forward to the lead lugged inwards into the line of HILTON JAMES.</p> <p>B Grylls (KING OF ROCK) was shown video footage of her ride and in particular near the 600 metres where she angled her mount outwards when not clear of NO CREDIT (B Lammas) which was momentarily hampered. B Grylls was advised to exercise more care when in similar circumstances.</p> <p>A post-race veterinary inspection of HILTON JAMES failed to reveal any abnormality.</p>	
Race 5	LIME COUNTRY YEARLING DRAFT MAIDEN
<p>IMA PERFECT GUY (C Dell) underwent and passed a veterinary examination behind the barrier when it's hind quarters made contact with a gatepost on leaving the enclosure.</p> <p>IMA PERFECT GUY shifted out abruptly leaving the barriers tightening SHINING PEARL (H Tinsley) which lost ground. IMA PERFECT GUY hung out badly throughout placing ride C Dell at a disadvantage. Connections were advised that a warning is placed against IMA PERFECT GUY with regard to it's racing manners.</p> <p>JUST CALL ME BLUE (D Bradley) was held up for some distance prior to the home turn.</p> <p>SEAMINGLY (D Walker) raced keenly in the early stages and was held up for a short distance before the home turn.</p>

<p>LASSWADE (M Dravitzki) was slow to begin.</p> <p>JUST CALL ME BOND (H Tinsley) raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>SECOND HOPE (M Dee) raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>CELEBRATION (K Myers) was denied a run near the 300 metres and had to change ground outward to improve.</p>

<p>PACHENKO (M Wenn) began awkwardly and got back.</p> <p>TSAR REFORMER (S Collett) raced wide early and in the home straight hung inwards and had to be straightened on several occasions. Co Trainer S Ramsay advised he would alter the gelding's gear prior to it's next start.</p> <p>DASHING THUNDER (R Jones) was bumped near the 400 metres when POLLY FLINDERS (B Lammas) was angled out in search of a run. PACHENKO was also forced over a little extra ground in this incident.</p> <p>THE AFTERSHOCK (K Myers) was held up throughout the entire home straight.</p>
