### Whangarei RC, 3 January 2013

Race 8 – Cowley's Hire Centre 1400

Stewards today concluded an inquiry into the riding of **TAKE CHARGE** where the Stewards had concerns with Apprentice K Joyce's riding of **TAKE CHARGE** in the early stages of the race, more particularly the manner in which Apprentice K Joyce failed to maintain contact with the body of the field in the early stages. It has been determined that Apprentice Rider K Joyce will be referred to the New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing, Rider Skills Review Panel for further tuition.

### Thames JC, 5 January 2013

Race 2 - PAK N SAVE THAMES SPRINT

Stewards today concluded an inquiry into the riding of **VINCENT MANGANO** where the Stewards had concerns with Apprentice K Chiong's riding of **VINCENT MANGANO** in the early stages of the race, more particularly the manner in which Apprentice K Chiong had left the barriers. It has been determined that Apprentice Rider K Chiong will be referred to the New Zealand Thoroughbred Racing, Rider Skills Review Panel for further tuition.

### Auckland RC, 12 January 2012

Race 1 – Dunstan Feeds 2100

Trainer B Wallace was fined \$50 by the JCA when his stable representative A Peard presented **MAKERS MARK** to race in side winkers which had not been notified.

### Auckland RC, 12 January 2012

Race 10 – Rich Hill Yearlings @ Karaka 1400

Apprentice Jockey R Hutchings admitted a breach of careless riding in that passing the 125 metres he allowed **KIJANI** to shift in forcing **EWENIGHT** (A Calder) on to the hind quarters of **MANGAROA MINI** (M Cameron) with **EWENIGHT** then having to be checked. After hearing all submissions the JCA suspended R Hutchings' license to ride in races 20 – 26 January 2013 inclusive, 5 days.

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## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>Rosebank Business Assn Pathways to the Future Trust 1200</b>
<p><b>SUPACALIFRAGLISTIC</b> (E Leighton) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>RATTLE AND HUM</b> (B Hutton) and <b>FOXY BELLE</b> (D Turner) both jumped away awkwardly.</p> <p>When making the bend near the 900 metres <b>MAASHKA</b> (C Dell) was briefly crowded when racing ungenerously.</p> <p><b>ZEST PRINCESS</b> was observed to have blood present in the nasal area on return to the enclosure area. <b>ZEST PRINCESS</b> underwent a veterinary examination which confirmed the mare to be a bleeder and as such is subject to a mandatory three month stand down from racing in New Zealand. <b>ZEST PRINCESS</b> was also showing signs of lameness in the near fore leg. Trainer D Logan is to provide a veterinary clearance for <b>ZEST PRINCESS</b> prior to trialling or racing again.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of <b>FOXY BELLE</b> Apprentice Jockey D Turner advised that the filly had travelled keenly in the early and middle stages and once placed under pressure in the final straight had not responded as anticipated. <b>FOXY BELLE</b> underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to find any abnormality. Apprentice Jockey E Leighton was reminded of her obligations with respect to making contact with connections prior to weighing in.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>The Falls Restaurant Auckland 24hr Glass 2200</b>
<p><b>GIVE 'EM THE BASH</b> (D Johnson) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>I'VE GOT FAITH</b> (T Thornton) shifted out when leaving the barriers bumping with <b>GAMER ROYALE</b> (M Cameron).</p> <p>When leaving the straight passing the 1700 metres <b>HERMAN</b> (O Bosson) became awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>CALIBURN</b> (E Leighton) and shifted in tightening <b>RIO TONTO</b> (C Dell). <b>HERMAN</b> then commenced to over-race, becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>CALIBURN</b> and raced ungenerously for a distance.</p> <p><b>CALIBURN</b> raced wide without cover from near the 1000 metres.</p> <p>Passing the 600 metres <b>I'VE GOT FAITH</b> shifted in when awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>FLOWER POWER</b> (A Calder) crowding <b>DEFIANT ROSE</b> (C Grylls) which had to steady.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>Cato Bolam Consultants 1600</b>
<p><b>GOLDEN CUP WINNER</b> (D Johnson), <b>WATTLE BAY</b> (M Sweeney) and <b>TABLE ONE</b> (L Innes) were all slow away.</p> <p><b>RHYTHM TO SPARE</b> (V Colgan) shifted in when jumping away inconveniencing <b>OOPS TIGER</b> (D Turner).</p> <p><b>FAST PROFIT</b> (A Calder) raced wide throughout.</p> <p><b>LION RED</b> (M Du Plessis) was held up early in the final straight and again passing the 250 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>N-Compass 1600</b>
<p><b>CHANDELIER</b> (M Du Plessis) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>WINESINWITSOUT</b> (M Sweeney) over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>LOVETOHAVEIT'S</b> (J Castano) position became tight passing the 1100 metres when racing in restricted room to the inside of <b>OTTO THE GREAT</b> (O Bosson).</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>Architectus 1600</b>
<p><b>SAVANNAH AL JAMAL</b> (R Aukett) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>SECRET'S ONLY</b> (M Cameron) shifted in making contact with <b>MOVIDA</b> (M Sweeney) which had begun awkwardly with <b>MOVIDA</b> losing ground as a result.</p> <p><b>RIBBONY ROSE</b> (S Collett) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>CALL ME BLONDIE</b> (S Spratt) raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>MORE THAN SACRED</b> (A Calder) was held up until passing the 200 metres.</p> <p><b>PORT ELIZABETH</b> (O Bosson) was held up and unable to obtain clear running in the final straight.</p> <p><b>SAVANNAH AL JAMAL</b> was held up until near the 250 metres and when shifting out inconvenienced <b>LA BELLA VISTA</b> (E Leighton). R Aukett was advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p>R Hutchings (<b>RAFFAELLA</b>) lost his whip approaching the winning post.</p> <p><b>RIBBONY ROSE</b> had difficulty obtaining clear racing room until near the 150 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>Campbell Brown Planning Ltd 1200</b>
<p><b>PAPER LACE</b> (M Sweeney) over-raced in the middle stages.</p> <p><b>KERRY O'REILLY</b> (V Colgan) became awkwardly placed on heels passing the 500 metres having to steady.</p> <p><b>ISHIMINE</b> (S Shirahama) was held up for clear racing room until near the 200 metres.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of <b>SHORT TALE</b> Rider O Bosson advised Stewards that after being taken on during the middle stages of the race <b>SHORT TALE</b> had not responded as well as anticipated when placed under pressure.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>www.socialracing.co.nz</b>
<p><b>COAT DU ROAN</b> reared as the start was affected, and then remained in the barrier, taking no part in the race. Trainer L Molloy was advised <b>COAT DU ROAN</b> must barrier trial to the satisfaction of stewards prior to racing next.</p> <p><b>BITETHEBULLET</b> and <b>FLAMIN AMY</b> were slow to begin.</p> <p>Shortly after the start <b>FLAMIN AMY</b> shifted away from <b>RAJAH BROOK</b> when racing ungenerously.</p>	

**EDITION** raced three wide without cover throughout.

**FLAMIN AMY** got its head up approaching the bend at the 800m, when racing ungenerously.

**RAJAH BROOK** was inconvenienced when **CHINTZ** shifted out to obtain clear running near the 300 metres.

Following the race L Molloy sought a request for a ruling to whether **COAT DU ROAN** was denied a fair start. After considering submissions the JCA declared **COAT DU ROAN** a starter.
