RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	SPIERS WIRELINE MAIDEN			
The following runners were tightened shortly after the start when HANAMICHI shifted in simultaneously as BIG LUCY				
shifted out; THE BIG OPAL, TINNAKOTU, CLYDE ABNER, BRECON GROSVE and BELCADO.				
CLYDE ABNER raced three wide without cover in the early and middle stages.				
BELCADO raced wide throughout.				
CLYDE ABNER bumped with BRECON GROSVE near the 800 metres when BRECON GROSVE rolled inwards.				
THE BIG OPAL and CAST IRON JACK raced in restricted room in the home straight.				
Both the riders of THE WHITE FENCER (L Allpress) and GOLDEN DUCK (S Doyle) which finished some distance last had no				
excuse. Trainer A Sharrock advised that THE WHITE FENCER would be retired from his stable.				
Race 2	TOTAL WORLDFRESH 1200			
HERA shifted out on jumping, dictating DESERT VIEW outward into the line of PHONE GIRL which after being slow away,				
was further hampered.				
SATANYA began awkwardly and was then crowded when runners either side shifted ground.				
OUTOFTIME was slow to begin.				
HERA and VALDARAH made the first turn awkwardly.				
VALDARAH continued to race greenly throughout.				
J Parkes the rider of SATANYA was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) after he shifted ground outwards				
approaching the straight entrance when not clear of SIR GONZALES which had to change ground.				

Near the 300 metres HERA and IFFLEY ROAD came together and bumped for several strides when HERA was angled out in search of clear running.

Race 3 CHAIN RESOURCES MAIDEN 3YO

AUNTY MUTAWAI got its head up when being steadied approaching the first turn and shifted out taking SALUTE ME out over extra ground.

AUNTY MUTAWAI then raced ungenerously for some distance.

MI APACHE HORSE over raced in the middle stages.

When questioned regarding the performance of SALUTE ME rider S Doyle stated that the filly had been outpaced throughout.

ADOLAY was inclined to lay in over the final stages.

Race 4 RIG 66 MAIDEN

POMPOUS PEARL began awkwardly and got back.

OLIVIA MARY was slow away and shortly after was hampered by WOTZAT which shifted in abruptly.

K Myers the rider of MAN OVERBOARD was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d) after she angled her mount inwards near the 800 metres which resulted in WOTZAT (H Tinsley) having to be eased off heels.

VICE VERSA hung outwards throughout placing the rider at a disadvantage and rounding the home turn shifted out inconveniencing MAN OVERBOARD and WOTZAT.

ROYAL TRIUMPH made the 800 metre bend awkwardly and bumped SYKES.

SYKES was obliged to race three wide throughout.

J Parkes the rider of WHATAHASSLE defended a charge of careless riding after the Stewards alleged he allowed his mount to shift inwards approaching the 800 metre turn, directing OLIVIA MARY into the line of POMPOUS PEARL which was checked. After deliberations the JCA found the charge proved and J Parkes had his license to ride in races suspended from close of racing on 11/2/13 up to the close of racing on 16/2/13. (3 days)

Race 5 HORIZON ENERGY SERVICES MAIDEN

LUCY CAN DANSKE shifted out on jumping dictating ROYAL SPY out on to the hind quarters of SAKI HOUSE which resulted in both ROYAL SPY and SAKI HOUSE becoming unbalanced and losing ground.

CUPCAKE jumped in at the start making contact with NORTH OF SUNSET.

NORTH OF SUNSET over raced in the early and middle stages.

HELLHATHNO FURY raced three wide without cover throughout.

JUSTASUGGESTION which ran last underwent a veterinary examination which revealed no abnormality.

Race 6 SCIENTIFIC DRILLING INTERNATIONAL

OUR SUPERNOVA proved fractious in the barriers after being loaded away and reared and lost ground as the start was made.

BETRAYED and STYLEE came together when leaving the barriers.

GHAZAWAN was slow away then raced wide throughout.

STYLEE attempted a run near the 250 metres and bumped with PEACE KEEPER prior to being angled inwards to improve.

Race 7 VAUSE WIRELINE SERVICES 1400

SHARKI BRAHMA raced ungenerously in the early stages and got its head up near the 1200 metres prior to shifting out abruptly a short distance further.

GLAIZEM raced three wide without cover throughout

ZEINA ROYALE shifted out on straightening and hampered SHARKI BRAHMA momentarily,

When questioned into the run of SHARKI BRAHMA which was under pressure some distance out rider J Parkes stated the gelding had little left at the finish after over-racing early.

BRIGHT GLO and SHARKI BRAHMA both underwent a post race veterinary inspection which failed to reveal any abnormality.

Race 8 HOOKER PACIFIC TARANAKI CUP

I SUGGEST was slow away.

MISS KIMBRA began awkwardly and was slow away.

FALZANO made the first bend awkwardly.

SHARMACK over raced near the 800 metres.

FRANCILIENNE hung outwards passing the 700 metres and made contact with FALZANO and ASHALINI which became unbalanced.

I SUGGEST raced in restricted room in the early part of the home straight and was unable to improve, so was angled outwards near the 150 metres to obtain clear running and finished on when clear.
