RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	riccartonpark.co.nz MAIDEN (1200m)
<p>N Wigley, the trainer of PUZZLED, advised the Stewards that prior to today's meeting the filly suffered a minor laceration to its right hind leg. PUZZLED underwent a pre race veterinary inspection on course and was passed fit to race.</p> <p>FRENCH LESSON and PUZZLED were slow to begin.</p> <p>Shortly after the start HOME MADE HALO was crowded and lost ground between INDIVIDUAL and YAK YAK which jumped awkwardly and shifted out.</p> <p>Approaching the 500 metres FRENCH LESSON was steadied momentarily when crowded by YAK YAK which was taken in slightly by HOME MADE HALO which lay in.</p> <p>WESTERN WARRIOR had difficulty obtaining a complete clear run from the 400 metres to the 200 metres.</p> <p>HOME MADE HALO raced greenly when placed under pressure in the straight and had to be straightened on a number of occasions.</p> <p>MY JUNGLE GIRL returned to the saddling enclosure with a minor laceration to the right hind leg.</p> <p>C Johnson, the rider of PUZZLED, advised that his mount raced greenly and would benefit from today's run.</p> <p>A post race veterinary inspection of PUZZLED revealed the filly to be suffering from a slow recovery rate. Trainer N Wigley was advised that a veterinary clearance including an endoscopic examination would be required prior to the filly racing again.</p>	
Race 2	PUNTERS CHALLENGE HERE APRIL 6TH RATING 65 (1200m)
<p>Correct weight was delayed as the connections of I'M MAVERIC wished to view the film to ascertain whether the gelding was denied a fair start. After viewing films the objection was not proceeded with.</p> <p>I'M MAVERIC which was fractious in the barriers jumped awkwardly and lost considerable ground.</p> <p>Shortly after the start KATRIFRIC was crowded between REFRESHNLY VIBRANT and FINTORRO which jumped awkwardly and shifted out.</p> <p>Near the 1000 metres KATRIFRIC which was racing keenly got its head up, shifted outwards and hampered OUR BELLA ROSE.</p> <p>M Cameron, the rider of ASTROGAL, accidentally dropped his whip near the 450 metres.</p> <p>KATRIFRIC which returned to the birdcage with blood present in both nostrils underwent a veterinary inspection and was declared a bleeder and stood down for the mandatory three months.</p>	
Race 3	MORE FM SUMMER VINEYARD TOUR RATING 85 (1200m)
<p>FULLAVINO was a little slow to begin.</p> <p>Shortly after passing the 400 metres SAVONT was momentarily inconvenienced by FULLAVINO which shifted in slightly when placed under pressure.</p>	
Race 4	DEREK FREEAR RATING 85 (1800m)
<p>STORMY RAIN had difficulty obtaining a complete clear run from the 450 metres until passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>FAXED was unable to obtain a clear run from the 400 metres until near the 200 metres where he was obliged to shift outwards to improve.</p>	
Race 5	ZACINTO AT INGLEWOOD STUD RATING 65 (1800m)
<p>LIDIACO jumped awkwardly.</p> <p>SOVEREIGN ROSE which started from an outside barrier raced wide in the early stages and then raced keenly for some distance in the middle stages.</p> <p>OLD GOLD raced wide throughout.</p> <p>A post race veterinary examination of LIDIACO, which was restrained out of the race passing the 200 metres, revealed a suspected break to the left front pastern, an abrasion to the right hind pastern, and some swelling in the left hind pastern. Trainer J Parsons was advised that a veterinary clearance and barrier trial would be required prior to the mare racing again.</p> <p>C Johnson, the rider of FALENA, which proved disappointing, advised that in his opinion the mare would be better suited on a rain affected track.</p>	
Race 6	millfield.co.nz OHOKA'S FINEST SUBDIVISION MAIDEN (1600m)
<p>PRINCE EDEN was slow to begin and then raced wide throughout.</p> <p>Passing the 1200 metres JUSTACRUSIN steadied and shifted out around the heels of SAVANNAH AL JAMAL.</p> <p>Approaching the 1000 metres EVIDENCE which was racing keenly raced in restricted room between SANDY'S GIRL and LADY LUNCHALOT which was also racing keenly and when being steadied away from the heels of KEYNOTE shifted out slightly.</p> <p>BOUJET LA and EVIDENCE raced wide rounding the home turn.</p> <p>TRUTH hung outwards in the straight and proved difficult to ride.</p>	

Race 7	CHRISTCHURCH CASINO RATING 65 (1400m)
<p>POSTILLION which was fractious in the barriers jumped awkwardly.</p> <p>On jumping SHE'S ASSERTIVE and ALTHELEAVESRBROWNE were crowded between POSTILLION and TANGOLINI which shifted inwards.</p> <p>POSTILLION raced keenly in the early stages and when being steadied got its head up.</p> <p>ALTHELEAVESRBROWNE raced wide throughout.</p> <p>SHE'S ASSERTIVE raced wide rounding the home turn.</p> <p>Passing the 300 metres SOMETIME LATER steadied momentarily and shifted outwards away from the heels of TREVISIO which shifted inwards.</p> <p>ROC CITY had difficulty obtaining a complete clear run for the majority of the straight and was never fully tested.</p> <p>Approaching the 200 metres SOMETIME LATER was steadied to avoid the heels of ANNABEL ROSE which was taken in slightly by KIMBERLEY COURTNEY which shifted in and away from POSTILLION which ducked in abruptly.</p> <p>Jockey K Williams, the rider of TILLY, reported that the mare never travelled throughout and failed to respond when placed under pressure from the 500 metres.</p>	
Race 8	SPEIGHT'S RATING 75 (1400m)
<p>CHAMPAGNE EVA jumped awkwardly and lost ground.</p> <p>On jumping OXBOROUGH MAGIC lost ground when bumped by BRONTE LASS which shifted inwards.</p> <p>ASHBURN LANE was a little slow to begin.</p> <p>PURPOSE and ROYAL HU bumped on several occasions near the 1100 metres.</p> <p>THE DEBT COLLECTOR and SATISFACTION both of which drew outside barriers raced wide for the majority of the race.</p> <p>LIVANA raced wide rounding the home turn.</p> <p>OUR PREMONITION shifted outwards in the straight when placed under pressure.</p> <p>L Allpress, the rider of KATIE JAY which was restrained from the race passing the 150 metres, reported that her mount appeared to be choking down and breathing irregularly. A post race veterinary examination of KATIE JAY did not reveal any obvious abnormalities however the connections were advised that a veterinary clearance including a pre and post exercise endoscopic examination is required prior to racing again.</p> <p>A post race veterinary examination of SATISFACTION revealed the mare to be lame in the left front leg. The connections were advised that a veterinary clearance is required prior to the mare racing again.</p>
