RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 ADAMS ENGINEERING STAYERS

SUNLOVER(T Baker) began awkwardly at the start and lost ground.

SUNLOVER commenced to over-race in the early stages, so was taken forward wide on the track to sit outside the leader in the run along the back straight.

SHEEZ ALL HEART(S Collett) over-raced in the early stages.

GOOGLE ME(D Walsh) had to be steadied off the heels of the rapidly tiring **SANDRASCAL(J Shackelton**) near the 500 metres and in doing so, shifted out and hampered **HANAMICHI(R Hannam)**.

MISS EVERGREEN(J Oliver) was held up for some distance prior to entering the home straight behind the tiring SANDRASCAL.

HANAMICHI shifted out under pressure over the final stages.

Race 2 ANGUS GEMMELL FLYERS

Trainer R Frost advised that **MISS SING** had suffered a superficial laceration overnight. After undergoing a Veterinary inspection **MISS SING** was passed fit to race.

AGOSTINI(B Grylls) was declared a late scratching by order of the Stewards after the filly would not proceed to the start, dislodging its rider on several occasions. Connections were advised the filly must trial to the satisfaction of stewards prior to its next start.

MISS SING(T Baker) jumped away awkwardly, losing ground.

BELLA ARTOIS(D Walker) over-raced in the early and middle stages.

MR POLO(B Lammas) was obliged to race three-wide without cover throughout.

LEGLESS(H Tinsley) was held up for a short distance near the 200 metres when racing in restricted room.

Following the running of Race 2 M McNab complained of feeling unwell due to dehydration and after being examined by paramedic staff, stood down from his remaining engagements.

Race 3 VETENT DASH

R Norvall replaced M McNab on POPPAS DELIGHT.

RHODAN(M Dee) jumped outwards at the start and lost ground.

MADAM KIRK(S Collett) was held up for a short distance near the 200m.

POPPAS DELIGHT(R Norvall) hung outwards throughout and could not be fully ridden to advantage by its rider.

Connections were advised that a warning would be placed against the racing manners of POPPAS DELIGHT.

D Walsh reported that his mount LA SOMMELIERE which was disappointing failed to back up from its first day run.

Race 4 KIWI TRANSPORT 1300

H Tinsley replaced M McNab on KARMAZYN.

THE RIGHT CHOICE(B Grylls) became fractious in the barrier and after undergoing a Veterinary inspection, was cleared to start.

THE RIGHT CHOICE jumped away awkwardly.

PAYDAY(S Collett) was slow to begin and got back.

POSTERGADO(B Lammas) raced ungenerously in the early stages.

PAYDAY lay out when improving round the bend and lost ground.

ALICIA(M Dee) was held up throughout the home straight until passing the 100 metres where it was angled outward to improve.

When questioned regarding the performance of **PRAISEWORTHY**, rider D Walker was of the opinion that the gelding may have not backed up from the first day and was possibly feeling the effects of the firm going.

Race 5 WAIROA STAR SPRINT

As there was no senior rider available, Stewards permitted Apprentice J Shackelton to replace M McNab on **TIMETODANCE.**

AMANPULO(R Hannam) was tightened on jumping away after runners either side shifted ground.

OUR DELIGHT(R Norvall) jumping outwards at the start and lost ground.

CHARLIE MCBRIDE(S Collett) got its head up shortly after the start when being restrained.

A post-race Veterinary inspection of MISS SERENA(D Walker) which finished well back failed to reveal any abnormality.

Race 6 HAVELOCK NORTH NEW WORLD DISTANCE

UPNOVER(D Walker) shifted in when leaving the barrier taking **NO CREDIT(B Lammas)** into the line of **LA MANZANILLA(R Hannam)** which was hampered.

RE DEEL(D Walsh) raced three wide without cover from near the 1200 metres

LASSWADE(T Baker) had to take evasive action to avoid the heels of the rapidly tiring GILMOUR'S GIRL(J Shackelton) and in doing so clipped the heel of LA MANZANILLA and blundered approaching the straight entrance. Also affected was NO CREDIT which had to shift outwards abruptly to avoid the heels of LASSWADE.

Race 7 AFFCO NEW ZEALAND LTD WAIROA CUP

B Lammas was permitted to ride **HERMOSA NOVIA** 1 kg over the carded weight. The explanation from B Lammas and his agent was accepted by the Stewards on this occasion.

HERMOSA NOVIA underwent and passed a Veterinary inspection behind the barrier after rider B Lammas had a minor concern with its action during the preliminary.

EVEN BETTER(M Dee) raced very keenly in the early and middle stages and had little left at the finish.

S Collett (GUNS AT FIVE) was issued with a warning under rule 638 (1) (d) after she angled her mount outwards near the 1000 metres dictating **RED DRAGON(R Hannam)** and **CALGACUS** over extra ground.

Riders R Hannam (RED DRAGON) and M Hills (CALGACUS) advised that their respective mounts failed to back up from the first day.

Race 8 WAIROA EXPATS SPRINT

GRENADE(H Tinsley) shifted out abruptly when leaving the barrier making contact LOCHWOOD(M Hills).

PINOCCHIO BOY(T Baker) shifted in when leaving the barrier hampering DUDEHAKA(D Walsh) which lost ground.

NOTSOFALLIBLE(S Collett) raced three-wide without cover throughout.
