| <p><b>PEACE KEEPER</b> (V Colgan) underwent a veterinary inspection behind the barriers being declared a late scratching at 7.14pm on veterinary advice as it was lame in the near foreleg. Trainer G Brick was advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required prior to <b>PEACE KEEPER</b> racing next.</p> <p><b>CHANTILLY ROSE</b> (A Collett) knuckled leaving the barriers.</p> <p><b>BERLUSCONI</b> (M Coleman) lay in shortly after the start hampering <b>CHANTILLY ROSE</b> which had to be steadied. <b>BERLUSCONI</b> was then inclined to over-race when being restrained in the early stages.</p> <p><b>LILLY BELLE</b> (M Cameron) got its head up when being restrained passing the 1200 metres dropping back on to <b>DUQUESA</b> (O Bosson). <b>SO ELITE</b> (M Walker) was also inclined to over-race when being restrained at that point of the race. <b>LILLY BELLE</b> continued to race ungenerously through the middle stages being inclined to get its head up.</p> <p><b>SO ELITE</b> made the bend passing the 800 metres awkwardly running wide on the track. <b>SO ELITE</b> continued to hang outwards for the remainder of the race, with rider M Walker advising that the filly had raced greenly throughout.</p> |                                             |
