When questioned into the run of TANSAVA, which disappointed, rider H Tinsley said that the mare was possibly unsuited to			
the slow pace. A post-race veterinary examination revealed <b>TANSAVA</b> to be lame in the off fore limb on cooling down.			
Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance will be required before <b>TANSAVA</b> next races.			
SUNLOVER raced	handy in the early and middle stages and was observed to be under pressure in the approach to the		
home straight and despite being well tried, dropped out to finish a long last.			
When questioned	into the run of <b>SUNLOVER</b> , rider B Lammas stated that the mare could not respond to his urgings.		
Trainer R Frost ad	vised that the mare will now be retired.

**PETTY CAT** bucked and attempted to dislodge rider M Tanaka shortly after the start, so was pulled up and took no further part. Connections were advised that the filly must trial to the satisfaction of the stewards prior to its next start. **COUNTESSOFDELGATIE** jumped outwards abruptly at the start tightening **INVALUABLE** and **ELATED**, which both lost

ground.

D Bradley the rider of **PRIDE ROCK**, defended a charge of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d) in that he allowed his mount to shift inwards near the 800 metres when not clear of **FASHION LASS**, which was checked. After deliberations the committee found the charge proved and D Bradley had his license to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on Monday, 11 March 2013 to the conclusion of racing on Saturday, 16 March 2013 (3 days).

**CHOPPER** got back in the early stages from its wide draw.

**FASHION LASS** raced wide from the 800 metres.

Following the event **CLAN O'CEIRIN** underwent a veterinary examination which revealed superficial abrasions to the near hind leg.

### Race 3 KAPITI HELIWORX MAIDEN

LUCIE CAN DANSKE and CORSICANA both blundered at the start and lost ground.

### Race 4 COASTLANDS SHOPPING TOWN 3YO MAIDEN

**SAND STORM** was a late scratching prior to the start on veterinary advice after becoming fractious and making contact with the running rail, which was damaged. The connections were advised that **SAND STORM** must trial to the satisfaction of a steward before next racing.

At the start **AZ MAZ** shifted in and tightened **OROHET** which got back.

LUEN YAT MIRACLE raced keenly in the early and middle stages.

AZ MAZ raced four wide without cover throughout.

M Tanaka the rider of **AZ MAZ** was reminded of his obligations with regard to his use of the whip on a horse out of contention.

### Race 5 NIGEL SMITH TRACTORS HANDICAP

**POWELKA** jumped out at the start and hampered **REGAL SECRET**, which got back.

FIGURE AGAIN had to change ground inwards to improve near the 300 metres after being held up for a short distance.

### Race 6 THOMSON JONES MORTGAGES & INSURANCE HANDICAP

WHISPERING WATERS was slow away.

**EDENSONG** was obliged to race three wide without cover until near the 700 metres.

**TOMSK** raced three wide without cover throughout.

WILLING SPIRIT shifted out under pressure over the final stages.

# Race 7 HARRY PHELPS CHIROPRACTOR MAIDEN

MASTERSTROKE began awkwardly but quickly recovered.

**ROCK EXPRESS** began awkwardly and was slow away.

**ROSA ROSSA** was obliged to race three wide throughout.

After deliberations the committee found the charge proved and Apprentice Jockey M Dee had his license to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on Monday, 11 March 2013 until the conclusion of racing on Friday, 22 March 2013 (5 days).
