RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 TREES TAVERN TOKOROA 2000

SILK CHARDONNAY (P Turner) jumped away awkwardly.

SHEEZ ALL HEART (R Myers) was slow to begin.

HERE'S DE CONSUL (B R Jones) shifted out jumping away, hampering DIXIE RUN (L Allpress).

When approaching the winning post on the first occasion **SHEEZ ALL HEART** raced fiercly, shifting out and inconveniencing **THE HAIRY LEMON** (M Coleman) which in turn went out and made contact with the hind quarters of **MISS EVERGREEN** (J Oliver). **SHEEZ ALL HEART** then raced ungenerously until being allowed to improve forward approaching the 1200 metres. Passing the 1100 metres **RAFHIKI** (T Thornton), **HERE'S DE CONSUL**, **HIGH PRAISE** (L Innes) and **SILK CHARDONNAY** all overraced when the pace steadied.

MISS EVERGREEN was obliged to race wide without cover throughout.

DIXIE RUN raced wide without cover throughout.

Passing the 500 metres MISS EVERGREEN became awkwardly placed on the heels of the weakening DIXIE RUN.

Race 2 RA'S SPORTS BAR TOKOROA 1200

WASABI was a late scratching at 12.20 pm after the mare had been injured in transit to the races. Trainer A Teague is to provide a veterinary certificate of fitness for **WASABI** prior to racing next.

TOP STAR (M Walker) underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was cleared fit to start.

TOP STAR and MR NOBODY (C Grylls) were both slow to begin.

STARRY HEIGHTS (L Satherley) jumped away awkwardly.

Approaching the 800 metres TOP STAR made the bend awkwardly, shifting out, and inconveniencing MR NOBODY.

QUESTION (L Innes) shifted in under pressure passing the 200 metres inconveniencing MASAMBULA (B Grylls).

Race 3 MILFOS SOUTH WAIKATO & FIRE N ICE REFRIGERATION 1200

KIRRAMOSA (M Walker) shifted out jumping away, making contact with MISS MOSSMAN (L Allpress).

HOT LADY (T Thornton) was slow to begin, and then was further hampered when runners to its inside shifted ground.

MISS MOSSMAN over-raced in the early and middle stages.

MISS MOSSMAN hung out rounding the final turn making the bend awkwardly passing the 300 metres.

PUCCINI (S Spratt) was held up early in the final straight.

Near the 250 metres TOKOMUTU JUDGE (M Sweeney) lay in, becoming unbalanced when placed under pressure.

When questioned regarding the performance of **MY BARBARELLA** M Du Plessis advised Stewards that the filly would benefit from the experience and may now be feeling the effects of recent racing.

Race 4 TOKOROA COMBINED CLUBS 1200

Trainer L Noble was advised a warning would be placed against **MALINA** as the filly proved difficult to load.

BACHATA (M Du Plessis) jumped away awkwardly.

RICH BILLIE MARSH (D Johnson) shifted out jumping away, making firm contact with SUGGEST GOLD (A Collett).

LIBERARE (M Coleman) raced keenly in the middle stages.

MISS DIRECTIONAL (L Innes) raced three wide without cover throughout.

RICH BILLIE MARSH hung out making the final turn and ran wide passing the 300 metres, forcing **PRINCESS NICOLE** (M Walker) over extra ground. **RICH BILLIE MARSH** then continued to hang when placed under pressure in the final straight.

LIBERARE raced greenly early in the final straight and had difficulty obtaining clear running until approaching the 200 metres.

Jockey M Walker reported that **PRINCESS NICOLE** was feeling the effects of the firm nature of the track, with trainer G Brick advising the filly is now likely to be spelled.

STITCHENTYNE (T Thornton) lost the near hind plate during the running.

RICH BILLIE MARSH lost the off hind plate during the running.

Race 5 POCKETS Q MASTERS TOKOROA 1400

The start of race 5 was delayed 2 minutes at the request of TAB Control.

TOO TRUE (M Hills) and **MYSTERY GIFT** (L Innes) were crowded leaving the barrier with **MYSTERY GIFT** losing ground.

MIZBELLA (C Grylls) and BLACKWOOD (M McNab) jumped away awkwardly.

BEST FELLA (M Du Plessis) raced three wide without cover throughout.

MIZBELLA raced in restricted room passing the 250 metres when **MYSTERY GIFT** shifted in slightly, and continued to do so for the remainder of the race.

Race 6 MATLEY FINANCIAL SERVICES 1400

EH WANDA was late scratched at 3.10 pm as trainer G Smith reported he was having transport difficulties.

JEALOUS MUCH (C Grylls) and **ATLANTIS** (N Harris) were both slow to begin.

ROSE OF VIRGINIA (M Hills) was slow to begin and then was further hampered when **FRANCILIENNE** (P Turner) shifted out abruptly after leaving the barrier.

Passing the 600 metres **THE LOOKER** (D Miller) had to steady when awkwardly placed on the heels of **BRANDY BELLE** (L Innes).

ROSE OF VIRGINIA (M Hills) went off stride passing the 300 metres and then was held up in the final straight until near the 100 metres.

SKAI GLEN (L Allpress) was inconvenienced when awkwardly placed near the 250 metres.

JEALOUS MUCH made the final turn awkwardly, then raced in restricted room passing the 200 metres to the inside of **BRANDY BELLE.**

EXABELLE (M Du Plessis) had to shift out near the 150 metres to obtain clear running.

Trainer K Fursdon was questioned regarding the apparent form reversal of **PACHENKO** advising at the gelding's previous start **PACHENKO** had disappointed and believed the addition of blinkers had been of benefit.

Race 7 LALLY & SYMES SOUTH WAIKATO CUP

DIDGERIDOO (B Grylls) and **I'VE GOT FAITH** (T Thornton) were both slow to begin.

ANDROID (L Allpress) over-raced in the early and middle stages.

QUEST (M Du Plessis) was obliged to race three wide without cover until near the 800 metres when allowed to improve forward to lead.

STINGRAY (M Walker) lay in rounding the final turn making contact with **MAKERS MARK** (D Johnson) near the 300 metres.

STINGRAY was inclined to lay inwards in the final straight.

DIDGERIDOO lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **QUEST** near the 150 metres and continued to hang in for the remainder of the race.

M Walker reported that **STINGRAY** had felt indifferent in its action once placed under pressure. **STINGRAY** underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the gelding to be showing signs of mild lameness in the off foreleg. Trainer J Walker advised **STINGRAY** is now likely to be spelled.

When questioned regarding the performance of **REMINISCING**, L Innes advised that in his opinion the gelding had failed to stay and would be advising the connections to revert to racing over a shorter distance.

When questioned regarding the performance of **BELORUSSIYA** S Spratt advised Stewards that in her opinion the mare had failed to see the trip out.

Race 8 TEAM WEALLEANS/HAYWARD GROUNDSPREAD 1600

SURPASS (L Allpress) was crowded leaving the barrier between GLOVE MAN (M Walker) and SKYFALL (S Spratt).

Making the final turn near the 300 metres **ROMAN CAVALRY** (C Grylls) raced in restricted room between **STONELEIGH** (L Innes) and **WORKMANS** (M Hills) both of which shifted ground slightly with **ROMAN CAVALRY** having to steady as a result.

TUTANEKAI (T Thornton) was held up making the final turn and then lay in when placed under pressure in the final straight.

Approaching the 100 metres **THATS HOW WE ROLL** (M Coleman) shifted out to obtain clear running crowding **SKYFALL** which steadied, then further shifting out and away from **GLOVE MAN** hampering **SURPASS**. M Coleman was advised that a warning would be placed on his record. Stewards took into the account the racing manners of **THAT'S HOW WE ROLL** at the time which shifted further than intended.

GLOVE MAN lay out under pressure in the final straight.

When questioned regarding the performance of **STONELEIGH** L Innes could offer no tangible excuse for the disappointing performance.

Co-trainer C Ormsby was questioned regarding the apparent performance improvement of **THATS HOW WE ROLL** advising the gelding had been mentally immature at his most recent starts and had benefited from the addition of blinkers today.
