The start of the race was delayed three minutes due to BRUNNHILDA proving fractious behind the barrier taking				
considerable time to load. Trainer W Marshment was advised that a warning has been placed against the filly's barrier				
manners.				
ELATED was slow to begin.				
SUNSEKA began awkwardly and then commenced to hang outward throughout.				
	after the start CHEYENNE PRINCESS was checked when racing to the inside of OUR ILLUMINATI which vay from BRUNNHILDA (M Dravitzki) which was on an inward movement. M Dravitzki was reminded of her			

CHEYENNE PRINCESS had to steady off the heels of KATIE MCKEEN when racing keenly passing the 800 metres. When questioned into the run of XIBIT which finished well back, Rider L Allpress had no tangible excuse but was of the opinion the gelding would improve. LOWE SCHOLLUM & JONES MAIDEN 1340m Race 3 MACKENZIE was slow to begin. Shortly after entering the home straight KNOWING was tightened after OUGHT TO BE BAD shifted in abruptly when hit with the whip simultaneously as WORD'S OUT shifted outwards in search of a run. WORD'S OUT was held up for some distance prior to the 200 metres prior to being angled outwards to improve. EARL SPENCER over-reacted when being angled outwards near the 200 metres and went wide on the track. Rider T Russell was of the opinion the gelding was better suited to a longer distance. MADAM ZENNO lost its offside hind plate during the running. FAULDINGS SOUND 3YO MAIDEN 1600m Race 4 WHATAHASSLE was tightened shortly after the start when runners either side shifted ground and clipped a heel. ZENOUKA had to be eased going into the first turn when racing keenly. ALLEZ ROSE raced three-wide without cover from near the 700 metres. When questioned in to the run of KOOL RETURN, Rider J Riddell said the gelding raced greenly throughout. Race 5 NZI MAIDEN 2040m SCOTCH HOPPA bounded when leaving the barrier and lost ground. I'M SAM was slow away. SELWYN raced three-wide early. GREY GURU was eased on the point of the bend near the 800 metres when in restricted room to the inside of TIZZA SECRET which shifted in marginally. LAST TO DANCE hung throughout and could not be ridden out fully in the home straight, finishing some distance last. Rider J Parkes was unable to offer any reason for the mare's tendency to hang. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed a small cut to the corner of its mouth which may have affected its performance. Race 6 **GUTHRIE BOWRON 2040m** THE BEAUT raced wide rounding the first turn and was very wide in the early part of the back straight so improved in to a forward position near the 800 metres. D Turner the rider of GAMER ROYALE was shown video footage of his ride and advised to exercise care after he allowed his mount to shift in passing the 100 metres hampering MISS LINCOLN which was attempting to improve to the inside of GAMER ROYALE. **QBE INSURANCE 1340m** Race 7 GENDARME shifted out leaving the barriers making contact with LIKEAPINS which in turn bumped SUNINSKY. LIKEAPINS blundered shortly after crossing the junction near the 1,100 meters. At the bend near the 1,000 metres PARK PRINCESS and SUNINSKY both over-raced. ZUMBA lay in under pressure over the concluding stages crowding GUS who had to steady. M Dee the rider of LIKEAPINS was dislodged on pulling up and after being attended to by paramedics was cleared to continue to ride. M Dee was excused from weighing in. Race 8 NZ BLOODSTOCK INSURANCE 1340m L Allpress (ASTUCIOUS) had to ease her mount near the 800 metres when on the heels of OUR DELIGHT. RIGHT ROYAL ROSE hung inwards rounding the turn and in doing so clipped a heel of ASTUCIOUS and momentarily blundered. COUNTESSOFDELGATIE (J Parkes) was held up for some distance in the early part of the home straight and when being angled out to improve near the 200 metres forced ASTUCIOUS over extra ground. J Parkes was advised to exercise care. TUI "BREWING LEGENDS SINCE 1889" 1600m Race 9 M Dee asked to be stood down after feeling the delayed effects of a fall in Race 7. Due to the unavailability of an Apprentice, M Dee was replaced on PILLAR TO POST by D Walsh. BRECON GROSVE was eased going into the first turn when in restricted room. WAIVE THE RULES raced three-wide without cover throughout. V Johnston had no excuse for the disappointing run of BRECON GROSVE. A subsequent veterinary examination failed to reveal any abnormality.
