RECESS began awkwardly, losing ground.			
ARIA PRINCE was obliged to improve its position wide rounding the turn.			
OUGHT TO BE BAD shifted ground under pressure in the final straight.			
NO ENEMY shifted ground outwards near the post.			

When questioned regarding the run of **TAIPA TIGER**, rider R Hannam advised that the gelding had sweated up prior to the start, travelled well in the running but failed to finish the race off as expected and was disappointing. R Hannam had no tangible excuse but was of the opinion that the gelding would improve with the run.

Race 3 TURKINGTON FORESTRY HANDICAP

MR MOR, HOT LIPS and NO CREDIT all over-raced in the early stages.

**WILBUR** raced three wide without cover round the first turn.

**KOOL RETURN** raced wide throughout.

J Riddell had no excuse for the disappointing performance of **DESI GIRL** which finished well back. A post-race veterinary inspection of **DESI GIRL** failed to reveal any abnormality.

. Trainer J Bary undertook to monitor the mare's progress and report any anomaly to the stewards, should this become apparent.

# Race 4 WANGANUI WELL DRILLERS HANDICAP

WANNABE QUEEN was slow to begin.

When questioned into the disappointing run of **THE FILLY**, apprentice rider J Shackleton reported the mare was not entirely comfortable in the going and in her opinion would improve with the run. A post-race veterinary inspection failed to reveal any abnormality.

## ERNIES HAY & FENCING CONTRACTING HANDICAP

BRAXY'S IMAGE and THE MAILMAN began awkwardly and lost ground.

**SEDUCER** was slow to begin.

LIBERATOR was obliged to improve wide rounding the turn.

Near the 200 metres **HAMMER** and **ELUSIVE LAW** were both checked when racing inside **TOMSK** (J Shackleton) which was attempting to improve into a marginal gap. After questioning riders concerned, it was established that **EVEREADY**, when taken into clear running, shifted in, bumping with **ANTOWNOV** which was further taken inward, dictating **TOMSK** which had become established inside that runner's heels, inward on to **ELUSIVE LAW** and **HAMMER**. No rider was considered at fault; however J Shackleton was shown video footage and reminded of her obligation with respect to improving into a run which had not fully developed.

# Race 6 TOD SEEDS/TURFSTAR HANDICAP.

**BRECON GROSVE** was a late scratching at 8.20am on veterinary advice. Trainer T Keegan was advised that a veterinary clearance is required for the gelding prior to its next race start.

**EXCEEDING A DREAM** was slow to begin.

FALZANO began awkwardly.

**ON THE HILL** shifted out on jumping, bumping with **COATOFMANYCOLOURS**.

SEA EAGLE was slow to begin.

**ON THE HILL** and **COUNTESSOFDELGATIE** over-raced early.

**CIRON** raced three wide without cover throughout.

COUNTESSOFDELGATIE shifted in shortly after straightening and momentarily hampered ON THE HILL.

When questioned into the run of **COUNTESSOFDELGATIE** rider J Parkes advised that the filly had little left at the finish after racing keenly early. Trainer F Auret advised **COUNTESSOFDELGATIE** would be spelled.

# Race 7 BAYER SEEDGROWTH HANDICAP

LADY PLATINUM and DOUBLE O SEVEN were slow away.

CALIFORNIA shifted out on jumping, hampering SADLERS ROCK.

**RIGHT ROYAL ROSE** shifted in on jumping, bumping with **SADLERS ROCK.** 

**FIGURE AGAIN** raced keenly in the run along the back straight forcing the rider to steady of heels for some distance near the 1000 metres.

**COSABELLA** had to steady off the heels of the tiring **THATZ DAVID** near the 700 metres and lost ground.

LADY PLATINUM gave ground and lost contact with the field passing the 800 metres being distanced at the finish. When questioned, rider J Parkes was of the opinion something was amiss with the mare's breathing. Stewards ordered a veterinary examination of LADY PLATINUM, which failed to reveal any immediate abnormality. Trainer L Latta advised that LADY PLATINUM would undergo a full veterinary check including an endoscopic examination with the results to be advised to the stewards.

### Race 8 NEW ZEALAND BLOODSTOCK INSURANCE MANAWATU BREEDERS' STAKES

**IRISH DREAM** bounded at the start, losing several lengths.

DENLEE was slow away.

**DENLEE** raced wide rounding the first turn so was taken forward to lead near the 1400 metres.

When questioned regarding the run of **JOY'S CHOICE** apprentice R Hutchings said the mare faltered stride near the 300 metres and was of the opinion that something was amiss, so eased the mare down over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination of **JOY'S CHOICE** which ailed to reveal any abnormality.

**DON'T DILLY DALLY** required veterinary attention following the event after bowing a tendon. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance is required before the mare's next race start.

WITZ END began awkwardly.

**THE MINER'S SON** shifted in abruptly on jumping away and tightened **MARANELLO and CANSO**, which were severely buffeted.

JERRICO over-raced in the early and middle stages.

**MARANELLO** was inclined to shift inwards in the home straight and had to be straightened on at least two occasions. When questioned regarding the run of **COOL SPUR**, rider M Cameron reported that the gelding failed to handle today's track conditions.
