## RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	STEVO'S DISTRIBUTORS MAIDEN 1360M			

MIUCCIA jumped outwards at the start crowding DEIDRE which settled back.

ROSA HEIGHTS began awkwardly.

SEARCH FOR FAME over-raced in the early stages when being restrained.

SARTOBY raced three-wide without cover throughout and shifted in near the end of the back straight when being restrained and over-reacted dictating KIRKININI inwards on to PRECEDE which was tightened.

TURKISH GOLD was held up rounding the turn prior to gaining a run near the rail.

MARACAY, when giving ground near the straight entrance, had to be steadied off the heels of MIUCCIA and in the home straight shifted in abruptly near the 150 metres.

K Smith (MARACAY) was given a warning under Rule 638 (3) (b) regarding the use of his whip prior to the 200 metres.

When questioned in to the run of SCARRED which raced handy throughout but failed to run on to any extent Rider M Dravitzki advised the gelding was comfortable in the going but may be better suited to a longer distance.

## Race 2 G BRISTOL & SONS 3YO MAIDEN 1360M

SINGLE MISSION was declared a late scratching at 1.27pm on veterinary advice after the gelding had become fractious in its gate. A veterinary inspection revealed lameness in the right hind. Connections were advised SINGLE MISSION must trial to

stewards satisfaction prior to its next start.

TANTE BESS lay in briefly after jumping away.

MAN VERSUS WILD was slow to begin.

CLAPATHUNDA raced three-wide without cover throughout.

When questioned in to the run of MAN VERSUS WILD, Rider L Allpress advised that after getting back at the start from her inside draw, her preferred option would have been to improve her position wide from near the 800 metres as she considered the gelding to be unsuited to the going nearer the rail, but was unable to do so and was held up for some distance rounding the turn. In the home straight MAN VERSUS WILD was held up and unable to improve until near the 150 metre mark and finished on fairly when clear.

## Race 3 RIVER CITY CABS 1360M

The start of this race was delayed nearly three minutes due to RAMPANTEXCUSE proving difficult to load. Connections were advised that a warning has been placed on the gelding's barrier manners.

BRUNNHILDA began awkwardly making contact with GALILEO'S STAR.

RAMPANTEXCUSE raced fiercely for some distance in the back straight.

CLASSIC RIO raced three-wide without cover until near the 800 metres.

SARAH JANE was held up early in the home straight and also had to be steadied passing the 200 metres when in restricted room.

ASTUCIOUS was buffeted between LORD OF THE STARS and LA STELLINA near the 150 metres when both runners shifted ground.

JAMOMITI raced three-wide without cover throughout.

### Race 4 MICKEY'S SUPER LIQUOR MAIDEN 1200M

FINALLY READY and AUTHENTIC RASCAL were both crowded at the start when runners either side shifted ground.

Passing the 1,000 metres FINALLY READY which was racing keenly, had to steady when awkwardly placed on the heels of MULAN QUEEN.

WRITTEN COMMAND raced keenly going in to the bend passing the 1,000 metres.

SEFERINO raced wide without cover throughout.

J Riddell, the rider of MULAN QUEEN was issued with a warning under Rule 638 (1) (d) after he allowed his mount to shift outwards over the final stages, hampering AUTHENTIC RASCAL which had to be eased near the finish.

### Race 5 OMAHANUI SPECIAL CARE UNIT MAIDEN 2060M

BOSS JONES was slow to begin.

MASTERSTROKE raced keenly in the early stages.

NOW WERETALKIN' was held up for a short distance on straightening and then taken inwards by TACO which shifted ground.

D Turner the rider of MASTERSTROKE was issued with a warning under Rule 638 (3) (b) regarding his use of the whip on a runner out of contention.

## Race 6 WANGANUI STEELFORMERS 1600M

MAUDE was slow to begin.

MRS MAC raced three-wide without cover throughout.

ISHIDANZIN raced wide without cover throughout.

Rider D Walsh reported that POWELKA lost its footing and slipped going in to the first turn.

When questioned in to the run of BEYOND BELIEF, Rider M Dee had no excuse.

## Race 7 NZ BLOODSTOCK INSURANCE F&M MAIDEN 1600M

ACUTELYGOLD was slow to begin.

LUCK AT LAST raced keenly in the back straight.

VAL DE MAR raced three-wide without cover throughout.

LUCK AT LAST was inclined to lay outwards throughout the final straight.

L Allpress has no excuse for the disappointing performance of THEATRICS, which after racing in a forward position dropped out in the home straight.

S Collett had no excuse for the disappointing run of VAL DE MAR which tailed off.
