RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1 JUDEA TAVERN 1300

SCHRODINGERS CAT (B R Jones) began awkwardly, and then over-raced through the early and middle stages.

Passing the 1200 metres **FLAMBOYANT** (K Leung) shifted in when racing keenly, making contact with the running rail.

VITO GENOVESE (S Spratt) shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages.

When questioned regarding the performance of **BAGSAGOLD** T Thornton explained that the gelding had not been entirely comfortable in today's track conditions, further advising that the gelding may be feeling the effects of recent racing.

Race 2 STEWART BROWNE GROUP 1400

JOHN GRAY (T Thornton) shifted out jumping away, making contact with GURUS SPIRIT (K Chiong).

CLASSCOROC (M Cheung) and **MACKADOO** (B Hutton) came together jumping away.

TEN BELLES (M Coleman) began awkwardly.

ACAPELA (A Collett) over-raced through the early stages.

GURUS SPIRIT raced wide without cover throughout.

Passing the 350 metres **CLASSCOROC** shifted out to obtain clear running, inconveniencing **NICOLE AMY** (R Hutchings).

Over the concluding stages JOHN GRAY had to be straightened by its rider when laying in.

TEN BELLES lost the off hind plate during the running.

Race 3 MARKS EWEN & ASSOCIATES 1200

PRICELESS (B Hutton) began awkwardly.

EDWARD CHEVAL (S Spratt) and ANDRE JOUBERT (S Dye) were both slow away.

Approaching the 400 metres **SPITTING IMAGE** (K Chiong) shifted out slightly inconveniencing **POPPAS DELIGHT** (A Collett) who shifted out into the line of **SHAPE UP** (B R Jones) which had to steady. Apprentice jockey K Chiong was advised to

exercise greater care.

Apprentice jockey K Chiong (**SPITTING IMAGE**) was advised a warning would be placed on her record as she used the whip in an excessive manner, prior to the 200 metres.

Race 4 TAURANGA HARDWARE & PLUMBING CENTENNIAL 1200

FASTNFREE (A Collett) and **IRISH ENCORE** (R Hutchings) came together on jumping away when both runners shifted ground.

STARGURU (S Spratt) shifted in abruptly jumping away dictating **COOL CRUISING** (K Chiong) inwards, hampering **ROMAN RULER** (B R Jones) which lost ground. Contributing was slight outward movement from **HE'S DAN** (V Gatu). **RUSSIANOV** (T Thornton) over-raced in the early stages.

When questioned regarding the performance of **IRISH ENCORE** R Hutchings advised that the mare had failed to handle the existing track conditions.

ROMAN RULER returned to the enclosure with blood present in the right nostril. A Veterinary examination found the blood to be consistent with a superficial abrasion.

CRACKER (K Leung) lost both hind plates during the running.

Race 5 GARTSHOREW CONSTRUCTION 1400

MATIMBA (B Hutton) and CAIPIRINHA (M Hills) came together jumping away.

READY STEADY (P Turner) was crowded jumping away between **PAN DULCE** (R Hutchings) and **LA PINNICLE** (K Leung) when both those runners shifted ground.

Apprentice Jockey P Turner defended a breach of misconduct in that he attempted to weigh out for **READY STEADY** without an Approved Body Protector. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee found the charge proven and fined Apprentice P Turner \$300.00.

Race 6 SISTERS & CO – NEW BOUTIQUE NOW OPEN 1400

MOLTO GRATO (A Collett) and EH WANDA (S Dye) were both slow away.
