| Race 1 | BEDPOST HASTINGS 2YO 1400 |
| <p>SUBROSA (M Cameron) shifted in on jumping crowding ENLIGHTENED KNIGHT (V Johnston) which lost ground.</p> <p>GROOVEY RUBY (L Whelan) got its head up when being restrained near the 1000 metres.</p> <p>ROSADO (B Grylls) raced three wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>ENLIGHTENED KNIGHT over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p>M Sweeney reported that TOKOMUTU JUDGE had not been entirely suited to the slow track conditions. M Sweeney added that in his view TOKOMUTU JUDGE may be better suited to a longer distance.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the run of CAPE MAPPERLEY rider D Walsh could offer no tangible excuse.</p> <p>Following race 1 the track was downgraded to a Slow 7.</p> | |
| Race 2 | CSM SIGNS PREMIER 1400 |
| <p>GOLD MOET (M Dee) began awkwardly and got back.</p> <p>POSY (K Smith) began awkwardly and lost ground.</p> <p>WISH YOU WERE HERE (A Morgan) and KNOWING (D Walsh) came together and bumped heavily at the start.</p> <p>ANDALOU (V Johnston) shifted out on jumping hampering KINGS ROYAL (M Tanaka) which was crowded and lost ground.</p> <p>Shortly after the start RINGO (K Myers) shifted out and directed PAIGE ME (C Dell) out onto the hind quarters of DIAMOND EDGE (M Cameron) and as a result PAIGE ME lost its position and settled back.</p> <p>DIAMOND EDGE and EASY STREET (M Sweeney) over-raced in the back straight.</p> <p>ZEDETTA (L Whelan) raced keenly and had to be steadied near the 800 metres when in restricted room.</p> <p>WISH YOU WERE HERE was crowded momentarily when attempting a narrow run near the 150 metres.</p> <p>M Cameron DIAMOND EDGE and M Tanaka KINGS ROYAL both reported that their mounts had been unsuited to the slow conditions.</p> | |

| Race 3 | IT'S A DUNDEEL PREMIER STAYERS |
| <p>Trainer S Manning defended a charge under Rule 614 (2) in that he presented BRUCE ALMIGHTY with the wrong number cloth. After submissions the JCA found the charge proved and Mr Manning was fined \$50.</p> <p>EARL OF DONCASTER (K Myers) and ZARDETTO (S Collett) were slow to begin.</p> <p>Shortly after the start KRASE (L Whelan) which was over-racing had to steady off heels and in doing so shifted inwards tightening RIBBONY ROSE (B Grylls) which was also racing keenly. RIBBONY ROSE continued to over-race in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the run of EARL OF DONCASTER rider K Myers was of the opinion that the gelding was unsuited to the slow 7 and was unable to quicken in the ground when placed under pressure some distance out.</p> | |
| Race 4 | MANAWATU SOUND SERVICE PREMIER 1200 |
| <p>BEAUTY SHOW (S Wong) began awkwardly.</p> <p>LETSGETITON (M Dee) lost ground when beginning awkwardly.</p> <p>PERFECT START (M Cameron) was bumped at the start and got back.</p> <p>M Tanaka was advised to exercise care after he allowed his mount to shift in shortly after the start tightening SHE'S SLINKY and THE FINAL ROUND.</p> <p>PIT A PAT (S Collett) received a bump from THE FINAL ROUND (V Johnston) near the 900 metres then commenced to over-race.</p> <p>WHOOPI GEE (M Dravitzki) hung outwards throughout and blundered near the 800 metres. WHOOPI GEE shied near the 200 metres when well back almost dislodging jockey M Dravitzki who lost the use of her irons for the remainder of the race. Connections were advised that a warning will be placed against WHOOPI GEE regarding its racing manners.</p> | |
| Race 5 | THE ELBOW ROOM PREMIER 1600 |
| <p>BRAVADO (N Harris) lost traction at the start and got back.</p> <p>WOLF RUN (K Myers) bumped with SARTEAGWEN (M Dravitzki) and got back.</p> <p>DESI GIRL (M Tanaka) was slow away.</p> <p>LIGHTNING LUCY (C Dell) raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>DUE NORTH (K Smith) was held up rounding the final turn prior to being angled wide to improve in the home straight.</p> | |
| Race 6 | HASTINGS RSA LEST WE FORGET 1600 |
| <p>PIMMS TIME (M Sweeney) was crowded at the start and got back.</p> <p>MICKEN (M Dee) was slow away.</p> <p>BEGUILE (D Walsh) raced three wide without cover throughout. D Walsh reported that BEGUILE hung throughout and in his opinion was unsuited to the left hand track.</p> <p>STELLA BELLA (K Myers) raced fiercely for a short distance passing the 1200 metres.</p> <p>OLD DRUMBLE (C Dell) was checked approaching the home turn when in restricted room.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of PERO apprentice jockey D Turner said the gelding was unsuited to the slow 7.</p> <p>Trainer T Riddell subsequently advised stewards that PERO would undergo a veterinary inspection on Monday 22nd April and if the outcome is satisfactory her intention is to race the gelding on ANZAC Day with the blinkers being reapplied. Alternatively the gelding will be spelled.</p> | |
| Race 7 | HAWKE'S BAY GOLD CUP |
| <p>NEGOTIATE (M Dee) was slow away.</p> <p>VOLKSWOOD (S Collett) raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>AINTREE (C Dell) was angled inwards sharply near the 400 metres to avoid the heels of the tiring SKYSOBLUE (D Turner) and in doing so tightened NEGOTIATE.</p> <p>GUNS AT FIVE (M Cameron) was taken wide near the 400 metres when SURVIVED (M Tanaka) was angled outwards into clear running.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the run of SKYSOBLUE rider D Turner reported that in his opinion the mare was unsuited to the slow track.</p> <p>When questioned into the run of GUNS AT FIVE rider M Cameron was of the opinion the weight (58.5kg) coupled with the slow 7 track, told on the gelding over the final stages.</p> | |
| Race 8 | OCEAN PARK @ WAIKATO STUD 1200 |
| <p>The Lowry/Cullen Partnership admitted a charge under Rule 616 (2) in that they presented MINK without blinkers in the enclosure and was fined \$50.</p> <p>were fined \$ Rule 616 (2) presented horse without blinkers</p> <p>MINK (M Sweeney) was slow away.</p> <p>SITARA (K Myers) raced wide without cover throughout.</p> | |
| Race 9 | PETER ROEBUCK FAREWELL 1400 |
| <p>COLOURFUL LADY (D Walsh) was slow to begin.</p> <p>ROCKWEILER (C Dell) over-raced when wide in the early stages.</p> <p>ROCKWEILER gave ground passing the 600 metres and was not preserved with over the final stages. Apprentice C Dell reported that he considered something amiss. Stewards ordered a veterinary examination which failed to reveal any abnormalities, however trainer T Wood undertook to advise stewards of any matter which may become apparent over the</p> | |
