RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	CAMBRIDGE EQUINE HOSPITAL PREMIER
<p>The start of this race was delayed 3 minutes at the request of TAB Control.</p> <p>AWESOME DIVA (M Coleman) was slow away.</p> <p>WOLFWHISTLE (M Cameron) began awkwardly.</p> <p>MAYGROVE (M Hills) began awkwardly making contact with COSMIC CUBE (R Hutchings).</p> <p>Shortly after jumping away YOUNG WARRIOR (J Jago) had to steady when crowded to the inside of MEZZALUNA (A Forbes) which was taken in by ARGENTE (S Spratt). S Spratt was advised to exercise greater care.</p> <p>MAYGROVE over-raced in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>WOLFWHISTLE commenced to over-race in the early stages when being restrained, and shifted out approaching the 900 metres inconveniencing AWESOME DIVA which was dictated out into the line of SINGING DUNE (O Bosson) which had to steady. WOLFWHISTLE was then obliged to race wide without cover.</p> <p>YOUNG WARRIOR raced wide in the early stages before being allowed to work forward to lead passing the 700 metres.</p> <p>DARTING (L Innes) made the bend awkwardly near the 900 metres.</p> <p>MEZZALUNA and DIAMANTINE (D Turner) raced wide without cover.</p> <p>WOLFWHISTLE raced greenly when placed under pressure in the final straight and passing the 200 metres shifted out abruptly.</p> <p>Approaching the 200 metres DARTING was inconvenienced when COSMIC CUBE shifted out to obtain clear running.</p> <p>Apprentice jockey A Forbes admitted a breach of Rule 340 in that he attempted to mislead the Clerk of the Scales when endeavouring to weigh-out without a vest. After considering submissions, Apprentice Jockey A Forbes was fined \$1000 by the judicial committee.</p>	
Race 2	MITAVITE PREMIER
<p>WORTHING (R Hutchings), JUSTANEXCUSE (O Bosson) and SHANDREAM (D Turner) all began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p>FLASH HAPI (S Spratt) raced ungenerously when being steadied passing the 1000 metres.</p> <p>Making the bend near the 900 metres KITT ANN MISS (K Leung) became awkwardly placed inside the heels of BARBARIC</p>	

(M Cameron) and then raced in restricted room for a distance having to be steadied.
WHOSYOURMASTER (L Allpress) commenced to race ungenerously and made the bend awkwardly passing the 900 metres.
JUSTANEXCUSE went off stride passing the 900 metres.
BARBARIC was held up for a distance behind the tiring **KAPTAIN KIRKUP** (S Collett) passing the 600 metres.
BARBARIC was briefly crowded passing the 50 metres when improving to the inside of **DOUBLE BARREL** (B Hutton).
When questioned regarding the performance of **PAYETTE** jockey L Innes could offer no tangible excuses other than he believed the mare may be better suited to right-handed racing.
WHOSYOURMASTER underwent an endoscopic examination after jockey Allpress reported the gelding had been making abnormal breathing noises. The veterinary findings were consistent with **WHOSYOURMASTER** having had previous tie-back surgery, and there was no other significant abnormality.
KAPTAIN KIRKUP underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormalities.

Race 3	RAFFLES FARM PREMIER

JUBILATE (M Coleman) began awkwardly and shifted out making contact with **SWAMI** (B Hutton).
RICH'N UNHITCHED (M Du Plessis) began awkwardly and shifted out making contact with **KASUMI** (O Bosson).
PINZAARA (S Spratt) shifted in jumping away making contact with **UNCLE SHAYNE** (R Hutchings) which became briefly unbalanced.
KING'S FORTUNE (T Thornton) stumbled on jumping away.
GOSPEL (D Turner) began awkwardly shifting in.
Shortly after jumping away **TANGO TERRIFIC** (A Forbes) shifted out abruptly and hampered **KINGS COURT** (M Cameron) and **CROWN OF THORNS** (J Waddell).
GOSPEL raced wide without cover throughout.
HAVE NO MEERCY (L Innes) made the bend awkwardly passing the 900 metres.
NEEDLLY (S Dye) was held up rounding the final turn and then had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.
Passing the 300 metres **SWAMI** had to steady when crowded by **NEEDLLY** (S Dye) which shifted in.
NEEDLLY lost the off front plate during the running.
TANGO TERRIFIC lost the off front and off hind plates during the running.

Race 4	WILLIAM INGLIS & SON PREMIER

NINE PIN (J Waddell) shifted in abruptly leaving the barriers.
HOT IN PINK (M Coleman) was crowded leaving the barriers between **MA BELLE AMI** (R Hutchings) and **TRENDY** (M Du Plessis) with **HOT IN PINK** losing ground as a consequence.
RICH BILLIE MARSH (S Collett) shifted out when leaving the barrier.
OUR JACKPOT (A Taylor) raced wide without cover.
FRANK WHITAKER (L Innes) shifted out under pressure in the final straight.
BILLIE JEAN KING (T Thornton) was inclined to lay in under pressure in the final straight.
When questioned regarding the performance of **CARTELL** apprentice jockey A Collett could offer no tangible excuses for the gelding's performance.
When questioned regarding the performance of **TALE TO TELL** O Bosson advised that the mare had felt indifferent in its action. **TALE TO TELL** underwent a post-race veterinary examination which could find no obvious abnormalities.

Race 5	WINDSOR PARK STUD BREEDERS STAKES

BIGGIN HILL (D Nolan) and **CASSIE MAY** (S Dye) made contact on jumping away when both runners began awkwardly.
DREAMCOAT (A Collett) began awkwardly shifting out making contact with **LUCKY COUNTRY** (M Hills) which became briefly unbalanced.
OASIS ROSE (M Cameron) began awkwardly making contact with **WATERFORD** (L Innes) and then was crowded for a short distance.
DREAMCOAT over-raced when being steadied approaching the 900 metres. As a result **CASSIE MAY** then became awkwardly placed on **DREAMCOAT'S** heels and raced ungenerously for a distance.
OASIS ROSE lay in under pressure over the final 200 metres.
Approaching the 100 metres **SILVERDALE** (H Tinsley) improved into a marginal run to the inside of **SO WOTIF** (O Bosson) which shifted in slightly. As a result **SILVERDALE** shifted in making contact with **BIGGIN HILL** which became briefly unbalanced.
Trainer D Sellwood was fined \$50 when his stable representative presented **COMICAL LASS** to race without side winkers.

Race 6	PRESLAND TOCKER INSURANCE PREMIER

ALEGRIO (A Collett) began awkwardly.
MASTER MICHAEL (M Sweeney) shifted out jumping away dictating **MACKADOO** (M Du Plessis) out on to **INDIKATOR** (A Taylor) which was hampered losing ground.
CARRICK (L Innes) began awkwardly.
HIGH KIN (A Forbes) was slow away.
Approaching the 400 metres **MISS PELEAR** (N Harris) shifted out making contact with **HAPPY GUYS** (M Coleman) with both runners becoming briefly unbalanced.
MACKADOO lost the off fore plate during the running.

Race 7	NZ BLOODSTOCK INSURANCE PREMIER

MENDOZA (L Innes) began awkwardly losing ground.
AIRTIME (M Cameron), **VOLCANO** (B R Jones) and **THE GRINNER** (S Spratt) were all crowded leaving the barrier between **KLITSCHKO** (N Harris) and **CAST IRON JACK** (T Turner) when both of those runners shifted ground. **AIRTIME** lost ground as a result.
KLITSCHKO over-raced in the early to middle stages.
Passing the 1300 metres **CAST IRON JACK** shifted away from **THE GRINNER** which shifted out slightly, making contact with the hind quarters of **LE'VANTOS** (M McNab) with both runners becoming briefly unbalanced. **CAST IRON JACK** then raced in restricted room, having to steady.
Passing the 450 metres **LE'VANTOS** lay out making contact with **CAST IRON JACK** which became unbalanced and shifted out with **VOLCANO** becoming awkwardly placed on that runner's heels and then making the bend awkwardly and shifting out abruptly badly, hampering **INIS ROSE** (M Coleman) which was forced outwards on to **AIRTIME** which in turn was forced outwards on to **AMBITIOUS CHAMPION** (O Bosson) with **INIS ROSE**, **AIRTIME** and **AMBITIOUS CHAMPION** being forced very wide on the track. Footage of this incident proved inconclusive with the Stewards not taking any further action.
THE LAST SHOWER (M Du Plessis) shifted out significantly over the concluding stages under pressure into the line of **THE GRINNER** which had to steady which had been taken in by **AMBITIOUS CHAMPION**. M Du Plessis was issued with a warning and told he is expected to stop and straighten his mounts when shifting ground, sooner than he did on this occasion.

Race 8	TRAVIS STAKES

VIADANA (M Du Plessis) began awkwardly shifting out making contact with the hind quarters of **ANNA MARIA** (S Spratt) which became briefly unbalanced.
ARCENCIAEL (L Innes) was slow away.
DANCING EMBERS (S Collett) began awkwardly and then was crowded, losing ground.
Leaving the straight on the first occasion **O'FILLE** (N Harris) shifted out slightly making contact with **ARCENCIAEL** which shifted out and forced **DANCING EMBERS** wider on the track.
JEU DE CARTES (O Bosson) raced ungenerously for a distance passing the 1400 metres.
VIADANA over-raced in the early and middle stages.
O'FILLE over-raced through the middle stages.
Approaching the 350 metres **ANNA MARIA** shifted out slightly with **POSTMANS DAUGHTER** (R Hutchings) shifting away from that runner dictating **QUINTESSENTIAL** (M Coleman) out into the line of **O'FILLE** which was steadied. Contributing were **O'FILLE'S** racing manners when it was laying in at the time.
PIMMS TIME (M Sweeney) shifted out under pressure over the final 250 metres inconveniencing **CARLOTTA** (M Wenn) near the 200 metres and **QUINTESSENTIAL** near the 50 metres.
When questioned regarding the performance of **VIADANA** M Du Plessis advised that the mare had travelled very keenly in the early and middle stages and this had been detrimental to her chances.

Race 9	MANELINE CAMBRIDGE PREMIER

TILDA (M Cameron) began awkwardly shifting in and hampered **SKYTOWER** (N Harris). Contributing was outward movement from **IRA BEAN** (L Allpress).
STARETTO (M Du Plessis) over-raced in the early stages.
SKYTOWER (N Harris) commenced to give ground passing the 600 metres and then was not persevered with for the remainder of the race.
When questioned regarding the run of **SKYTOWER** rider N Harris advised that the gelding had never travelled comfortably in the existing track conditions. **SKYTOWER** underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.
When questioned regarding the run of **SACRED KNIGHT** rider S Spratt could offer no tangible excuse. **SACRED**

KNIGHT underwent a post-race veterinary examination which did not reveal any obvious abnormality.
