## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>THE TUI BREWERY, LEADING THE WAY SINCE 1889 HIGHWEIGHT</b>
<p><b>AYATOLLAH</b> began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>SEA KING</b> (K Veenendaal) hung out throughout the final straight and passing the 200 metres when taken outward to improve shifted out bumping on two occasions with <b>SEA EAGLE</b> (C Studd) forcing that runner over extra ground. Following the event C Studd, the rider of the 3<sup>rd</sup> placed <b>SEA EAGLE</b> lodged a protest against the 1<sup>st</sup> placed <b>SEA KING</b>, alleging interference over the final stages. After consideration the judicial committee dismissed the protest.</p> <p>H Curran the rider of <b>O'CONNOR</b> was issued with a warning under Rule 330(3)(c) after she failed to claim her full allowance. Following the event it was reported that <b>O'CONNOR</b> had lost the near side hind plate during the running. Following this event the track conditions were upgraded to Slow 8.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>THE DOMINION POST MAIDEN</b>
<p><b>THE PAINTER</b> began awkwardly and was slow away.</p> <p><b>QUEEN OF THE BLUES</b> improved three wide rounding the final turn.</p> <p><b>SHOOGOLD</b> (B Lammas) shifted out under pressure in the home straight resulting in B Lammas accidentally striking <b>WAIANAKARUA</b> across the neck with his whip.</p>	

<b>QUEEN OF BLUES</b> shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages and had to be straightened.	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>THE SOUND 3YO MAIDEN</b>
<b>ORINTO</b> was slow to begin. <b>OBRAHMA</b> was obliged to race three wide without cover throughout.	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>MILLS REEF MAIDEN</b>
<b>BUDDY BROKE</b> jumped in at the start, bumping with <b>HE KIN BE FAMOUS</b> . <b>MARACAY</b> was crowded leaving the barriers. <b>MAN VERSUS WILD</b> was slow to begin. <b>MARACAY</b> commenced to race ungenerously nearing the 1200 metres and shifted in crowding <b>PARTY GIRL</b> , which was taken in on to <b>MAN VERSUS WILD</b> . <b>MARACAY</b> continued to race ungenerously and had to be restrained for some distance. <b>PARTY GIRL</b> lost its footing behind near the 1300 metres. <b>PARTY GIRL</b> became awkwardly placed and was unable to improve its position rounding the turn and when attempting a run in the home straight near the 300 metres was crowded and had to be steadied when <b>MADAM ZENNO</b> shifted in under pressure. <b>MAN VERSUS WILD</b> had to be taken wide in the home straight to improve and when being angled wide forced <b>NORBERT</b> over extra ground.	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>CAVALLO AGISTMENT MAIDEN</b>
<b>LED THE WAY</b> and <b>MACKENZIE</b> were slow to begin. V Johnston ( <b>JUST LIKE NO OTHER</b> ) defended a charge of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d) when it was alleged she permitted her mount to shift in near the 1400 metres when not clear of <b>SAVABELLE</b> and <b>LAST TO DANCE</b> both of which had to be checked. After deliberations the charge was found proven and V Johnston had her licence to ride in races suspended from the conclusion of racing on Friday, 3 May 2013 up to and including racing on Wednesday, 8 May 2013 (4 days). <b>PRECEDE</b> raced keenly in the run along the back straight. <b>SAVABELLE</b> was held up rounding the home turn and early in the home straight had to be angled very wide to improve near the 200 metres. H Matthews admitted a breach of Rule 616(3) in that he presented <b>LAST TO DANCE</b> at the inspection area minus notified gear (blinkers) and was fined the sum of \$50.	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>HOROWHENUA SHELTER TRIMMERS HANDICAP</b>
On jumping, <b>JAMOMITI</b> shifted in on to <b>PIRINITETE</b> , which lost ground. <b>REASONS UNKNOWN</b> was slow away. <b>PIRINITETE</b> over-raced in the early stages. <b>MISS LINCOLN</b> was obliged to race wide without cover throughout. <b>EMMA LUCY</b> hung out throughout the final straight and near the 200 metres shifted out on to the heels of <b>PIRINITETE</b> and had to be steadied. A post-race veterinary examination of <b>NOVA SCOTIA</b> revealed the mare to be suffering from a respiratory infection. Connections were advised that a veterinary clearance will be required prior to the mare next racing. M Breslin admitted a breach of Rule 616(3) in that he presented <b>PALMERS PRIDE</b> at the inspection area minus notified gear (blinkers) and was fined the sum of \$50.	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>EL CHEAPO CARS HANDICAP</b>
<b>THE LAST AL</b> began awkwardly and lost ground. <b>ZA BRUTE</b> race wide without cover throughout. <b>LA DUCA</b> raced keenly in the early and middle stages. <b>SARAH JANE</b> had to be momentarily steadied near the 350 metres when on the heels of <b>GET THE MESSAGE</b> prior to being angled inwards to improve. <b>CLASSIC RIO</b> shifted out near the 200 metres which resulted in <b>ELUSIVE LAW</b> changing ground inwards to improve.
