## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>NZ BLOODSTOCK AIRFREIGHT 1600</b>
<p><b>DUCHESSOFCAMBRIDGE</b> (O Bosson) shifted in jumping away making contact with <b>INARUSH</b> (M Coleman).</p> <p><b>MADAME MILLIE</b> (L Allpress) and <b>BRITANNIA</b> (R Hutchings) over-raced in the early and middle stages, with then <b>BRITANNIA</b> being obliged to race wide without cover.</p> <p><b>PORT ELIZABETH</b> (M Cameron) and <b>INARUSH</b> over-raced passing the 1000 metres when the pace steadied.</p> <p><b>MISS CLEVEDON</b> (M Du Plessis) lay in under pressure in the final straight, and passing the 200 metres became awkwardly placed on heels.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>NGATLOC INVESTMENTS 1200</b>
<p><b>FEVER</b> proved restless in the barrier with jockey P Turner being thrown from the stalls. Trainer K McQuade was advised that a barrier warning would be placed against the gelding.</p> <p><b>FOXSPUR</b> (L Innes) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>RED STORM</b> (R Hutchings) shifted in jumping away, inconveniencing <b>MINI BLOOM</b> (M Du Plessis) with that runner losing ground.</p> <p><b>TENNESSEE WHISKEY</b> (M Cameron) raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>Approaching the 300 metres <b>FEVER</b> shifted out under pressure inconveniencing <b>RED STORM</b>.</p> <p>M Cameron reported that <b>TENNESSEE WHISKEY</b> had become unbalanced passing the 600 metres.</p>	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>COLLETT RACING STABLES 1200</b>
<p><b>PARDON MOI</b> (M Coleman) shifted in leaving the barrier making contact with <b>EMBLEM</b> (A Forbes).</p> <p><b>FREE DRINKS</b> (S Spratt) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>FLYINGGOLD</b> (L Innes) was inclined to lay out throughout.</p> <p><b>SUGGESTIVE SMILE</b> (M Wenn) was obliged to race wide for the majority of the race.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>HENTON LODGE 1200</b>
<p><b>KING PANAMERA</b> (R Smyth) jumped away awkwardly, losing ground.</p> <p><b>FONDA YOU</b> (A Forbes) shifted in abruptly at the start, crowding <b>COPA VERDE</b> (M Cameron) and <b>MURDOCH</b> (S Spratt).</p>	

**KING PANAMERA** raced fiercely when being restrained in the early stages and made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly, shifting out across the heels of **DON'T LOOK ETHLEN** (M Sweeney). Approaching the 300 metres **PENTAROSE** (L Allpress) shifted into a marginal run to the inside of **COPA VERDE** making contact with its hind quarters, with **COPA VERDE** then becoming unbalanced. **PENTAROSE** then raced in restricted room for a distance.

<b>Race 5</b>	<b>RACE IMAGES 1200</b>

Jockey O Bosson was fined \$250 by the Judicial Committee when he failed to make the contracted weight for **ELUSIVE GOLD**. M Sweeney replaced O Bosson.  
**CASTLETON KING** (R Smyth) and **MONKEY ROCK** (M Hills) were both slow to begin.  
**ELUSIVE GOLD** (M Sweeney) was inclined to lay out in the final stages.

<b>Race 6</b>	<b>KARAKA ACCOUNTING 1400</b>

**KATINKA** (R Smyth) and **BRITTANY** (M Du Plessis) were both slow to begin.  
**TOP CHOICE** (M Sweeney) shifted in jumping away, making contact with **SUGGEST GOLD** (A Taylor).  
**INVALUABLE** (L Allpress) commenced to hang soon after leaving the barriers and then ran off when making the bend near the 800 metres. **INVALUABLE** was not then persevered with and eased down in the final straight. Stable representative M Liefting was advised that **INVALUABLE** would be required to trial to the satisfaction of Stewards prior to racing again.  
**KATINKA** commenced to race ungenerously when being steadied passing the 1000 metres, shifting out across the heels of **SARNIA** (B Hutton). **KATINKA** continued to race ungenerously through the middle stages.

<b>Race 7</b>	<b>CLAIRE'S BENEFIT 1400</b>

**ELLIE'O** (M Coleman) jumped away awkwardly, losing ground.  
**AIMEES GOLD** (S Spratt) knuckled leaving the barrier, losing ground.  
**CHINTZ** (L Innes) raced keenly in the middle stages.  
**AIMEES GOLD** and **CHARLIE FARLEY** (D Nolan) both raced ungenerously when making the bend passing the 800 metres.  
**THE CAPTAIN** (M Wenn) was obliged to race wide without cover.  
**DUNTOILIN** (L Satherley) was held up early in the final straight.  
**DENMARK** (K Joyce) had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.

<b>Race 8</b>	<b>LOCKYS UPHOLSTERY 1600</b>

**VIKING CHIEF** (M Tanaka) underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was cleared fit to start after dislodging its rider leaving the birdcage when making contact with the gate.  
**CASH KINGDOM** (B Hutton) over-raced in the early and middle stages.  
**MR RIMFIRE** (L Allpress) and **DEL MONDO** (S Spratt) both raced fiercely passing the 1000 metres. **MR RIMFIRE** then hung out for the remainder of the race and was obliged to race wide without cover.  
**NAVY BEACH** (M Du Plessis) was briefly held up passing the 200 metres.  
**MR RIMFIRE** shifted out abruptly under pressure in the final straight finishing wide on the track.
