Race 1 HASTINGS, HEART OF HAWKE'S BAY F & M 1400

R Hutchings arrived late on course due to transport difficulties and was replaced on KAYZED by O Bosson.

WORDS OUT (R Hannam) jumped outwards abruptly at the start into the line of JAZZ ROCK (M Dee) which got back.

A post-race veterinary inspection of JAZZ ROCK failed to reveal any abnormality.

KAYZED (O Bosson) raced three wide without cover throughout.

ALL IN MYSTERY (L Allpress) raced keenly throughout.

J Parkes (EDGE OF GLORY) was advised to exercise care after he angled his mount inwards approaching the 1200 metres when only marginally clear of WORDS OUT which was steadied and went back onto BOOSTING ELEANOR (M Sweeney) which had to shift ground outwards to avoid heels.

WORDS OUT over-raced in the early and middle stages.

TANSAVA (H Tinsley) was held up rounding the turn.

LAUREN TATE (R Myers) raced greenly throughout and prejudiced its chances of finishing in a higher placing by hanging outwards badly in the home straight.

Trainer J Morell was advised that a warning would be placed against **LAUREN TATE** regarding its racing manners. J Morell advised that he would remove the blinkers for future racing and consider restricting the filly to right handed tracks.

Race 2 TRINITY HILL 1200

BEYOND BELIEF (D Walsh) was slow away.

COMMETT (M Tanaka) began awkwardly.

CASSIE MAY (M Dee) shifted out on jumping away and crowded THAT'SOUREXCUSE (R Hannam).

ROCKWEILER (R Hutchings) raced three wide without cover throughout.

COLD SNAP (M Cameron) raced three wide throughout.

RANI AURORA failed to respond when placed under pressure prior to entering the home straight. When questioned rider J

Parkes said the filly raced greenly and was not comfortable racing amongst other runners at this stage of its preparation but in his opinion, would improve with experience.

MELODY CELEBRE (B Grylls) was held up early in the home straight then raced in restricted room prior to gaining clear running over the final 75 metres.

D Walsh had no excuse for the poor run of **BEYOND BELIEF** which finished last.

Race 3 THE ELBOW ROOM SPORTS BAR MAIDEN 3YO

ACQUIESCE (L Whelan) was slow away.

LAVISH PRINCE (J Parkes) began awkwardly losing ground.

ETERNITY (L Allpress) shifted out abruptly on jumping away crowding **GOLDEN BAY** (K Myers) with contributing inward movement from **SHOW NO EMOTION** (M Cameron).

LITTLE DRUMMER BOY (D Bradley) was slow away.

LAVISH PRINCE over-raced in the early stages.

HELIO STAR (B Lammas) raced three wide without cover throughout.

SHOW NO EMOTION raced greenly throughout.

Passing 800 metres ETERNITY shied, shifted out and forced GOLDEN BAY over extra ground.

When questioned into the poor run of **DIRECTIONZ** rider H Tinsley could offer no excuse.

A post-race veterinary examination of **DIRECTIONZ** failed to reveal any abnormality.

Race 4 HARRISONS NURSERIES OPEN SPRINT

PRINCESS KATIE (M Dee) and **THE SHACKLER** (K Myers) were crowded on jumping by runners on either side with **THE SHACKLER** being worst affected and losing ground.

FAIRWAY WISH (L Allpress) over-raced and had to be continuously steadied off heels prior to the 800 metres.

Race 5 STELLA ARTOIS 2000

MYMINKCOAT (J Parkes) shifted in abruptly on jumping away and crowded **DUE NORTH** (R Hutchings), **HOT LIPS** (M Cameron) and **VALLEY OF PENTIRE** (L Allpress) which became awkwardly place on the heels of **LASSWADE** (D Walsh).

MY PENTIRE (M Hills) was slow away.

PARK PRINCESS (K Myers) had to steady passing the winning post on the first round and then made the bend awkwardly. Rider K Myers reported that PARK PRINCESS over-raced in the early and middle stages and finished the race of fairly.

HILTON JAMES (R Myers) raced wide early.

FIREKEEPER (D Bradley) raced fiercely in the early and middle stages and had nothing left at the finish.

LASSWADE raced three wide without cover throughout.

MYMINKCOAT had to be eased passing the 800 metres when in restricted room.

When questioned into the run of **DUE NORTH** rider R Hutchings said his mount was left flat footed when the pace ahead quickened when rounding the final turn, but ran on fairly in the home straight.

LASSWADE returned to the enclosure with blood present in its mouth. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed a loose tooth.

RACE 6 BAY FORD HAWKE'S BAY OPEN 1200

WYBAN ANGEL (D Bradley) was slow away.

HELL YEAH (M Hills) began awkwardly losing ground.

WYBAN ANGEL which finished a long way back returned to the enclosure showing signs of tying up which a subsequent veterinary inspection confirmed. Connections are to report the progress of the mare to the Stewards over coming days. **QUEST** (M Du Plessis) raced in restricted room in the early part of the home straight.

HELL YEAH was held up for the majority of the home straight and only gained clear running inside the final 100 metres.

Race 7 MID-WINTER CHRISTMAS AT THE RACES 29TH JUNE 1400

STELLA BELLA (B Grylls) was slow away.

SHEZGORGEOUS (D Bradley) and SKITTLE (B Lammas) began awkwardly.

THE KNIGHT (O Bosson) raced three wide without cover in the early and middle stages so was taken forward to sit outside the leader near the 700 metres.

STELLA BELLA had to be steadied when attempting a marginal run near the 350 metres then was angled outwards to improve.

When questioned regarding the run of **ABRAHAM LINCOLN** rider K Myers was of the opinion the gelding would prefer more cut in the ground and possibly a longer distance.

Race 8 WWW.HAWKESBAYRACING.CO.NZ 1400

DRAGON BEAUTY (R Hannam) was slow away.

SHARKI BRAHMA (S Doyle) began awkwardly and got back.

PEARLS (K Myers) was slow away.

ATHENRY (K Kalychurun) hung outward badly rounding the turn placing the rider at a disadvantage.

When questioned into the run of **ON YER FEET** rider D Bradley reported the filly had nothing left at the finish after racing fiercely throughout.

KIPKEINO (L Allpress) raced three wide throughout.

PEARLS was held up early in the home straight.

SHARBEELA (R Hutching) shifted out and forced MANGAROA MINI (M Cameron) wide near the 200 metres and over the

final stages bumped with MANGAROA MINI again near the finish.	
When questioned into the run of MR HANDSOMELAD rider H Tinsley was of the opinion the gelding may be better suited	
to more rain affected going.
