DIXIE RUN (A Jones) jumped away awkwardly and raced wide without cover throughout.	
Race 2	Racing at Avondale 22 May 1200
<p>CILLIAN WILL (M Coleman) jumped away awkwardly and then was further hampered when I DREAM OF JEANNIE (S Dye) shifted in abruptly.</p> <p>RAMARRO (M Cameron) was inclined to lay in throughout the race.</p> <p>MAA CHUCK lost the off hind plate during the running.</p>	
Race 3	NZ All Golds Cosmopolitan Club 1200
<p>FONDA YOU underwent a veterinary examination prior to being loaded into the barriers and was cleared fit to start.</p> <p>CAST A SPELL (S Dye) was slow to begin.</p> <p>SENATORIAL (M Du Plessis) raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>Passing the 700 metres MISS DIRECTIONAL (M Cameron) lay in making contact with JESSHANIMO (D Turner) which became unbalanced.</p> <p>Rider S Collett admitted a breach of careless riding in that passing the 400 metres she allowed CANTHASSLEME to shift out when not clear of JESSHANIMO which was checked and forced over the heels of MISS DIRECTIONAL clipping a heel and blundering. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee suspended S Collett's license to ride in races from 16 – 23 May 2013 inclusive, 5 riding days.</p>	
Race 4	The Order of St John Northern Region 2100
<p>Permission was granted for the removal of blinkers for MAKERS MARK due to the existing track conditions.</p> <p>DANCING EMBERS (D Turner) and CHEVREMONT (C Dell) both began awkwardly, coming together.</p> <p>MAKERS MARK (J Oliver) and DIAMOND PETE (D Walsh) both raced keenly when contesting the lead in the early stages.</p>	
Race 5	The Original Aussie Butcher Kumeu 1400
<p>Trainer A Forsman was fined \$50 by the JCA for presenting CATALAN KING to race without notified gear (blinkers).</p> <p>KING PANAMERA (R Smyth) jumped away awkwardly and then raced fiercely in the early and middle stages when being restrained.</p> <p>CEE TEE ARE (R Hutchings) was inclined to lay in in the final straight.</p> <p>Following the race the connections of the second placed horse CATALAN KING lodged an objection against the first placed horse TRAVEL WISE alleging interference in the final 50 metres. After considering submissions the Judicial Committee dismissed the protest.</p>	
Race 6	Bob Black – Shivaree 1400
<p>CARNAVALITO and PRINCESS HOLLY were late to arrive on Course. A subsequent veterinary examination of both horses cleared them fit to race.</p> <p>Permission was given to Trainer S Hapeta to remove the blinkers on PRINCESS HOLLY due to the existing track conditions.</p> <p>COSTUME (O Bosson) was a little slow to begin.</p> <p>CARNAVALITO (R Hutchings) raced keenly when being restrained in the early stages.</p>	
Race 7	Beckett Real Estate 1400
<p>Permission was given to Trainer D Waddell to remove the blinkers on KIDNAPPED due to the existing track conditions.</p> <p>BILLIE JEAN KING (M Tanaka) and SEED OF SPEED (M Cameron) were both slow to begin.</p> <p>FRANK WHITAKER (L Innes) raced keenly in the early stages.</p> <p>MA BELLE AMI lost the near fore plate during the running.</p>

<p>HARDTALUVA (M Wenn) jumped away awkwardly shifting in crowding ROC DE CHINE (M Du Plessis) and HONEYMOON (M Cameron).</p> <p>SHADES OF GOLD (M Coleman) raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p>
