## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>TE AKAU RACING SUPPORTS PAEROA HURDLE</b>
<p><b>COMTE DE JEU</b> (A Kuru) ran down the first fence and landed awkwardly.  <b>IT'S A MESSAGE</b> (R Cully) was crowded when jumping the second fence between <b>SHOOGOLD</b> (G Walsh) and <b>COMTE DE JEU</b> and clipped a heel and blundered on landing.  <b>REYNARDS BRO</b> (K Veenendaal) put in a poor jump at the fence near the 1200 metres.  <b>SHOOGOLD</b> was under pressure passing the 600 metres and was pulled up prior to jumping the last two fences when tailed off.  <b>ZENOCOIN</b> put in a poor jump at the second to last fence.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>RACING'S FUN WITH TE AKAU STEEPLECHASE</b>
<p><b>SINISTA</b> (R Cave) was slow to begin.  <b>HENRYTHEGUN</b> landed awkwardly after jumping the first fence with rider A Kuru becoming unbalanced.  <b>AT THE TOP</b> (W Cafferty) put in a poor jump at the second and fourth fence unbalancing the rider.  <b>AT THE TOP</b> put in a poor jump at the fence on the top of the hill on the first occasion.  <b>TRALEE</b> (S Phelan) lost its footing when crossing over into the centre of the course on the start of the second round.  <b>AT THE TOP</b> stumbled on landing after jumping the fourth fence on the second occasion.  The favourite <b>HENRYTHEGUN</b> began to lose touch with the field passing the 1400 metres on the final round and was pulled up prior to jumping the final fence. The gelding was found to be lame in the off front leg on pulling up. A post-race veterinary examination confirmed that the gelding was lame in the off front leg. Trainer D Stevenson was advised that a veterinary certificate will be required prior to the gelding racing next.</p>

<p>Approaching the 800 metres <b>POTHEEN</b> (C Dell) was inclined to lay in making contact with <b>BILLY ELLIOT</b> (L Whelan) with that runner becoming momentarily unbalanced.</p> <p><b>TOM'S MYTH</b> (S Phelan) was obliged to race wide without cover for the majority of the race.</p> <p><b>SUNSET PASS</b> (P Ormsby) lay in under pressure over the final 250 metres.</p> <p>When questioned into the performance of the favourite <b>BILLY ELLIOT</b> rider L Whelan could offer no tangible reason.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>RACE A HORSE WITH TE AKAU 2200</b>
<p><b>DAN DINERO</b> (C Studd) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>RED HOT</b> (C Singer) got tightened shortly after jumping away when runners on either side shifted ground.</p> <p><b>MR NOBODY</b> (R Cully) was inclined to lay inwards in the final 200 metres when placed under pressure.</p> <p><b>AMANOOD LAD</b> (C Dell) was not persevered with over the final 200 metres. When questioned C Dell could offer no excuses apart from possibly not suited to the very holding track conditions.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>VISIT TE AKAU RACING'S NEW WEBSITE 1670</b>
<p><b>JUST COLLIE</b> (G Walsh) jumped away awkwardly losing ground, then improved forward and was obliged to race wide without cover throughout.</p> <p>Passing the 250 metres <b>SOLYN</b> (S Phelan) was dictated out by <b>SOLDIER'S LEAP</b> (C Thornton) making contact with <b>ROMEO WHISKEY</b> (B Lammas). Rider C Thornton was advised to exercise care when shifting ground.</p> <p>Passing the 100 metres <b>SKEEN</b> (S Houston) shifted out abruptly under pressure and had to be straightened by its rider.</p> <p>When questioned into the disappointing performance of <b>MACAN</b> rider R Hutchings could offer no reason.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>MARK WALKER LEADS SINGAPORE PREMIERSHIP 1670</b>
<p><b>MISS JAYDEEJAY</b> (B Lammas) was slow away.</p> <p><b>SING HANG STAR</b> (D Nolan) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>SMUCKERS</b> (C Studd) raced wide without cover throughout.</p> <p><b>SOPHIE CLAIRE</b> (C Thornton) shifted out abruptly to obtain clear running passing the 300 metres.</p> <p>Passing the 150 metres <b>BLACK ATTACK</b> (M Cropp) had to check when crowded between <b>SEAMS LIKE MAGIC</b> (R Hutchings) and <b>SKAI GLEN</b> (P Ormsby) when both those runners shifted ground. Rider M Cropp lodged a protest against the third placed <b>SEAMS LIKE MAGIC</b> and the fourth placed <b>SKAI GLEN</b>. After viewing all relevant videos and hearing submissions from the connections involved the protest was dismissed.</p> <p><b>PROSPERO</b> (A Kuru) shied and shifted out just prior to the finishing line crowding <b>SEAMS LIKE MAGIC</b> which shifted out making contact with <b>SKAI GLEN</b>.</p> <p>Shortly after the finish <b>RAISAFUASHO</b> (C Singer) shifted out into the line of <b>ISHIDANZIN</b> which clipped a heel and stumbled dislodging rider K Veenendaal who was uninjured.</p> <p><b>SMUCKERS</b> underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>TE AKAU RACING NZ &amp; SINGAPORE 1670</b>
<p><b>LE BON FIN</b> (C Dell) and <b>CHILL BILL</b> (B Lammas) came together on jumping away.</p> <p><b>LE BON FIN</b> raced ungenerously through the early and middle stages when being restrained.</p> <p><b>ASWORTHY</b> (S Phelan) raced ungenerously through the middle stages.</p>
