RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	BOP PUNTER OF THE YEAR-22 JUNE '1600'
<p>NANCYLEE (O Bosson) was impeded leaving the barriers when the front gate on its starting stall failed to catch. As a result NANCYLEE lost ground beginning awkwardly and making contact with C'MON GEORGE. C'MON GEORGE was inclined to over-race in the early and middle stages. BAGSAGOLD (T Thornton) raced wide without cover throughout. NANCYLEE was inclined to lay out under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
Race 2	CLASSIC HITS 95FM TAURANGA '1200'
<p>Several runners anticipated the start with the gates not opening on the first attempt due to a power issue which was quickly rectified. KAYLEEN (M Dee) was slow to begin. JONAH (A Forbes) began awkwardly shifting in dictating LADY PHOENIX (T Thornton) inwards resulting in ROMANI (M McNab) and REACHFORTHESTARS (O Bosson) being crowded and losing ground. OKAY ANNIE (R Hutchings) jumped away awkwardly. LADY ROSETTA (L Allpress) began awkwardly and was further inconvenienced when CLAREVILLE FLIGHT (P Turner) shifted in. READY AT EIGHT (B Hutton) lay in going into the first turn near the 900 metres making contact with LADY PHOENIX. Near the 850 metres LADY PHOENIX had to be steadied to avoid the heels of READY AT EIGHT which shifted in when not fully clear. B Hutton was advised to exercise more care. REACHFORTHESTARS was held up rounding the final turn and early in the straight. Following the race R Norvall advised that he was feeling unwell and after being attended to by the ambulance personnel was stood down from his remaining ride in Race 7 suffering from dehydration.</p>	
Race 3	PARAMOUNT HIRE GROUP '1200'

<p>PRETTY SCARY (M Tanaka) and SCHRODINGERS CAT (B R Jones) both jumped away awkwardly with SCHRODINGERS CAT losing ground.</p> <p>CHAUSSETTE (M Dee) was slow to begin.</p> <p>Approaching the 400 metres PRETTY SCARY had to be steadied off the heels of CHAUSSETTE.</p> <p>DELLA LAMOUR (L Satherley) was inclined to lay out throughout the race.</p>	
Race 4	ULTIMATE MOTOR GROUP'S 40 YEAR CELEBRATION '2100'
<p>BAHTTON (R Hutchings) was struck leaving the barriers when the front gate failed to catch and sprung back. This starting gate was replaced prior to the next race.</p> <p>ROCKET QUEEN (M Wenn) and ARISE (O Bosson) came together on jumping away when both runners shifted ground.</p> <p>THE LAST STAR WAY (P Turner) which was slow to begin was further hampered by JAMIE LEE (M Tanaka) which shifted in when beginning awkwardly.</p> <p>When questioned O Bosson the rider of ARISE was unable to offer any excuse for the geldings disappointing performance advising that it had been a beaten runner passing the 800 metres. A post-race veterinary examination of ARISE did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.</p> <p>Apprentice M Dee the rider of MISS INDY which raced poorly stated that the mare had never travelled comfortably and in his opinion had failed to handle the existing track conditions.</p> <p>MANACOR (S Spratt) lay out under pressure in the final straight.</p>	
Race 5	TAINUI PRESS DESIGN AND PRINT '1600'
<p>MISS NANCHO BELLE (E Stack) began awkwardly.</p> <p>PORT ELIZABETH (B Hutton) was crowded for room near the 300 metres when KATNISS (T Thornton) lay out when struck with the whip rounding the final turn. When being steadied PORT ELIZABETH made contact with the hind quarters of KHALEESI (O Bosson) which became unbalanced. KHALEESI then shifted out forcing BEAUTY GLOW (B R Jones) wider on the track.</p> <p>BEAUTY GLOW and LUCKY RUBY (M Sweeney) came together approaching the 100 metres with both runners becoming unbalanced and making further contact passing the 100 metres. Following the race the connections of the second placed horse LUCKY RUBY lodged a protest alleging interference by the first placed horse BEAUTY GLOW. After hearing submissions the Judicial Committee dismissed the objection.</p>	
Race 6	CAFEBRAVO.CO.NZ '1400'
<p>IMPY LUIS (M Cheung) was slow away.</p> <p>KODEMA (O Bosson) began awkwardly and shifted out causing crowding to LADY GRANGELEA (M Hills), PALRAF (D Hain), NOTTOOBAD (M Sweeney) and POPPAS DELIGHT (B Grylls) with IMPY LUIS also being further hampered.</p> <p>JACK ROMANOV (C Dell) shifted out when struck with the whip rounding the bend near the 450 metres taking A COOL CHANGE (R Hutchings) outwards on to the hind quarters of WAINUI PRINCE (M Dee).</p> <p>JACK ROMANOV continued to be inclined to shift ground under pressure and ducked away from PRICKLEY PRINCESS (A Forbes) when that runner shifted out near the 250 metres. A Forbes was advised to exercise care.</p> <p>B Grylls (POPPAS DELIGHT) dropped her whip near the 250 metres.</p> <p>PAY ATTENTION (B Hutton) returned to the enclosure with blood present in both nostrils. PAY ATTENTION was confirmed as a bleeder and is now subject to the mandatory 3 month stand down, with a veterinary clearance then required prior to trialing or racing next. The connections advised that PAY ATTENTION will now be retired.</p> <p>A post-race veterinary examination of KODEMA found the gelding to be lame in the right foreleg. Co-trainer A Forsman was advised that a veterinary certificate of fitness would be required prior to KODEMA racing next.</p>	
Race 7	STELLA ARTOIS DE BIER HAUS '1200'
<p>L Allpress replaced R Norvall on INTERCITY GIRL.</p> <p>ROCKONBY (B Grylls), BROKASH (M Hills) and MEAN SLEAK (B R Jones) were all slow to begin.</p> <p>REGALIA (R Hutchings) began awkwardly shifting out inconveniencing COOL GENIE (P Turner) with SO KEEP ME (T Thornton) then shifting in abruptly and further hampering COOL GENIE which lost ground.</p> <p>R Hutchings the rider of REGALIA which performed poorly was unable to offer any excuses other than the filly may have found today's conditions too testing in its first run back from a spell, but he had still been very disappointed with its effort. A post-race veterinary examination of REGALIA did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.</p>	
Race 8	AMPHORA ON THE STRAND '1200'
<p>SUMOTORI (D Walsh) was slow away and then was further hampered when ROLL WITH PULSE (M McNab) shifted out abruptly with SUMOTORI losing ground as a result. When being corrected by its rider ROLL WITH PULSE then shifted back in crowding EDWARD CHEVAL (T Thornton) which lost ground.</p> <p>PHEROZARDO (M Dee) lost both hind plates during the running.</p> <p>A Forbes was reprimanded after weighing in at approx. 0.9kg in excess of the weight at which he had weighed out.</p>	
Race 9	RACE IMAGES FOR WINNING MEMORIES '1600'
<p>Co-trainer C Ormsby advised that he had inadvertently failed to scratch IMAGINE prior to the scratching deadline. IMAGINE was declared a late scratching at 11.03 am with C Ormsby being fined \$200 by the Judicial Committee.</p>	

SIR ELMO (A Jones) and **HOT IN BLACK** (D Walsh) were both slow away.

THE PROPHECY (A Taylor) was crowded leaving the barriers when **CLARA JANE** (L Allpress) began awkwardly shifting in.

CLARA JANE raced keenly in the early stages.

URBAN ANGEL (M Dee) had to be steadied near the 600 metres when awkwardly placed on the heels of **POSTAGE** (P Turner).

CLARA JANE lay out under pressure early in the final straight making contact with **SATEKA** (C Dell) near the 250 metres.

CLARA JANE raced in restricted room over the final 100 metres between **SIR ELMO** and **SATEKA** which both shifted ground.
