<b>Race 1</b>	<b>Western Leader 800</b>
<p><b>MOONEER</b> (S Spratt), <b>SUN HAVEN</b> (K Joyce) and <b>ANOTHER EMPEROR</b> (M Hills) were slow away.</p> <p><b>FASCINATION STREET</b> (A Forbes) hung out around the bend.</p> <p><b>DIDDY BOP SHADES</b> (R Norvall) and <b>LOTTI O'REILLY</b> (L Satherley) raced wide throughout.</p> <p><b>ANOTHER EMPEROR</b> lay out rounding the final turn and continued to do so in the final straight.</p> <p><b>ORBITY</b> (O Bosson) had to be steadied near the 150 metres and shifted out across heels to obtain clear running.</p>	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>Bill and Carrie 800</b>
<p><b>BRAH SPRING</b> (B Hutton) was slow to begin.</p> <p><b>BANBURY LAD</b> (L Satherley) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>CONCEPTUAL</b> (O Bosson) was hampered when leaving the barriers.</p> <p><b>NUGGETT</b> (A Taylor) began awkwardly hampering <b>EYE CONTACT</b> (R Norvall).</p> <p><b>CONCEPTUAL</b> hung out rounding the bend covering a considerable amount of extra ground.</p> <p><b>NUGGETT</b> made the first turn awkwardly.</p>	

<b>EYE CONTACT</b> and <b>AAJA NACHLE</b> (A Forbes) both shifted out under pressure in the final straight.	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>Paton Roofing Ltd 1200</b>
<p><b>RIVA BALLERINA</b> (D Turner) began awkwardly shifting out and hampering <b>SIMONE</b> (M Wenn) which was slow to begin. <b>TEGWIN</b> (BR Jones), <b>RICH N' ROSES</b> (R Norvall), <b>FULLOVIT</b> (M Tanaka), <b>FALKIRK'S HONOUR</b> (T Thornton) and <b>HOT CHA</b> (P Turner) were slow to begin.</p> <p><b>TEGWIN</b> raced greenly throughout.</p> <p>Passing the 900 metres <b>VILLARS</b> (RS Dye) lay in and away from <b>WHITNEY SPICE</b> (O Bosson) crowding <b>RICH N' ROSES</b> which was hampered losing ground. Jockey RS Dye was issued with a warning.</p> <p><b>HOT CHA</b> lay in when making the bend approaching the 800 metres inconveniencing <b>FULLOVIT</b>.</p> <p><b>TEGWIN</b> was disappointing finishing well back. The filly underwent a post race veterinary examination which revealed cardiac arrhythmia. Trainer A Scott was informed that the filly would need a veterinary clearance including clear results of an ECG examination prior to racing next.</p>	
<b>Race 4</b>	<b>Lovells Knits for Merino 1200</b>
<p><b>RAMARRO</b> (M Cameron) and <b>ELUSIVE SONG</b> (M McNab) both began awkwardly making heavy contact.</p> <p><b>PAULASKY</b> (R Aukett) began awkwardly losing ground.</p> <p><b>COOLIBAH</b> (M Tanaka) was crowded when leaving the barriers.</p> <p><b>SENATORIAL</b> (O Bosson) began awkwardly shifting in abruptly hampering <b>TWIST OF FATE</b> (BR Jones) and <b>LION RED</b> (B Hutton) which both lost ground.</p> <p>Approaching the 800 metres <b>STAR EMBRACE</b> (M Sweeney) raced ungenerously and shifted out making contact with <b>COOGEE FLYER</b> (M Hills) which was dictated into the line of <b>TWIST OF FATE</b> which had to steady and was taken over extra ground.</p> <p><b>SENATORIAL</b> raced ungenerously in the early and middle stages.</p> <p><b>STAR EMBRACE</b> commenced to give ground passing the 600 metres becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>LION RED</b> which shifted out slightly.</p> <p><b>GUETTA</b> (S Spratt) shifted out under pressure over the final 100 metres dictating <b>RAMARRO</b> wider on the track which crowded <b>LION RED</b> over the concluding stages which was steadied. S Spratt was advised to exercise care when riding her mounts out to the finish.</p> <p>S Spratt, the rider of <b>GUETTA</b>, was charged under Rule 638(3)(b) for excessive use of the whip prior to the 200 metres to which she elected to plead guilty and was suspended from the conclusion of racing on 25 May 2013 up to and including racing on 31 May 2013, 4 riding days.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>Thomsen's Timber Ltd Taumarunui 1400</b>
<p>Trainer C Wood applied for and was granted permission to remove the blinkers from <b>JOYFUL SPIRIT</b> today given the existing track conditions.</p> <p><b>KEEP IN TUNE</b> (S Wong) shifted in when leaving the barriers making heavy contact with <b>AQUA REGIA</b> (A Taylor).</p> <p><b>JOYFUL SPIRIT</b> (V Gatu) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>MYTHS AND LEGENDS</b> (T Wenn) shifted in when leaving the barriers making contact with <b>MINI BLOOM</b> (C Dell) which became briefly unbalanced.</p> <p><b>KEEP IN TUNE</b> had to steady approaching the 800 metres when becoming awkwardly placed inside the heels of <b>JOYFUL SPIRIT</b>.</p> <p>Passing the 700 metres T Wenn (<b>MYTHS AND LEGENDS</b>) lost the use of her stirrup iron becoming unbalanced for a distance and checking her mount. T Wenn regained the use of her irons near the 500 metres.</p> <p><b>JOYFUL SPIRIT</b> raced greenly early in the final straight and when looking to obtain clear running approaching the 200 metres became awkwardly placed on the heels of <b>MAA CHUCK</b> (A Jones) when dictated in by <b>KEEP IN TUNE</b>. Rider S Wong was issued with a warning under Rule 638(1)(d).</p> <p><b>KING PANAMERA</b> lost the near hind plate during the running.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>McLachlan Family Race 2200</b>
<p><b>TRABALDY</b> (P Turner) was slow away.</p> <p><b>MISS JAYDEEJAY</b> (B Hutton) began awkwardly.</p> <p><b>SAVED BY THE BELL</b> (M Sweeney) had to shift out when awkwardly placed on heels passing the 1500 metres to obtain clear running.</p> <p>Approaching the 600 metres <b>MISS JAYDEEJAY</b> raced in restricted room between <b>TAATS</b> (R Hutchings) and <b>TRABALDY</b> which appeared to shift out and away from <b>SAVED BY THE BELL</b>. <b>MISS JAYDEEJAY</b> was crowded and lost ground as a result. Video footage of this incident proved inconclusive with no further action being taken.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>North West Flooring Xtra 1200</b>
<p>Apprentice A Forbes admitted a breach of Rule 649(1)(a) in that he had attempted to weigh out for his mount <b>JUSTAGEM</b> without leathers and irons. After hearing submissions A Forbes was suspended by the Judicial Committee</p>	

from the conclusion of racing on Monday 27 May until the conclusion of racing on 17 June 2013.  
**HUG A GINGA** (L Satherley) began awkwardly jumping in the air and losing ground.  
**COLD SNAP** (R Hutchings) began awkwardly making contact with **CARNIVAL QUEEN** (M Sweeney).  
**BOY** (T Thornton) was slow away.  
**POGUE** (A Taylor) lay in making contact with **MATIMBA** (B Hutton) near the 900 metres.  
**POGUE** lay in near the 200 metres making contact with **AGENT ZIVA** (M Wenn).

<b>Race 8</b>	<b>Bryan Jackson 1400</b>

**JOKING** (M Wenn) and **SARNIA** (M Sweeney) both began awkwardly and shifted ground causing severe crowding to **ENVIADO** (A Forbes), **BEAUTY AHEAD** (BR Jones) and **EDWARD THE EIGHTH** (P Turner) which all lost ground.  
**OUT WEST** (L Satherley) was a little slow away.  
**HEZ COOL** (K Chiong) and **POWER TRIP** (R Hutchings) came together when leaving the barriers when both runners began awkwardly.  
When questioned regarding the performance of **ELLURE** Jockey M Cameron advised that the filly had found today’s existing track conditions too testing.  
When questioned regarding the performance of the favourite **LOOT ‘N’ LUST** Jockey O Bosson stated that the horse travelled well until the 600 metres and was quickly under pressure finishing well back. The gelding underwent a post race veterinary examination which revealed a slower than normal recovery rate.
