| <b>Race 1</b>  | <b>F.J.C STEWARDS MAIDEN</b>                                   |
| <b>KONTIKI</b> shifted in abruptly on jumping, hampering <b>RAYA TIKUS</b> , which lost ground.<br><b>SHINING PEARL</b> reared and began awkwardly.<br><b>NORTH AND SOUTH</b> jumped sideways at the start losing several lengths.<br><b>GOLDEN GLOVES</b> was crowded for several strides shortly after leaving the barriers and shortly after bumped with <b>SHINING PEARL</b> when in restricted room.<br>Shortly after entering the final straight <b>SHINING PEARL</b> was crowded when awkwardly placed between <b>MARACAY</b> which shifted in simultaneously as <b>RAYA TIKUS</b> shifted outwards. <b>SHINING PEARL</b> was then held up for a short distance.<br><b>DANCED ALL NIGHT</b> and <b>MILANION</b> came together and bumped over the final stages. |  |
| <b>Race 2</b>  | <b>S I ATKINS &amp; ASSOCIATES DANCED ALL NIGHT 3YO MAIDEN</b> |
| <b>HANDSOME HARVEY</b> was slow into stride.<br><b>MER NOIRE</b> commenced to race erratically passing the 900 metres and near the 700 metres ducked outwards abruptly   |  |

| <p>which resulted in rider Apprentice M Dravitzki becoming unbalanced and losing the use of her outside iron until near the 300 metres. <b>HANDSOME HARVEY</b> had to take evasive action to avoid <b>MER NOIRE</b>.<br/> <b>WILFRED</b> was inclined to race greenly throughout the final straight.</p>  |   |
| <b>Race 3</b>   | <b>TUI BREWING LEGENDS SINCE 1889 HANDICAP</b>    |
| <p><b>FASTFOOT</b> began awkwardly, bumping with <b>SPORTS COAT</b>.<br/> Near the 700 metres <b>BOLT ACTION</b> had to be steadied when in restricted room between <b>MCRAE</b> and <b>FASTFOOT</b> and made contact with the hind quarters of <b>FASTFOOT</b>, unbalancing that runner for a short distance.<br/> <b>HEY BRUCE</b> hung in throughout the final straight with rider <b>L Allpress</b> changing the whip to the near side in an attempt to rectify the gelding's hanging tendency.<br/> <b>SIR COSWORTH</b> was inclined to shift in under pressure over the final 400 metres, having to be straightened.</p>  |   |
| <b>Race 4</b>   | <b>CARTERS HANDICAP</b>                           |
| <p><b>HILTON JAMES</b> bounded at the start.<br/> <b>CRACKA CROWN</b> was slow away.<br/> <b>MISS DANNI</b> over-raced in the early and middle stages.<br/> <b>BIRCHINO</b> raced wide without cover throughout.<br/> <b>WAITAHA TOA</b> had to steady entering the home straight when awkwardly placed inside the heels of <b>HILTON JAMES</b>.</p>  |   |
| <b>Race 5</b>   | <b>COLSPEC CONSTRUCTION MAIDEN</b>                |
| <p><b>POSING GEM</b> began awkwardly.<br/> <b>ROSA HEIGHTS</b> was slow to begin.<br/> Approaching the 1300 metres, <b>TARTLET</b> was crowded and had to steady when inside <b>LA BELLA SANDS (M Dravitzki)</b> which shifted in. Apprentice M Dravitzki was issued with a warning.<br/> Apprentice D Turner (<b>ROSA HEIGHTS</b>) was issued with a warning with respect to the use of his whip on a horse not in contention.<br/> When questioned into the disappointing run of <b>FLAT WHITE</b>, rider J Parkes had no tangible excuse but was of the opinion that the mare may be better suited to a longer distance.</p> |   |

| <p><b>POLLY FLINDERS</b> and <b>DON'T LIKE MONDAY</b> bumped at the start.<br/> <b>GLAIZEM</b> raced wide throughout in search of better footing.</p>   |   |
| <b>Race 7</b>   | <b>GARY DYER PAINTERS &amp; DECORATORS MAIDEN</b> |
| <p><b>BEAU ZED, MY MAGICIAN</b> and <b>GOLLY I'M HANDSOME</b> were slow away.<br/> <b>CLAPATHUNDA</b> raced wide without cover throughout.<br/> <b>PADDY JO</b> shifted out abruptly when struck with the whip passing the 350 metres.<br/> <b>MWAADAN</b> held up approaching the 200 metres and had to shift ground inward to improve.<br/> <b>MR MIKE</b> lost a front plate near the 600 metres.</p>  |   |
| <b>Race 8</b>   | <b>NOEL'S BUILDING HANDICAP</b>                   |
| <p><b>SLAH</b> was slow away.<br/> Passing the 500 metres <b>THE LAST AL</b> was checked when between <b>DRIFT</b>, which when laying in, shifted in and <b>SLAH</b> which was being taken out to obtain clear running. After questioning riders it was determined that both <b>DRIFT</b> and <b>SLAH</b> had contributed to the tightening and no further action was taken. <b>DRIFT</b> continued to lay in for the remainder and had to be straightened on several occasions in the final straight.</p>  |   |
