

# STIPENDIARY STEWARDS REPORT

## GENERAL:

B Hutton was stood down from riding following a fall in race 6 and due to the unavailability of suitable apprentice jockeys was replaced on his remaining rides by senior jockeys.

M McNab admitted a breach of Rule 801(1)(h) in that he provided false information to Stipendiary Steward M Williamson at Paeroa, 30 May, 2013 after advising that he had a medical certificate to ride at those trials when in fact he did not. Today he produced a medical certificate clearing him to ride. After hearing submissions the judicial Committee fined him \$500.

## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>FRANKLIN LONG ROOFING LTD 2200</b>
<b>GOGINGA</b> (D Nolan) was slow to begin. <b>CHAINEDINKATRAZ</b> (C Studd) jumped away awkwardly, losing ground. <b>KING LARIA</b> (C Thornton) over-raced in the early and middle stages. <b>WINNIPEG</b> (S Houston) was inclined to lay out in the final stages when placed under pressure. When questioned regarding the performance of <b>KING LARIA</b> jockey C Thornton advised Stewards that the slow tempo of the race had not suited the gelding.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>ITM GJ WECK &amp; SONS LTD 2200</b>
<b>SOLYN</b> (P Turner) jumped away awkwardly. <b>ISTIMAGIC</b> (M Cheung) was slow to begin, and then was obliged to race wide without cover in the early stages.	

**JAMIE LEE** (M Tanaka) had to be steadied passing the 800 metres when racing in restricted room.  
**SOLYN** was inclined to lay in over the final 200 metres when placed under pressure.  
When questioned regarding the performance of **DAGGY ONE** which had become tailed off during the running, the connections explained that the gelding is now destined for a jumping career.

<b>Race 3</b>	<b>MEGA MITRE 10 PUKEKOHE 1600</b>
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**ZAH BIG BOY** (A Ihaka) and **ROMAN RASCAL** (J Forbes) both jumped away awkwardly, losing ground.  
**TOMMY RIKI** (S Houston) was slow away, and then was hampered when runners to its outside shifted in.  
Passing the 1200 metres **GOLDEN CUP WINNER** (C Leveque) when over-racing, shifted out forcing **ROMEO WHISKEY** (R Hutchings) and **TOMMY RIKI** wider on the track. **TOMMY RIKI** was then obliged to race wide without cover throughout.  
Approaching the 400 metres **LIGHT UP THE NIGHT** (P Ormsby) shifted out, inconveniencing **SOLDIER'S LEAP** (C Thornton) which was laying in.  
Shortly after passing the 200 metres **TOMMY RIKI** lay in and away from **SOLDIER'S LEAP**, crowding **BELLA CAVALLA** (C Studd) which was then further crowded by **REAL TREASURE** (S Phelan) which shifted out under pressure. As a result **BELLA CAVALLA** had to steady and change ground to obtain clear running. Jockey S Phelan was advised that a warning would be placed on his record for allowing **REAL TREASURE** to shift under pressure. In assessing the incident, Stewards took into account the movement from **TOMMY RIKI** which was beyond the control of its rider  
A Ihaka **ZAH BIG BOY** was advised that a warning would be placed on his record for using his whip in an excessive manner prior to the 200 metres.  
**TOMMY RIKI** returned to the enclosure with blood present in the right nostril. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a minor laceration.

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>TUAKAU COSSIE – RACING SECTION 1200</b>
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M Cropp was fined \$100 for failing to claim down to his published riding weight.  
**NEARLY STOLEN** (J Whiteside) began awkwardly and shifted out making contact with the hind quarters of **SNOW LINE** (M Cameron) which became briefly unbalanced.  
**WITZ END** (S Collett) and **DESIGNACAT** (R Hutchings) were crowded leaving the barrier between **VIKING ACE** (P Turner) and **NOTHING** (B R Jones) which had both began awkwardly, shifting ground.  
**DESIGNACAT** was held up early in the final straight and shifted out passing the 400 metres to obtain clear running.  
Passing the 400 metres B R Jones (**NOTHING**) lost the use of his whip before regaining it a short time later.

<b>Race 5</b>	<b>VERNON &amp; VAZEY TRUCK PARTS LTD 1200</b>
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The Stewards gave permission to trainer S Clotworthy for **GO JOELI** (R Norvall) to race without a shadow roll.  
**TANAYA** (P Turner) blundered shortly after leaving the barrier.  
**KAAP'S PRINCESS** (S Collett) was slow to begin.  
**LASTING TOUCH** (A Morgan) raced in restricted room passing the 100 metres.

<b>Race 6</b>	<b>ROGER GILL MOTORS 1200</b>
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Leaving the barrier, **GIRLS DAY OUT** (M Cheung) shifted in making contact with **FLUORO LITE** (C Grylls), forcing that runner on to **COPA VERDE** (M Cameron) which made heavy contact with **GISELA**, which became unbalanced and shifted in abruptly dislodging rider B Hutton. B Hutton was examined by medical staff and stood down from his remaining rides suffering from contusions to his left thigh and right foot.  
**LADY SCARLETT** (M Tanaka) and **MISS CITRON** (T Thornton) were both slow away.  
**GARDEN OF GOLD** (M Hills) commenced to race ungenerously passing the 800 metres and then shortly after was dictated wider on the track by **GIRLS DAY OUT** which was hampered by the riderless horse. **GIRLS DAY OUT** then continued to be inconvenienced by the riderless horse making the final turn.  
**GIRLS DAY OUT** shifted out when placed under pressure passing the 300 metres taking **GARDEN OF GOLD** wider on the track. **GARDEN OF GOLD** then shifted in off the heels of **GIRLS DAY OUT** to obtain clear running with that runner then shifting back in further inconveniencing **GARDEN OF GOLD**. The Stewards adjourned the matter to a later date.

<b>Race 7</b>	<b>COUNTIES CLEANING SUPPLIES 1400</b>
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**RAP N TAP** (R Norvall) put its head down as the gates were released and was subsequently slow away (3L).  
Leaving the barrier **DREAMY JAYDA** (B R Jones) was crowded between **THORNDIKE** (S Collett) and **CONTRADA** (M Hills), both of which began awkwardly.  
**MADETOMEASURE** (C Grylls) began awkwardly, shifting in and making contact with **JESSHANIMO** (O Bosson).  
**THE ARTFUL DODGER** (M Cameron) shifted out leaving the barrier inconveniencing **MISS OKLAHOMA** (M Tanaka).  
**KNOCK KING** (P Turner) was slow to begin.

**KING PANAMERA** (D Turner) and **KATINKA** (M Sweeney) both began awkwardly.

Approaching the 600 metres **BURNADEEM** (R Hutchings) raced in restricted room between **JESSHANIMO** and **KNOCK KING** both of which shifted ground.

Passing the 300 metres **KATINKA** shifted in when struck with the whip before being corrected by its rider. As a result **BURNADEEM** which was racing to the inside of **KATINKA** became crowded having to steady. M Sweeney was reprimanded and advised that he must make a greater attempt to straighten his mounts when they are shifting ground. In assessing this incident the Stewards took into account the racing manners of **KATINKA**.

**KING PANAMERA** lay out over the final 75 metres.

**KATINKA** shifted in over the final 50 metres.

M Sweeney was reminded of his obligations in that he must ride his horses fully to the finish when circumstances permit him to do so.

**Race 8**

**BARCON SECURITY 1400**

**CARADONNA** jumped away awkwardly unbalancing rider D Turner, and then making contact with **ANOTHER EDITION** (T Thornton).

**HOT MUSTARD** (R Hutchings) jumped away awkwardly.

**CHAUSSETTE** (C Grylls) got its head up when racing ungenerously in the early stages.

**DJANGO** (R Norvall) became awkwardly placed on heels approaching the 600 metres.

Passing the 300 metres **HOT MUSTARD** commenced to lay in when placed under pressure and then shifted in, inconveniencing **KEEPIT** (S Collett).

**EMILYS OWN** (O Bosson) underwent a post-race veterinary examination which found the filly to have suffered a minor laceration to the inside of a nostril.

**Race 9**

**NORWOOD FARM MACHINERY CENTRE PUKEKOHE 1600**

**HOCHHAUS** (D Nolan) jumped away awkwardly losing ground.

**WHATWASTHAT** (O Bosson) and **HOLLY ROSE** (S Collett) made contact when both runners shifted ground leaving the barrier.

At the start **LIBERTY FIGHTER** (M Sweeney) shifted in making contact with **PORT ELIZABETH** (M Hills) with both horses becoming unbalanced for a short distance.

**LIBERTY FIGHTER** ducked in abruptly when placed under pressure early in the final straight and then continued to lay in for the remainder of the straight placing rider M Sweeney at a disadvantage.
