#### **RACE COMMENTS:**

## Race 1 DD BLOODSTOCK 1200

CELTIC BOY (N Harris) was slow to begin and then was severely hampered when VITESSE ROSE (C Grylls) and DESIGNATED

**DRIVER** (L Satherly) both began awkwardly and shifted ground.

**STORM BRO** (D Johnson) over raced in the middle stages.

NUGGET (S Collett) made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly when racing keenly.

**VITESSE ROSE** raced three wide without cover throughout.

**YOUNG WARRIOR** (J Jago) lay in under pressure in the final straight.

## Race 2 NORRIS WARD MCKINNON 1400

WANNABEFAMOUS (N Harris) and CROWN OF THORNS (D Johnson) were both slow to begin.

**TOMA VALEA** (T Thornton) jumped away awkwardly then over raced in early and middle stages.

SPARE A FORTUNE (P Turner) raced wide without cover throughout.

CROWN OF THORNS got its head up and made the bend near the 800 metres awkwardly.

**CROWN OF THORNS** and **SPARE A FORTUNE** came together near the 250 metres.

SPARE A FORTUNE lay in under pressure, inconveniencing CROWN OF THORNS near the 100 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of **WANNABEFAMOUS**, rider N Harris advised that after travelling comfortably the entire had been unable to quicken when placed under pressure, adding that in his opinion

WANNABEFAMOUS would be improved by the outing and would appreciate a deeper, more rain affected track.

## Race 3 BDO WAIKATO 1400

**GALAXY ROAD** (S Collett) jumped away awkwardly, blundering and losing ground.

**EDWARD THE EIGHTH** (P Turner) jumped away awkwardly shifting in to the line of **ARTIFACT** (S Dye) forcing that runner on to **SOPHIE'S GEM** (R Hutchings), with **SOPHIE'S GEM** becoming unbalanced.

WAIPIPI LAD (D Turner) raced wide without cover throughout.

**GOLD HUNTER** (M Sweeney) raced ungenerously in the middle stages.

GALAXY ROAD had to be steadied off heels near 600 metres.

**ALESSANDRA** (M Cameron) was inclined to lay in during the final straight.

KAPSBOY (J Jago) lost the left hind plate in the running.

## Race 4 PAULINE & RALPH BAX'S 50<sup>TH</sup> WEDDING ANNIVERSARY 1200

**THE RACONTEUR** (J Oliver) and **STARCHEEKA** (S Dye) both jumped away awkwardly, coming together with both runners becoming unbalanced.

**BOY** (T Thornton) was slow to begin.

AGENT ZIVA (P Turner) was inclined to get its head up in the early to middle stages.

THE RACONTEUR had to be steadied away from the heels of STARCHEEKA going into the bend near the 800 metres.

A KEEPA (M Hills), which was attempting a marginal run to the outside of STARCHEEKA, was placed in restricted room near the 400 metres when STARCHEEKA lay out rounding the final turn. A KEEPA then had to be steadied near the 350 metres when STARCHEEKA shifted out across the heels of PLAYBOY (D Turner) which lay in.

**AGENT ZIVA** was inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight, with **LEICA QUEEN** (C Grylls) shifting out across that runners heels passing the 100 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of AIRFIELD ROAD, O Bosson was unable to offer any excuses.

## Race 5 MUNNS THE MAN'S STORE / R M WILLIAMS 2100

VITALI (O Bosson) and EXCUSE ME MADAM (P Turner) both jumped away awkwardly.

**SKEEN** (L Kalychurun) raced wide without cover throughout.

O Bosson the rider of **VITALI** reported that the gelding had hung throughout the race.

## Race 6 PELLOWS FUNERAL DIRECTORS & ADVISORS 1600

The start was delayed 2 minutes at the request of Raceday Control.

PROPULSION (D Johnson) was hampered leaving the barriers when struck by the side partition of its barrier stall.

**HONEYMOON** (R Hutchings) and **LION RED** (O Bosson) both began awkwardly.

**SERGIOS** (M McNab) had to be steadied near the 200 metres when crowded for room by **BEAUTY AHEAD** (R Jones) which was taken out by **HONEYMOON** which was shifting away from **VERDASCO** (M Cheung). **HONEYMOON** continued to shift out under pressure inconveniencing **BEAUTY AHEAD**. R Hutchings was advised to exercise more care.

#### Race 7 MUNNS THE MAN'S STORE / R M WILLIAMS 1600

After weighing out for his ride in Race 1, O Bosson advised that he would be unable to make the required weight for **ANTONINE**. After considering options, the connections of **ANTONINE** were unable to secure a satisfactory replacement rider and in the circumstances were granted permission to late scratch the mare. O Bosson admitted a breach of Rule 330 (3)(c) and after hearing submissions was fined \$800 by the Judicial Committee.

**ARE YOU DEVIOUS** (D Johnson) shifted out leaving the barriers, crowding **THE MIG** (S Collett) onto **POPEYE BRAGGINS** (N Harris). **MISS DANNI** (C Grylls), which had begun awkwardly, then bumped with **POPEYE BRAGGINS** and was forced on to the hind quarters of **BOB VALDEZ** (V Gatu) with both **POPEYE BRAGGINS** and **MISS DANNI** having to be checked, losing ground.

THE TERMINATOR (D Turner) and GOYESCAS (S Dye) were both slow away.

**BOB VALDEZ** over raced in the early to middle stages until improving forward to sit three wide outside the leader passing the 800 metres.

**CAT WOMAN** (M Sweeney) had to be steadied when crowded going into the bend near the 800 metres.

**THE TERMINATOR** and **GOYESCAS** were both hampered near the 500 metres when held up behind the weakening **ARE YOU DEVIOUS**.

S Dye (**GOYESCAS**) advised that the mare had not been entirely comfortable in today's track conditions and in his opinion would benefit from the reapplication of blinkers.

**STAGEHAND** (B Hutton) rolled out rounding the final bend near the 400 metres, placing **OCEAN BOUND** (R Hutchings) in restricted room. **STAGEHAND** continued to shift out slightly early in the straight, with **OCEAN BOUND** making contact with the hind quarters of **LE BON FIN** (R Jones) turning that runner inwards, exacerbating the crowding to **OCEAN BOUND** which was checked when becoming awkwardly placed on the heels of **LE BON FIN**. B Hutton was advised to exercise more care.

## Race 8 THE MEAT WAREHOUSE 1600

MEMORY (O Bosson) lay in leaving the barriers crowding MAHARISHI (S Collett).

MAHARISHI over raced down the back straight.

**URBAN ANGEL** (M Cameron) had to be steadied when racing in restricted room near the 700 metres and made contact with the hind quarters of **WATTLE BAY** (M Sweeney) turning that runner inwards, with **WATTLE BAY** then also having to be steadied. Video coverage of the incident was inconclusive.

WATTLE BAY was held up rounding the final turn.

**CLAREEN** (R Jones) made contact with **WATTLE BAY** near the 350 metres.

**MEMORY** was inclined to lay out in the final straight.

**URBAN ANGEL** had some difficulty obtaining clear running early in the final straight.

A post race veterinary examination of **URBAN ANGEL** did not reveal any abnormalities.
