## RACE COMMENTS:

<b>Race 1</b>	<b>EGMONT WANGANUI HUNT 1200m</b>
CANYON reared at the start losing several lengths. CANYON had to steady off heels for a short distance passing the 400 metres. JOAN FRANCES lay in under pressure shortly after entering the final straight, resulting in MR WOOHOO being crowded. When questioned regarding the run of MR WOOHOO Rider H Tinsley could offer no excuses. Following the running of this race the track was downgraded to Heavy 10.	
<b>Race 2</b>	<b>HOOPER ENGINEERING 1650m</b>
NORBERT and FRED FLINSTONE were slow to begin. MWAADAN got its head up when being restrained racing in to the first turn. FRED FLINSTONE raced keenly in the early stages. FRED FLINSTONE was held up for a short distance early in the final straight. When questioned in to the run of NOW WERETALKIN' which ran last, rider A Morgan had no excuse.	
<b>Race 3</b>	<b>vetfarm 1400m</b>
COASTAL HEIGHTS was declared a late scratching at 1.40pm after dislodging Rider R Myers in the preliminary and galloping an excessive distance. Rider R Myers was uninjured. LEATHER N' LACE was slow to begin. BONNIE DUNDEE raced keenly when wide making the turn near the 1,000 metres.	

<b>Race 4</b>	<b>STEELFORM ROOFING GROUP 1400m</b>
<p>Apprentice Rider D Turner was unable to make the required weight for HIS PET and was replaced by R Myers. D Turner admitted a resultant breach under Rule 330 (3) (c) and after consideration the Judicial Committee imposed a \$400 fine.</p> <p>DEIDRE was slow away.</p> <p>ASTUCIOUS raced keenly in to the first corner and bumped with I SUGGEST.</p> <p>When questioned in to the run of WILD ROCK which disappointed, Rider B Grylls was of the opinion the filly may be better suited to a shorter distance.</p>	
<b>Race 5</b>	<b>ZED@GRANGEWILLIAM STUD 1400m</b>
<p>An enquiry was opened and adjourned in to the reasons why FREYA was presented in the enclosure without its notified gear (blinkers).</p> <p>MR INK shifted in abruptly on jumping, making heavy contact with SNEDDON which became unbalanced and shifted in hampering BELLA ARTOIS which lost ground.</p> <p>KUZANOV raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p>	
<b>Race 6</b>	<b>BRUCE CLIFTON BUILDING SERVICES 1200m</b>
<p>PASHA SUMORE shifted in on jumping, making contact with THE LONE RANGER which in turn bumped with SNOW EXCUSE which lost ground.</p> <p>SNOW EXCUSE was held up for a short distance passing the 600 metres and was angled inward passing the 400 metres to obtain clear running.</p>	
<b>Race 7</b>	<b>WAITOTARA BULK SUPPLIES 2200m</b>
<p><b>CAUGHT OUT</b> lost its footing on jumping, however recovered quickly.</p> <p><b>RIOCH</b> shifted out on jumping tightening <b>COLT FORTY FIVE</b> which lost ground.</p> <p><b>HONEY</b> began awkwardly and was slow away.</p> <p><b>VIKING CHIEF</b> over-raced in the early stages.</p> <p><b>I CHIANTI</b> raced keenly in the early and middle stages.</p> <p>When questioned regarding the performance of <b>I CHIANTI</b>, Rider O Bosson reported that the gelding's tendency to over-race had proved detrimental to its chances.</p>
