RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	Cowleys Hire Centre 1200
SKYDIVER (C Grylls) was slow away.	
ZEST PRINCESS (L Innes) began awkwardly.	
SPARE ONE (L Satherley) was steadied when racing keenly going into the bend near the 900 metres.	

CHAUSSETTE (S Collett) raced wide without cover.

AIRMAN (S Spratt) lay out under pressure in the final straight.

Passing the 300 metres **ZEST PRINCESS** had to steady off the heels of **THIRD RATE ROMANCE** (M Sweeney) which shifted out under pressure.

Race 2 | **The Northern Advocate 1200**

CAV IN THE CASTLE (L Satherley) and **AFRICAN STAR** (M Sweeney) came together when leaving the barriers.

Shortly after jumping away **HANNAH MARY** (S Spratt) shifted in and away from **TROIA** (L Innes) crowding **GIDGET THE MIDGET** (R Smyth) in on to the hind quarters of **ONE O EIGHT** (O Bosson) which became briefly unbalanced.

Shortly after jumping away **CAV IN THE CASTLE**, **AFRICAN STAR** and **DOMESTIC GODDESS** (T Thornton) were all crowded between **LADY HAURAKI** (D Johnson) which shifted in and outward movement from **CAV IN THE CASTLE** which had been bumped by **CANDLE IN THE WIND** (M Cameron) which shifted out shortly after the start. D Johnson was issued with a warning and advised she must exercise greater care when shifting ground.

Approaching the 800 metres **CANDLE IN THE WIND** which was racing ungenerously had to be steadied off the heels of **LADY HAURAKI** which shifted in and away from **RATTLE AND HUM** (B Hutton). D Johnson was issued with a warning and advised to be clear of other runners when shifting ground.

STRADA LASS (P Turner) was held up passing the 600 metres and had to be steadied near the 500 metres to avoid the heels of **GIDGET THE MIDGET** which had also been steadied when racing in restricted room at that point of the race dropping back on to **STRADA LASS**.

TROIA shifted out under pressure over the final 200 metres.

Passing the 100 metres **HANNAH MARY** shifted out off the heels of **MAIDEN WARRIOR** (S Collett) and inconvenienced **AFRICAN STAR**.

Race 3 | **Captain Rio 2YO Challenge Handicap**

PAPPA RAGAZZO (O Bosson) began awkwardly making contact firstly with **ORBITY** (M Cameron) and then with **STAND YOUR GROUND** (C Grylls).

Approaching the 1000 metres **PAPPA RAGAZZO** and **BABILLONI** (BR Jones) were both racing keenly and in restricted room with both runners being steadied. **PAPPA RAGAZZO** made contact with the hind quarters of **STAND YOUR GROUND** and became unbalanced with **PAPPA RAGAZZO** shifting out resulting in **BABILLONI** being checked near the 1000 metres.

WAZUNGU (M Sweeney) had difficulty obtaining clear running in the final straight.

PAPPA RAGAZZO underwent a veterinary examination which failed to find any obvious abnormalities. O Bosson advised the gelding had raced greenly in amongst the field.

Race 4 | **JLT Bloodstock 1200**

BENGHAAZI BURNER (R Hutchings) which had been proving difficult to load was declared a late scratching at 12.47pm after escaping riderless from behind the barriers and crashing through the running rail and a gate. As a result this race ran approximately 8 minutes late.

EL GUAPO (C Grylls) was slow away.

SAINT PIRAN (M Sweeney) shifted in abruptly when leaving the barriers crowding **SO DANSO** (D Johnson) on to **SCORCHING** (S Collett).

SAINT PIRAN over-raced in the early to middle stages.

LATE DECISION (O Bosson) and **HOLLY ROSE** (B Hutton) both raced wide without cover.

Race 5 | **Carters Your Building Partner 2100**

CAJERO (M Cameron) was a late scratching behind the barriers at 1.22pm acting on veterinary advice as it was mildly lame in the off fore leg.

ZAH BIG BOY (D Nolan) which had been fractious in the barriers began awkwardly losing ground.

MANACOR (S Spratt) was crowded when leaving the barriers.

ROMAN RASCAL (A Taylor) hung outwards rounding the first bend and continued to race ungenerously through the middle stages.

ARISE (M Sweeney) blundered near the 700 metres.

DEE I WHY (L Innes) had to be steadied approaching the 600 metres when **ROMAN RASCAL** rolled out.

ZAH BIG BOY lay in under pressure in the final straight hampering **CANDY GIRL** (O Bosson) near the 250 metres.

When questioned regarding the performance of **LET'S DIVORCE** Rider D Johnson advised that the filly had not been suited by the pace of the race and had been unable to recover after being shuffled back during the running, adding that the filly would in her opinion be better suited racing in the open and handier to the pace.

Race 6 | **Fell Engineering 2100**

NOOSA BLUE (D Johnson) and **RYAN JOHN** (O Bosson) were slow away.

KING PICCOLO (P Turner) raced three wide without cover throughout.

TABLE ONE (S Spratt) was held up early in the final straight and shifted ground to the inside to obtain clear running near the 300 metres. **SPICEY AS** (A Taylor) which was improving then shifted out abruptly across the heels of **TABLE**

ONE.

C Grylls (**IMAGINE**) was issued with a warning for his whip use prior to the 200 metres.

Race 7 Carters Chippies Mile

The start of this race was delayed approximately 8minutes due to **PACO KID** requiring farrier attention behind the barriers.

CEE TEE ARE (R Hutchings) was slow away.

GIOVANNA BELLA (T Thornton) began awkwardly making contact with **ZABINELLA** (O Bosson) which was forced on to **RULALINE** (M Hills) which made contact with the hind quarters of **SHADES OF GOLD** (D Johnson). **RULALINE** had to be checked as a result losing several lengths.

THE FORCE (L Innes) began awkwardly.

RULALINE shied and shifted out abruptly approaching the 1400 metres.

Passing the 1300 metres **HURIKIN** (BR Jones) was crowded and checked when racing to the inside of **PERFECTLY CLEVER** (M Sweeney) which was dictated in by **ASSASSIN** (P Turner). P Turner admitted a breach of careless riding under Rule 638(1)(d) and was suspended from the conclusion of racing on Saturday 15 June 2013 until the conclusion of racing on Saturday 22 June 2013, 4 riding days.

SHADES OF GOLD (D Johnson) over-raced through the middle stages.

Approaching the 300 metres **GIOVANNA BELLA** shifted out to obtain clear running making contact with **HURIKIN** which was dictated out with **PENTAROSE** (C Grylls) becoming awkwardly placed on that runner's heels shifting out and crowding **PERFECTLY CLEVER** which shifted out dictating **ZEPHYROS** (B Hutton) out into the line of **SHADES OF GOLD** which had to steady. T Thornton was advised to exercise greater care when shifting ground.

Race 8 92.4FM Live Sport Northland 1400

BIG PICTURE (BR Jones) reared when the barriers opened and was further hampered by **ANOTHER EDITION** (S Collett) which began awkwardly making solid contact with **BIG PICTURE** which as a result lost considerable ground.

PINK DIAMOND (D Johnson) began awkwardly and was further hampered when crowded.

GISELA (B Hutton) knuckled when leaving the barriers.

DJOKOVIC (M Sweeney) began very awkwardly crowding **MITCHAM** (M Cameron) on to **EMILIO** (L Innes).

Passing the 800 metres **DJOKOVIC** lay inwards making contact with **GISELA** which became briefly unbalanced.

Near the 800 metres **LADY PRIVATEER** (C Grylls) had to steady when awkwardly placed inside the heels of **PACKING EXPRESS** (O Bosson). **KANSAS** (T Thornton) which was following **LADY PRIVATEER** also had to be steadied.

Approaching the 700 metres **GISELA** shifted out making contact with **DJOKOVIC** forcing that runner wider on the track.

DJOKOVIC was quickly beaten once entering the final straight and was not persevered with by its rider. The connections indicated that they would not be persevering with the gelding. A post race veterinary examination did not reveal any obvious abnormalities.

Race 9 Whangarei Bus Services 1400

CAPTAIN SCOTT (O Bosson) was slow away.

BIG ROCKET (B Hutton) raced wide without cover outside the leader.

Near the 250 metres **CAPTAIN SCOTT** was held up and when shifting out to obtain clear running was not clear of **FIELDODREAMS** (M Hills) which was crowded and checked losing ground. Jockey O Bosson admitted a breach of careless riding and was suspended from the conclusion of racing on the 19th June up to and including the 26th June, 4 days.

Race 10 A'Fare Cafe Catering 1400

NAZEER dislodged its rider L Innes and escaped during the preliminaries. After being recaptured **NAZEER** underwent a veterinary examination before being passed fit to run.

SUMOTORI (B Hutton) began awkwardly making solid contact with **NAZEER** which was badly hampered losing ground.

FREEDOM (K Joyce) was slow to begin.

STARS OF JIRO (M Hills) began awkwardly and was further hampered when crowded.

THE RICH LISTER (O Bosson) began very awkwardly bumping **AIMEES BABE** (M Sweeney).

THE RICH LISTER over-raced in the early and middle stages.

SUMOTORI raced three wide without cover throughout.

Passing the 300 metres **MT EDEN** (S Spratt) had to steady when crowded to the inside of **THE RICH LISTER** which lay in.

KING ZEUS returned to the enclosure with blood present in the right nostril which after being examined by the veterinarian was found to be consistent with a laceration.

When questioned regarding the performance of **NAZEER** Rider L Innes advised that the gelding had received interference at the start and had made abnormal breathing noises during the running. A post race veterinary

examination revealed no abnormalities.
