RACE COMMENTS:

Race 1	BRISTOL CLAN MAIDEN HURDLES 3000M			
TIM which was fractious in its gate prior to the start, reared leaving the barriers losing ground.				
SHOTGUN began awkwardly and made contact with RANGATIRA.				
ISHIDANZIN landed awkwardly at the fence near the 800 metres on the first occasion and shifted out bumping LIZAC.				
TIM jumped the fence near the 600 metres awkwardly on the final round.				
LIZAC landed awkwardly after jumping the fence near the 600 metres.				
FRAGGLE ROCK was retired from the race near the 400 metres when well back and out of contention.				
RANGATIRA landed awkwardly after jumping the last fence.				
When questioned in to the run of ISHIDANZIN, Rider G Walsh said his mount struggled in the going after hitting the fence near the 600 metres.				
Trainer K Duncan admitted a breach of Rule 616 (1) in that he presented WEE BISKIT with leather reins which are not permitted and was fined the sum of \$50.				
A post-race veterinary inspection of FRAGGLE ROCK failed to reveal any abnormalities.				
Race 2	JOLT COFFEE HOUSE MAIDEN HURDLES 3000M			
NO EXCUSES began awkwardly.				

EDENBRAE slowed up at the fence near the 1,200 metres then landed awkwardly losing ground.

WILBUR knuckled on jumping the second last fence.

HERMAN MUNSTER broke down after jumping the fence at the top of the straight on the first round and was retired from the contest. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed an undiagnosed injury to the right hind leg requiring veterinary treatment.

When questioned **in to the run o**f REYNARDS BRO Rider J Rathbone advised Stewards that the gelding was travelling comfortably near the rail and was improving its position in the back straight until hitting the fence near the 1,000 metres which resulted in her losing ground and having to improve wide around runners from the 1,000 metres.

Race 3 THE WHANGAEHU 'RIOCH' O'LEARYS MAIDEN STEEPLES 4100M

BALLY HEIGHTS raced wide without cover throughout.

HAPPY GO LUCKY raced keenly in front.

PALEMO landed awkwardly after jumping the first fence in the home straight with a round to go.

DOUBLED UP hit the fence near the 1,200 metres and lost ground.

WAIANAKARUA landed awkwardly at the fence near the 1,000 metres

MCCULLEY lost ground at the fence near the 600 metres.

When questioned in to the run of MCCULLEY Rider I Lupton advised the gelding raced keenly throughout but after hitting the fence near the 600 metres had little left at the finish.

DUMINY landed awkwardly after jumping the last fence and lost momentum.

DOUBLED UP, WAIANAKARUA, OHOPEE and HAPPY GO LUCKY were all retired from the race prior to entering the home straight when well back and out of contention.

Race 4 GUDSELL CLAN MAIDEN 1200M

There was a delay to the start of this race of approx. six minutes due to the dismantling of the steeple fences and runners being slow to load.

PLATINUM PROVENCE shifted out leaving the barrier crowding TAKEMEHOMEBABE which lost ground.

CLIO shifted in sharply when tested with the whip near the straight entrance which resulted in PRETTY PLEASE and ITSAGEM being hampered for a short distance.

SHILLYSHALLY failed to keep pace with the field despite being tried in the early and middle stages and proved uncompetitive. Connections were advised that a warning would be placed against the mare. Trainer G Haigh advised SHILLYSHALLY would trial prior to its next start.

Trainer W Morris was advised that a warning would be placed against THE RAHTWO REBEL which was reluctant to load. When questioned regarding the performance of CORBYN Rider D Bradley was of the opinion the gelding was unsuited to

the Slow 9 track.

PLATINUM PROVENCE lost its off front plate during the running.

Race 5 B CONNORS FAMILY CLAN R85 1200M

Rider B Lammas was unable to make the carded weight for ATOZED, being 1kg over and was replaced by D Walker. B Lammas admitted a breach of Rule 330 (3) (c) and was fined the sum of \$300.

UNBELIEVEABELLE and ATOZED began awkwardly.

M Dravitzki reported that SUPER BOY which failed to run on was unsuited to the track.

ATOZED returned to the enclosure with blood present in a nostril. A subsequent veterinary inspection revealed a cut consistent with having hit the front of its gate prior to the start.

Race 6 MACNAB CLAN R65 1200M

ROPA LANE was crowded leaving the barrier between LORRAINE which shifted in abruptly and LAKOTA and lost ground as a result.

AWAHURI and GEMMA LASS both began awkwardly.

LORRAINE raced ungenerously for a short distance rounding the bend near the 1,000 metres.

Race 7 TURAKINA CLAN MAIDEN 2060M

THE PAINTER was tightened at the start and got back.

NO QUOTA was tightened at the start after ATTABOY shifted in and away from BEGUILING.

Near the 1,200 metres ATTABOY had to be steadied and angled wider when improving up on to the heels of MY MAGICIAN. SOCIETY ROSE raced wide without cover rounding the turn.

Rider D Walsh reported that RAPT IN GOLD raced keenly in the early and middle stages and when placed under pressure had little left at the finish.

Race 8 94.4 THE SOUND RADIO STATION OF THE YEAR MAIDEN 1600M

XIBIT began awkwardly and got back.

THE OYSTERMAN was slow to begin.

Apprentice Jockey D Turner (BEAUDASTORM) was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground after allowing his mount to shift in passing the 1,200 metres, hampering FLAT WHITE and SKYBIRD for a short distance.

When questioned in to the run of XIBIT, Rider K Smith reported that the gelding may not have been suited to today's track conditions.

D Walsh reported that SKYBIRD was unsuited to the going.

Race 9 PALAMOUNTAINS NUTRITION R75 1360M

COASTAL EXPRESS was hampered leaving the barrier.

FARO RUBINO jumped out abruptly at the start dictating ALIGNADREAMS in to the line of COASTAL EXPRESS which was severely tightened and settled back.

FARO RUBINO raced keenly early.

DON'TLIKEMONDAY had to change ground inward near the 300 metres to improve.
